Requirements:

1 print Jelly Roll 1 solid Jellu Roll

% yard binding (or 6 Jelly Roll strips for scrappy look)

3 ¼ uards backing

12" Log Cabin Quilt Block Foundation Paper Pad

Cutting & Placement:

Refer to the paper pad instructions for placement cutting sizes.

From the print Jelly Roll, select 16 dark strips and 8 medium strips.

Cut from each of 16 dark strips -

(1) Placement 4, 5, 12 and 13

Cut from 8 medium strips -

(2) Placement 1, 8 and 9

From the solid Jelly Roll, select 17 strips.


Cut from each of 16 solid strips -

(1) Placement 3 6 7 10 and 11

Cut from 1 solid strip -


(16) Placement 2

Assemble 16 blocks according to the instructions, using one medium and one dark print per block.



Finished size: 48 1/2" x 48 1/2"

Assemble four blocks as shown. Repeat three times to make four quadrants.
