VINTAGE VALENTINE PATCH

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 44¾" x 63"

Measurements include ¼-inch seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric.

WOF = Width of Fabric

LOF = Length of Fabric

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabrics are from the All My Heart collection by J. Wecker Frisch for Riley Blake Designs.

- 1 Valentine Ads Patch Panel (PD14130-PANEL)
- 1 Valentine Greetings Patch Panel (PD14131-PANEL)
- 3 yards White Trimmings Border Stripe (C14132-WHITE)
- 1⅞ yards Pink Love Letters (C14139-PINK)
- ⅝ yard Black Candy Wraps (C14143-BLACK) for Binding
- 1½ yards Wide Back backing of your choice

OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies

⅝ yard of 20"-wide Fusible Webbing
Batting (53" x 71")

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all pattern instructions before cutting fabrics. Refer to the quilt photo for the placement of fabrics. Use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter to cut your fabrics.

Valentine Ads Patch Panel

Fussy-cut (6) 10" squares.

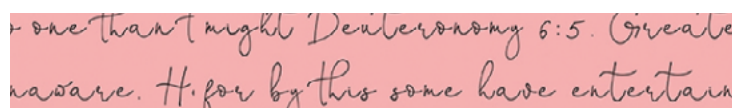

White Trimmings Border Stripe

Fussy-cut (24) 3" x 18" strips.

Pink Love Letters

Cut in the order listed. Note the WOF & LOF cuts.

- (3) 6½" x WOF strips C
- (2) 6½" x 45¼" LOF strips. D
- (2) 4¼" x 33¼" LOF strips. E
- (3) 4¼" x 15" WOF rectangles F



Black Candy Wraps

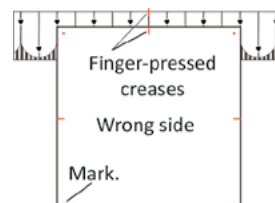
Cut (6) 2½" x WOF strips for binding.

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

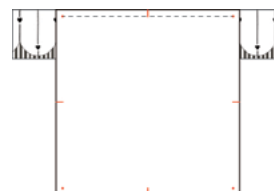
Refer to the quilt photo for the placement of prints.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Finger press a crease at the center of each side of fussy-cut square A. Do the same with (4) B strips along the edge facing the square. On the wrong side of A, mark ¼" from each corner.



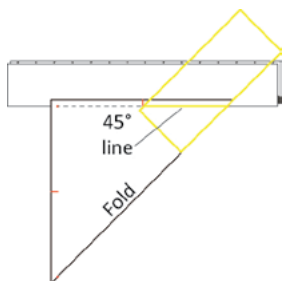
2. Match the crease of a B strip to the crease on one side of square A. Sew the strip to the square between the (2) marks on that side, backstitching at each end.



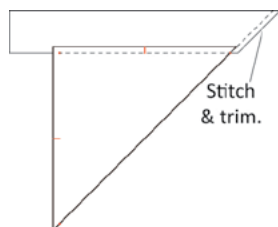
3. Repeat Step 2, adding a B strip to each side, making sure all strips are facing toward the center in a similar manner.

4. Fold square A wrong sides together diagonally and line up (2) adjacent B strips. Place a ruler's 45° angle line along the line of stitching and draw a line from the marked corner across the C rectangles.



5. Stitch on the angled line backstitching at the marked corner. Check to see that the corner lies flat and straight before trimming the excess fabric $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the stitching. Press the angled seam open and the seams around the square toward the outside.



6. Repeat Steps 2–5 at each corner of the square to complete the mitered Framed Block, measuring 15" square. Make 6 Framed Blocks.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Please refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram on page 4.

7. Sew (2) Framed Blocks together with an F rectangle in between to make a row. Make (3) rows, each measuring $33\frac{1}{4}$ " \times 15".
8. Sew (3) rows together top to bottom with (2) E strips, alternating positions, to make the quilt center, now measuring $33\frac{1}{4}$ " \times $51\frac{1}{2}$ ".
9. Sew (3) C strips together end-to-end. From the strip cut (2) side borders $51\frac{1}{2}$ " in length. Attach the side borders to the quilt center, now measuring $45\frac{1}{4}$ " \times $51\frac{1}{2}$ ".

10. Attach the D strips to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top. Quilt now measures $45\frac{1}{4}$ " \times $63\frac{1}{2}$ ".

STAMP EMBELLISHMENTS

11. Cut out (7) stamps from the Valentine's Greetings Patch Panel following the dashed lines printed on the panel fabric.
12. Cut (7) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " squares of fusible webbing.
13. Following the manufacturer's instructions, center and fuse the $5\frac{1}{2}$ " webbing squares, glue side down, to the wrong side of the stamps. The fusible webbing should fit within the edges of the fabric in order to keep the ironing surface free of glue.
14. Working from the right side, fussy-cut each stamp as desired between $4\frac{1}{2}$ "–5" square depending on how much white border you want around the perimeter. Or, you may decide to cut along the edge of the printed image, it's up to you.
15. Fuse the stamps to the quilt top as desired and machine stitch around each stamp with a straight, zig-zag or blanket stitch in matching thread.

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Bind with the Black Candy Wraps binding strips.
