
From 3  $\frac{1}{2}$  yards of backing fabric:

Finished Size: 40 1/2" x 52 1/2"

Cutting Instructions:	
om % yard	of white background fabric:
- Cut 2	2 ½" x 8 ½" rectangles
- Cut 2	2" x 15 ½" strips
- Cut 3	1 ½" x 14 ½" strips
- Cut 2	1 ½" x 28 ½" strips (second borders)
- Cut 2	1 ½" x 18 ½" strips (second borders)
- Cut 2	$1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips (fourth borders)
- Cut 2	1 ½" x 32 ½" strips (fourth borders)
From 1/4 yar	d of fabric for first border:
- Cut 2	1 ½" x 26 ½" strips
- Cut 2	1 ½" x 16 ½" strips
From 1 yar	d of fabric for fifth border:
- Cut 5	4 ½" x width of fabric strips

2 ½" x width of fabric strips

25 ¾" x 62 ½" rectangles




In Lori's and Kimberly's version the sashing and border measurements are cut exactly the same ... the only difference is how it is sewn together!

#### Quilt Center:

Assemble two 2" x 15  $\frac{1}{2}$ " white background strips and the Filled Basket Block.

Bordered Basket Block Unit should measure  $14 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $15 \frac{1}{2}$ ".


Make one.




Assemble two 2 ½" x 8 ½" white background rectangles and the Yarn and Crochet Hook Block.

Bordered Yarn and Crochet Hook Block Unit should measure 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 14  $\frac{1}{2}$ ".


Make one.





Assemble three 1 ½" x 14 ½" white background strips, the Bordered Basket Block Unit and the Bordered Yarn and Crochet Hook Block Unit.


Quilt Center should measure 14 1/2" x 26 1/2".



#### First Border:

Attach side first borders using the 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 26  $\frac{1}{2}$ " scrappy strips.


Attach top and bottom first borders using the  $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $16 \frac{1}{2}$ " scrappy strips.



#### Second Border:

Attach side second borders using the 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 28  $\frac{1}{2}$ " white background strips.

Attach top and bottom second borders using the  $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $18 \frac{1}{2}$ " white background strips.




#### Third Border:

Assemble five Mama Blocks.


Third Border Strip should measure 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30  $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Make four.



Attach side third borders using two Third Border Strips.


Attach top and bottom third borders using two Third Border Strips.



#### Fourth Border:

Attach side fourth borders using the 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42  $\frac{1}{2}$ " white background strips.

Attach top and bottom fourth borders using the 1 ½" x 32 ½" white background strips.



#### Fifth Border:


Piece the 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " fifth border strips end to end.

#### Subcut into:

- 2 4 ½" x 44 ½" strips
- 2 4 ½" x 40 ½" strips

Attach side fifth borders using the  $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $44 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Attach top and bottom fifth borders using the  $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $40 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.



### Finishing:

Piece the  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric binding strips end to end for binding.

Quilt and bind as desired.
