Fabric Requirements:

| A | 1 panel | Panel | Panel blocks | 3873-M |
| B, C & D | 7/8 yard | Purple paint | Block borders & binding | 3875-P |
| E & F | 1/2 yard | Orange paint | Block borders | 3875-O |
| G & H | 1/2 yard | Brown paint | Block borders | 3875-N |
| I, J & K | 7/8 yard | Multicolored stripes | Sashing & First border | 3874-M |
| L & M | 1/3 yard | White on white tonal | Second border | 3876-L |
| N & O | 1 7/8 yards | Children all over | Final border | 3877-M |
| Backing fabric | 3 3/4 yards | *** Not included in kit, sold separately *** | | |

Cutting Instructions:

| Fabric | Quantity | Size |
|--------|----------|---|
| A | 12 | 5 3/4" squares (fussy cut by centering fabrics) |
| B | 16 | 2" x 5 3/4" rectangles |
| C | 16 | 2" x 2" squares |
| D | 6 | 2 1/2" x WOF strips (for binding) |
| E | 16 | 2" x 5 3/4" rectangles |
| F | 16 | 2" x 2" squares |
| G | 16 | 2" x 5 3/4" rectangles |
| H | 16 | 2" x 2" squares |
| I | 2 | 2 1/2" x WOF strips Subcut into 8 – 2 1/2" x 8 3/4" rectangles |
| J & K | 8 | 2 1/2" x WOF strips For J, subcut 5 strips into 5 – 2 1/2" x 29 1/4" strips For K, sew 3 strips together end to end, then subcut into 2 – 2 1/2" x 43 1/2" strips |
| L & M | 4 | 1 3/4" x WOF strips Sew 4 strips together end to end For L, subcut into 2 – 1 3/4" x 43 1/2" strips For M, subcut into 2 – 1 3/4" x 35 3/4" strips |
| N | 2 | See page 6 for cutting instructions |
| O | 2 | See page 6 for cutting instructions |

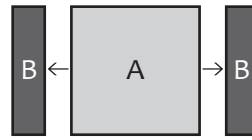
What Do You See? Quilt Pattern

Piecing Instructions:

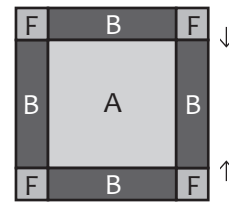
Sew two Fabric B rectangles to opposite sides of a Fabric A square. Press seams toward Fabric B.



Sew two Fabric F squares to opposite sides of two Fabric B rectangles. Press seams toward Fabric B.



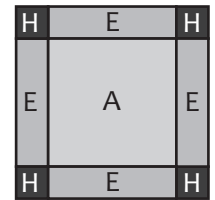
Sew the units together as shown. Press toward the Fabric B/A units. Make 4.

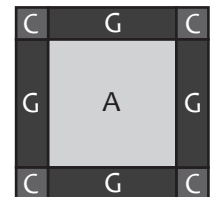
Finished block should measure 8 3/4" x 8 3/4" square.

Repeat steps above using Fabric E rectangles and Fabric H squares. Make 4.

Repeat steps above using Fabric G rectangles and Fabric C squares. Make 4.



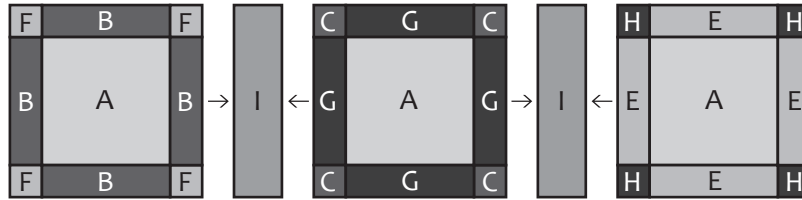

What Do You See? Quilt Pattern

With a Fabric B/A/F unit, a Fabric G/A/C unit, and a Fabric E/A/H unit, assemble the first row of blocks as shown, inserting two Fabric I rectangles between the three blocks.

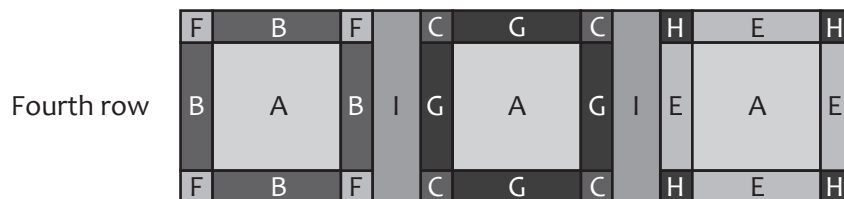
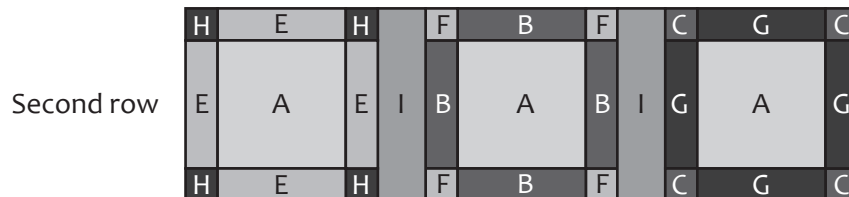
Pay close attention to the direction and placement of the blocks.

Sew together and press toward Fabric I.



Repeat previous steps for the second, third, and fourth rows, assembling the blocks as shown below. Pay close attention to the direction and placement of the blocks.

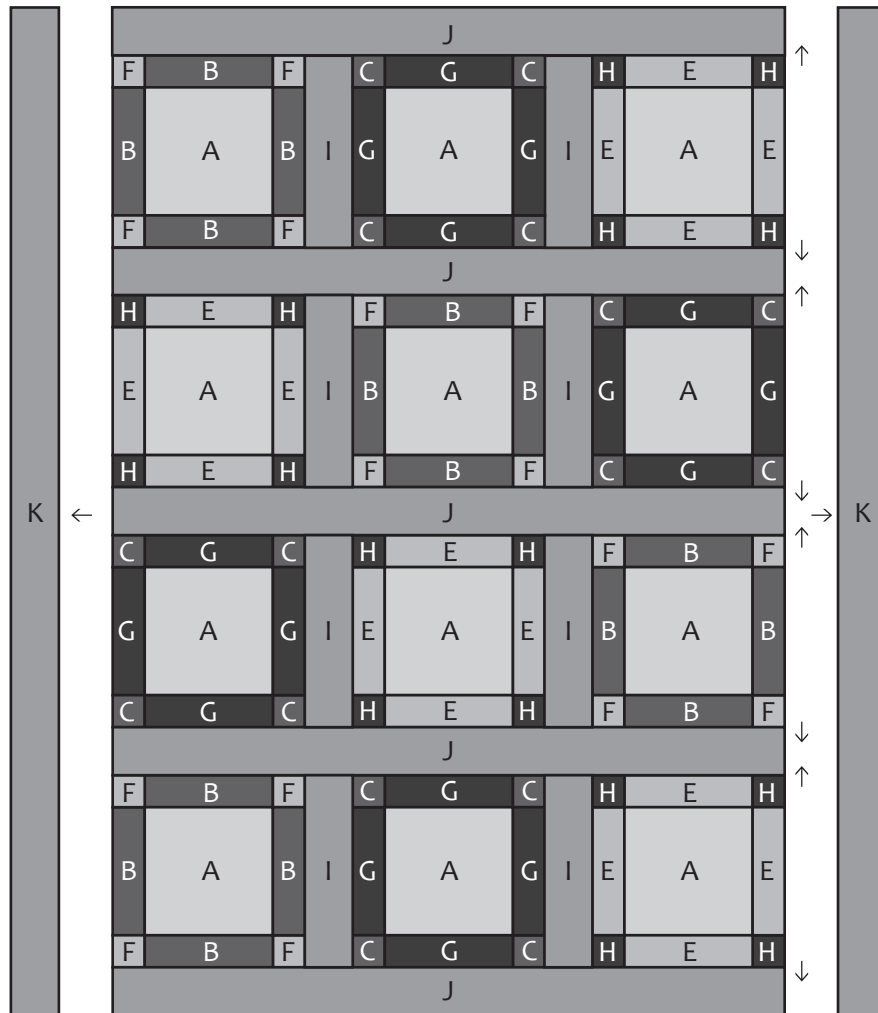
Sew together and press toward Fabric I.



What Do You See? Quilt Pattern

Layout the rows and five Fabric J strips as shown below. Sew together, pressing toward Fabric J. Pay close attention to the direction and placement of each row.

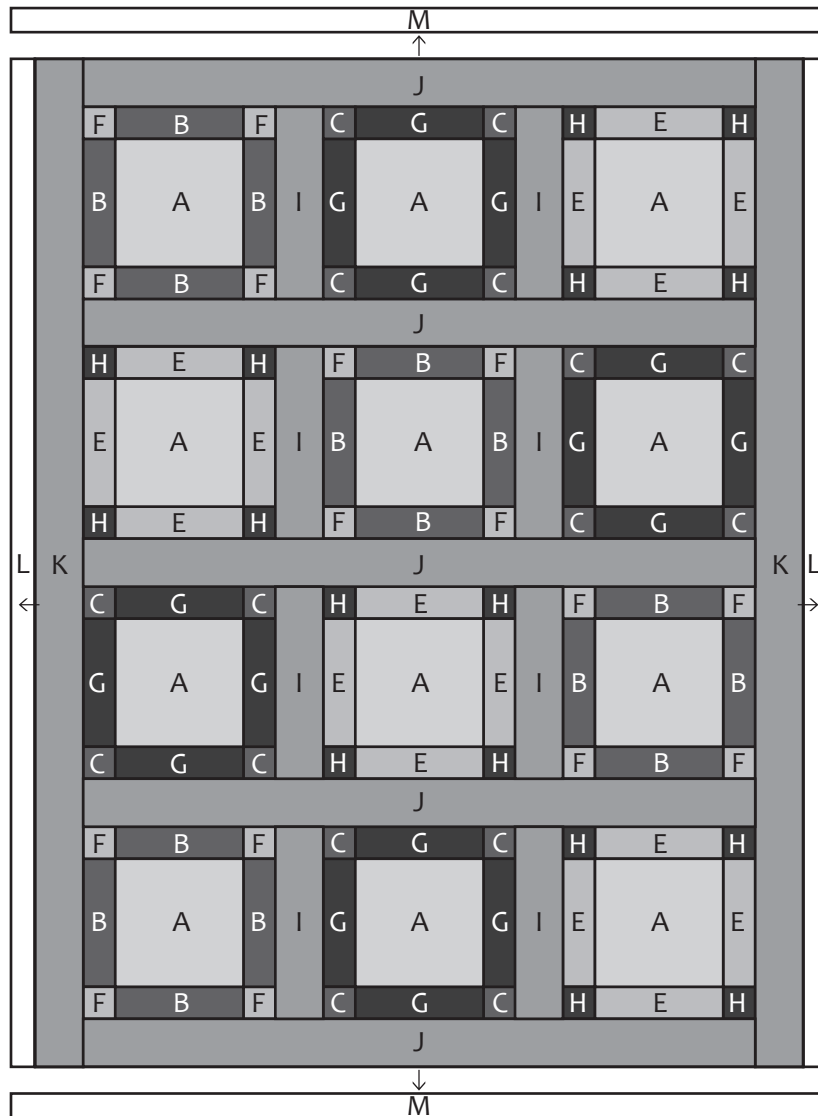
Attach two Fabric K strips on either side of the quilt center, pressing toward Fabric K.



What Do You See? Quilt Pattern

Sew two Fabric L strips to the sides of the quilt. Press toward Fabric L.

Sew two Fabric M strips to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward Fabric M.



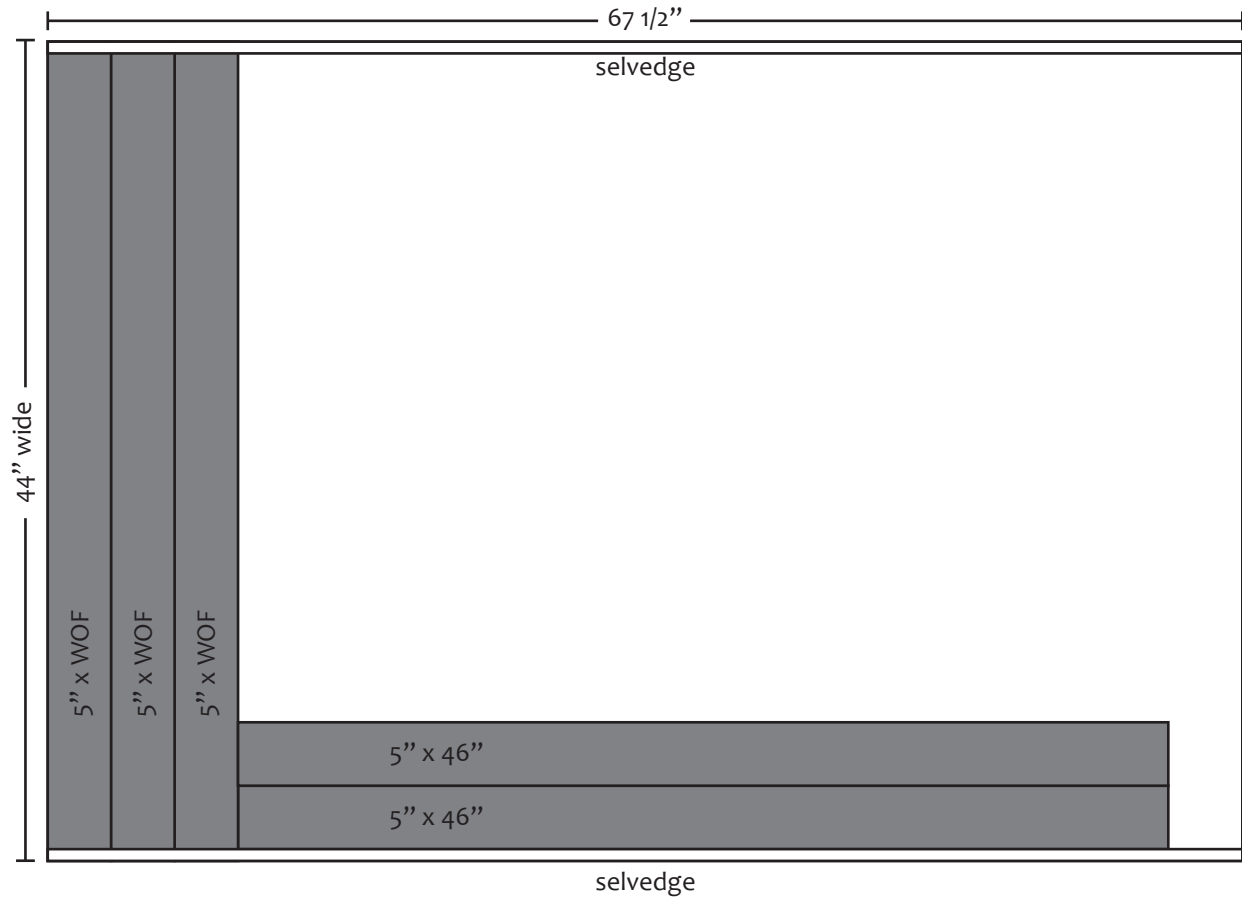
What Do You See? Quilt Pattern

Cut outer border fabrics according to the diagram below. **Pay close attention to the direction of the print.**

First cut 3 – 5" x WOF strips as shown. These will be for Fabric O, the top and bottom borders.

Then cut 2 – 5" x 46" strips across the length of the fabric as shown. These are Fabric N, the side borders.

Piece the 3 – 5" x WOF strips together end to end and subcut into 2 – 5" x 44 3/4" for Fabric O.

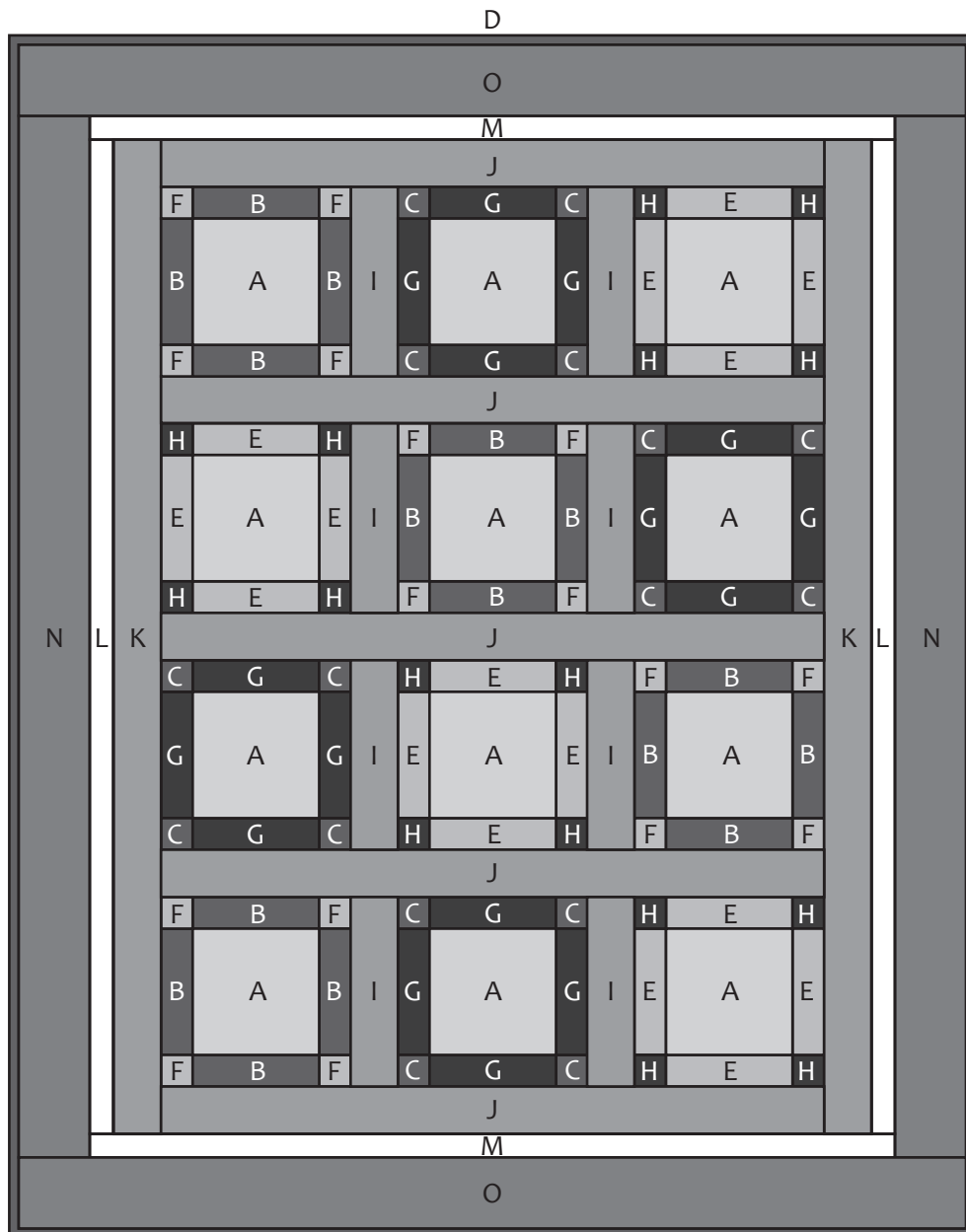


What Do You See? Quilt Pattern

Sew two Fabric N rectangles to the sides of the quilt. Pay close attention to the direction of the print. Press toward Fabric N.

Sew two Fabric O rectangles to the sides of the quilt. Pay close attention to the direction of the print. Press toward Fabric O.

Quilt and bind as desired.
