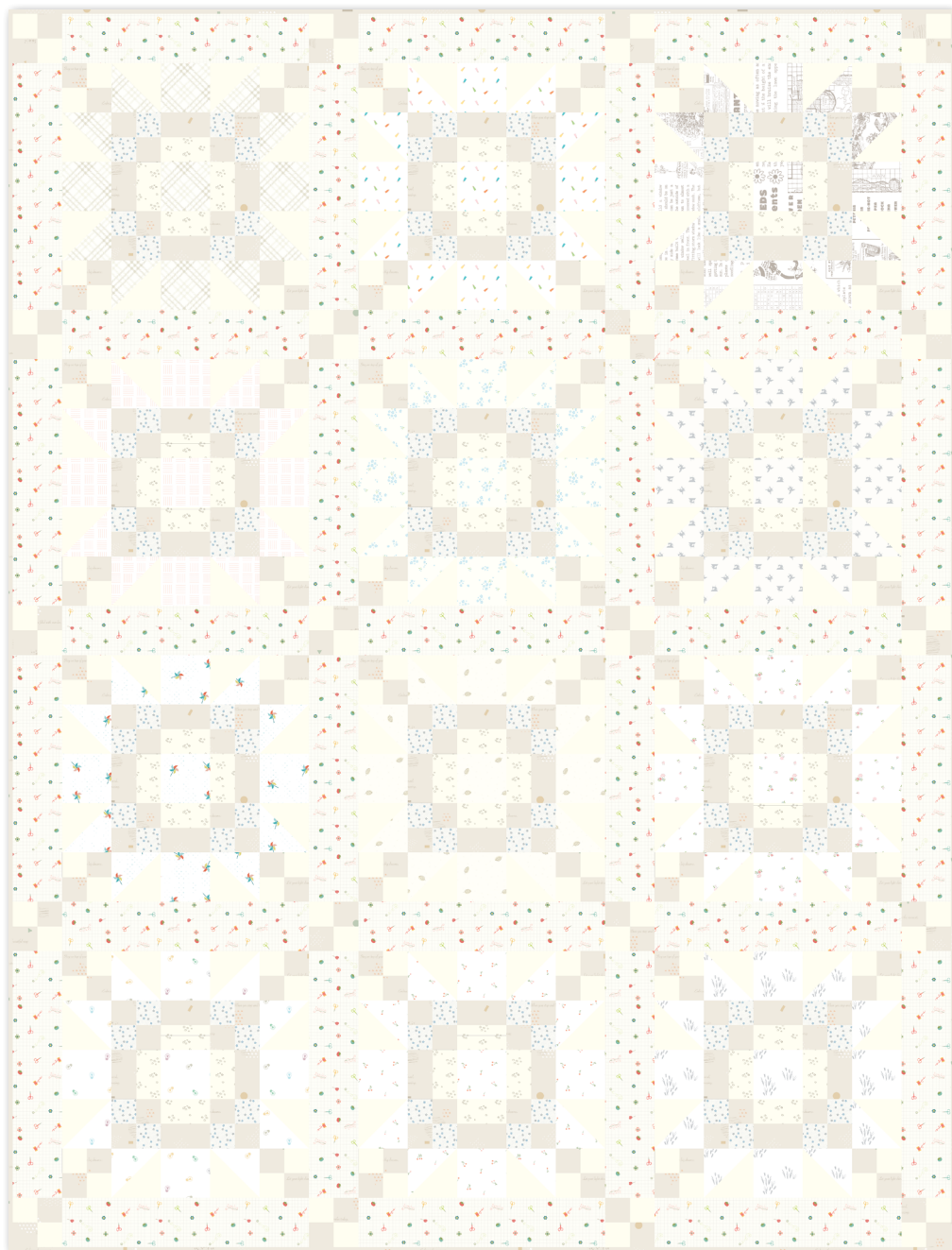

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 57" x 75"

Please read all instructions before beginning the project.
Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

WOF = Width of Fabric
RST = Right Sides Together
HST = Half Square Triangle

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

All fabrics are from the Hush Hush 3 collection unless otherwise indicated.

Oops-a-Daisy (C14060-OOPS)

1 $\frac{1}{8}$ yards Confetti Cottons Vintage White
(C120-VINTAGEWHITE)

1 $\frac{1}{8}$ yard Stitch is Life (C14079-STITCH)

1 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards Big Dreams (C14075-BIG)*

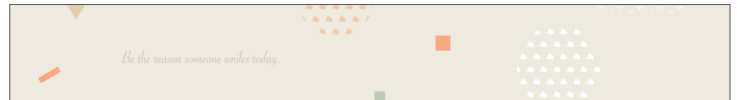

OTHER SUPPLIES

1 $\frac{1}{8}$ yards WIDEBACK backing fabric of your choice
Basic Sewing Supplies
Batting (65" x 83")

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all pattern instructions before cutting fabrics. Use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter to cut your fabrics and label all cuts as noted.



Big Dreams

Cut (16) 2" x WOF strips, label A.

Cut (7) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips, put aside for binding.



Confetti Cottons Vintage White

Cut (7) 2" x WOF strips, label B.

Cut (3) 8" x WOF strips; subcut:
(12) 8" x 8" squares, label C.



Oops-a-Daisy

Cut (5) 2" x WOF strips, label D.



Dots It!

Cut (4) 2" x WOF strips, label E.



Stitch is Life

Cut (3) 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips, subcut.
(31) 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, label F.



Fat Quarters

Cut (1) 8" x 21" strip, subcut:
(1) 8" x 8" square, label G
(5) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, label H.

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ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

SEWING TECHNIQUES

Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Sew with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise stated. Refer to the quilt photo for placement of the prints. Press seams as noted in each step for best results. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes unless stated otherwise.

Strip Sets

- Take (1) A strip and (1) B strip and sew together lengthwise to make Strip Set A, which should measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Make (7) Strip Set A's.



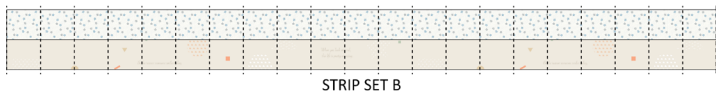
- Subcut each Strip Set A into (21) 2 " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " units for a total of (136) units, label I.



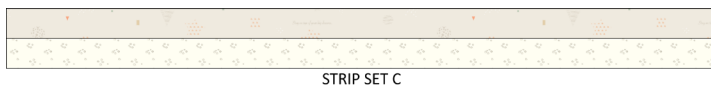
- Take (1) A strip and (1) D strip and sew together lengthwise to make Strip Set B, which should measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Make (5) Strip Set B's.



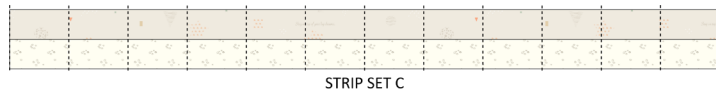
- Subcut each Strip Set B into (21) 2 " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " units for a total of (96) units, label J.



- Take (1) A strip and (1) E strip and sew together lengthwise to make Strip Set C, which should measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Make (4) Strip Set C's.

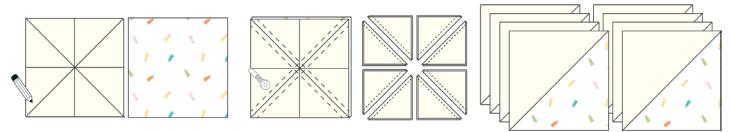


- Subcut each Strip Set C into (12) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " units for a total of (48) units, label K.



8 at a time Half-Square Triangles

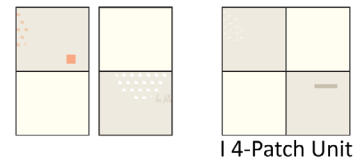
- Place a (1) C square and G square, RST. Draw (2) diagonal, (1) horizontal, and (1) vertical lines on the wrong side of one square. Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the drawn *diagonal* lines. Cut on the drawn lines to create (8) HSTs. Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Make (96) total C/G HST Units.



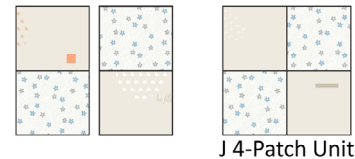
BLOCK ASSEMBLY

4-Patch Assembly

- Lay out (2) I units as shown. Sew together to make a 4-Patch. 4-Patch should measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Make (68) I 4-Patch units.

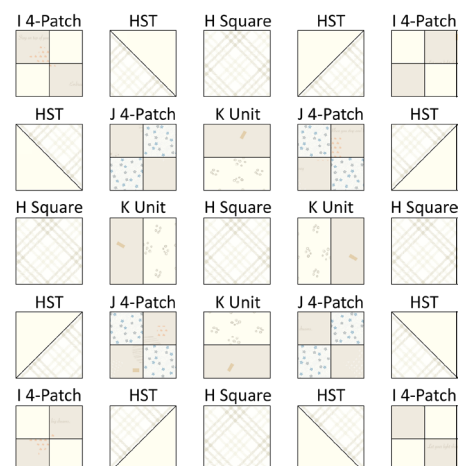


- Lay out (2) J units as shown. Sew together to make a 4-Patch. 4-Patch should measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Make (48) J 4-Patch units.



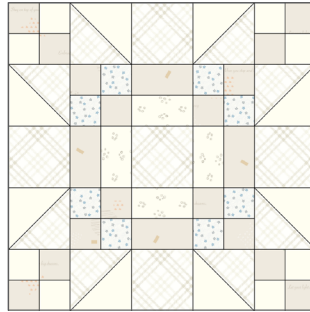
Main Block

- Lay out (5) H squares, (8) HSTs of the same print, (4) K units, (4) J 4-Patch units, and (4) I 4-Patch units as shown.

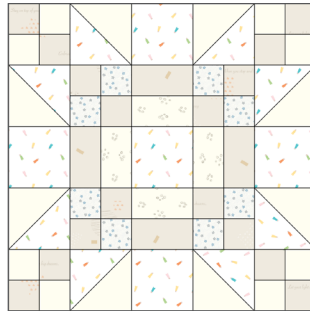


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11. Sew together the blocks to make rows. Press the seams of each row in opposite directions. Sew together the rows to make a Main Block. Main Block should measure 15 ½" x 15 ½" unfinished.

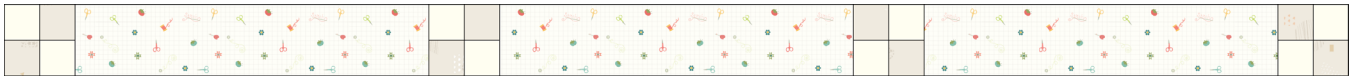


12. Repeat to make (12) Main Blocks ensuring that the H squares and HSTs are the same print in each Main Block.



Horizontal Sashing

13. Lay out (4) I 4-Patch units and (3) F rectangles as shown. Sew together to make a Horizontal Sashing Strip. Press seams toward the I 4-Patch units. Strip should measure 57 ½" x 3 ½" unfinished. Repeat to make (5) Horizontal Sashing Strips.



14. Lay out the (5) Horizontal Sashing Strips, (12) Main Blocks, and (16) F rectangles as shown on the Quilt Layout Diagram.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

15. Sew together the Main Blocks and F rectangles to make (4) rows. Press seams toward the Main Blocks.
16. Sew together the Horizontal Sashing Strips and the rows to make the quilt top.

Your quilt top should measure 57 ½" x 75 ½" unfinished.

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Bind with the (7) Big Dreams strips.
