Materials

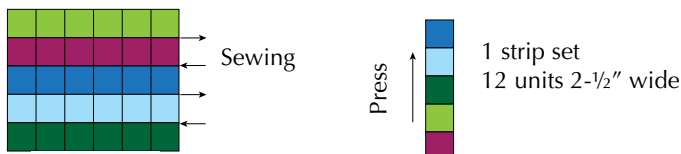
Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

- 2/3 Yard or one Panel - (Y0216-1)
- 1/3 Yard - Small Snowflake, blue (Y0221-1)
- 1/2 Yard - Tonal Swirl, blue (Y0218-1)
- 1/2 Yard - Tonal Swirl, aqua (Y0218-2)
- 1 Yard - Tonal Swirl, plum (Y0218-3), includes binding
- 1/2 Yard - Tonal Swirl, green (Y0218-4)
- 1/2 Yard - Tonal Swirl, lt. green (Y0218-5)
- 1 2/3 Yard - Stripe (Y0217-1)
- 3 1/2 Yards backing of your choice

Directions

Use 1/4" seam allowances and press in the directions indicated by arrows.

1. Sew the 2-1/2" wide inner border strips to the top and bottom of the panel section, trim, and press toward the inner border. Sew the 3-1/2" strips to the sides of the panel section, trim, and press toward the inner border. **Trim unit to measure 25-1/2" x 25-1/2" square.**
2. Carefully make the following strip sets. Sew seams in alternate directions to keep seams from stretching and turning strip set into an arc. (Sewing direction is indicated by short arrows.) Press and sub-cut sets into number of units as shown. Strip sets are about 40" long.



Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric
LOF = Length of Fabric

From the Panel cut:

Trim panel so opposite sides are parallel to each other, at least 1/2" outside the frames on the outer edges. (21" x 22-1/2")

From the Small Snowflake fabric (for inner border) cut:

- 1 strip, 2-1/2" x WOF, cut into:
- 2 - 2-1/2" x 21" strips
- 2 strips, 3-1/2" x WOF

From each of the five tonal swirls cut:

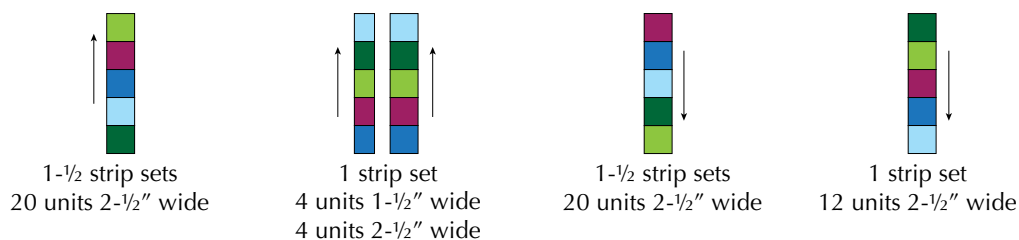
- 6 strips 2-1/2" x WOF

From the stripe cut:

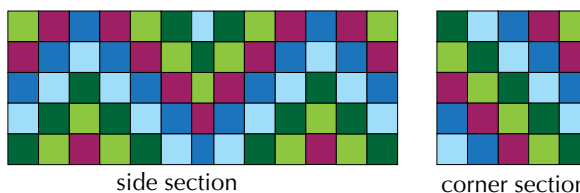
4 sections 5-1/2" x LOF, cut the same section/motif for each of the four sides of the wall hanging

From the binding fabric, cut:

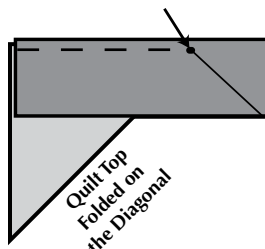
- 6 strips, 2-1/2" x WOF



3. Carefully make four each of the side and corner sections. Sew two side sections onto opposite sides of the center panel unit, press toward the panel unit. Piece the corner units onto each end of the remaining side sections and press toward corners. Sew to top and bottom of the panel, press toward the panel.



4. Add outer border strip, mitering corners to create the illusion that the snowmen are dancing all around the edge of the quilt top! To miter each corner, fold the quilt top on a diagonal, back sides together. **This should line up the strips from adjacent sides.**



5. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in figure above) draw a 45° line out to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.
6. Layer with batting and backing, quilt as desired and bind.

(Optional idea, purchase 5/8 yard of snowman toss Y0219 or snowflake Y0220 and cut 4 squares, 10-1/2" x 10-1/2" to use in corners instead of the bargello corners. You will need 4 fewer 2-1/2" cuts from each of the strip sets when you are doing this version.)
