LAP QUILT

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

• One Print Layer Cake or 36 - 10" print squares Shop Layer Cakes at:




• One Solid Layer Cake or 36 - 10" solid squares Shop Layer Cakes at:

- ⅓ yard background
- 5/8 yard binding
- 4 yards backing

Layer Cake cutting diagrams:





CUTTING

- Cut thirty-six 10" print squares into:
 - 2 4" squares 72 total (Fabric A)
 - 2 3 1/2" squares 72 total (Fabric B)
- Cut thirty-six 10" solid squares into:
 - 2 4" squares 72 total (Fabric C)
 - 1 3 ½" x 9 ½" rectangle 36 total (Fabric D)
- Cut background fabric into:
 - 7 3 ½" x width of fabric strips (Fabric E)
- Cut binding fabric into:
 - 7 2 ½" x width of fabric strips (Fabric F)

Use 1/4" seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric C squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric C square with a Fabric A square.

Stitch 1/4" from each side of the drawn line.

Cut apart on the marked line.

Trim Half Square Triangle Unit to measure 3 ½" x 3 ½".







Make one-hundred forty-four.

Assemble two matching Half Square Triangle Units and one Fabric B square. Pay close attention to unit placement.

Espresso Unit should measure 3 1/2" x 9 1/2".







Ready. Set. Sew!

Assemble two Espresso Units and one Fabric D rectangle. Rotate bottom unit so seams nest.


Cappuccino Unit should measure 9 1/2" x 9 1/2".






Assemble Block. Pay close attention to unit placement.

Latte Block should measure 18 1/2" x 18 1/2".






Make nine.

QUILT CENTER:

Assemble Quilt Center. Rotate blocks so seams nest. Press rows in opposite directions.

Quilt Center should measure 54 1/2" x 54 1/2".



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BORDER:


Piece the Fabric E strips end to end and subcut into:

- 2 3 1/2" x 54 1/2" strips (Side Borders E1)
- 2 3 1/2" x 60 1/2" strips (Top and Bottom

Borders - E2)

Attach the Side Borders.

Attach the Top and Bottom Borders.

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EXTRA QUILT SIZES

To make the quilt in different sizes, follow the Cutting and Quilt Assembly Instructions for the size quilt you have chosen and refer to pages 1 and 2 for the Block Assembly.

CRIB QUILT

Finished Size: 42 1/2" x 42 1/2"

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- One Print Layer Cake or 16 10" print squares*
 Shop Layer Cakes at:

- One Solid Layer Cake or 16 10" solid squares*
 Shop Layer Cakes at:

- 5/8 yard background
- 1/2 yard binding
- 3 yards backing

CUTTING

- Cut sixteen 10" print squares into:
 - 2 4" squares 32 total (Fabric A)
 - 2 3 1/2" squares 32 total (Fabric B)
- Cut sixteen 10" solid squares into:
 - 2 4" squares 32 total (Fabric C)
 - 1 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangle 16 total (Fabric D)
- Cut background fabric into:
 - 2 3 ½" x 36 ½" strips (Fabric E1)
 - 3 3 ½" x width of fabric strips (Fabric E2)
- Cut binding fabric into:
 - 5 2 ½" x width of fabric strips (Fabric F)

QUILT ASSEMBLY AND BORDER:

Make four Layer Cake Latte Blocks.

Assemble Quilt Center. Rotate blocks so seams nest.


Press rows in opposite directions and then press down.

Quilt Center should measure 36 1/2" x 36 1/2".

Piece the Fabric E2 strips end to end and subcut into:

2 - 3 ½" x 42 ½" strips (Top and Bottom Borders - E2)

Attach side borders using the Fabric E1 strips. Attach the Top and Bottom Borders.



FINISHING:

^{*}This size would be perfect for a Junior Layer Cake.



TWIN QUILT

Finished Size: 66 1/2" x 84 1/2"

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Two Print Layer Cakes or 48 - 10" print squares
 Shop Layer Cakes at:

 Two Solid Layer Cakes or 48 - 10" solid squares Shop Layer Cakes at: www.fatquartershop.com/layer-cakes

- 1 5/8 yards background
- 1/8 yard binding
- 5 1/4 yards backing

CUTTING

- Cut forty-eight 10" print squares into:
 - 2 4" squares 96 total (Fabric A)
 - 2 3 1/2" squares 96 total (Fabric B)
- Cut forty-eight 10" solid squares into:
 - 2 4" squares 96 total (Fabric C)
 - 1 3 ½" x 9 ½" rectangle 48 total (Fabric D)
- Cut background fabric into:
 - 8 6 1/2" x width of fabric strips (Fabric E)
- Cut binding fabric into:
 - 9 2 ½" x width of fabric strips (Fabric F)

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QUILT ASSEMBLY AND BORDER:

Make twelve Layer Cake Latte Blocks.

Assemble Quilt Center. Rotate blocks so seams nest.

Press rows in opposite directions and then press down.


Quilt Center should measure 54 1/2" x 72 1/2".

Piece the Fabric E strips end to end and subcut into:

- 2 6 1/2" x 72 1/2" strips (Side Borders E1)
- 2 6 ½" x 66 ½" strips (Top and Bottom Borders E2)

Attach the Side Borders.

Attach the Top and Bottom Borders.

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QUEEN QUILT

Finished Size: 84 1/2" x 84 1/2"

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- Two Print Layer Cakes or 64 10" print squares Shop Layer Cakes at: www.fatguartershop.com/layer-cakes
- Two Solid Layer Cakes or 64 10" solid squares
 Shop Layer Cakes at:
 www.fatquartershop.com/layer-cakes
- 2 yards background
- 1/8 yard binding
- 7 1/8 yards backing

CUTTING

- Cut sixty-four 10" print squares into:
 - 2 4" squares 128 total (Fabric A)
 - 2 3 ½" squares 128 total (Fabric B)
- Cut sixty-four 10" solid squares into:
 - 2 4" squares 128 total (Fabric C)
 - 1 3 ½" x 9 ½" rectangle 64 total (Fabric D)
- Cut background fabric into:
 - 10 6 ½" width of fabric strips (Fabric E)
- Cut binding fabric into:
 - 10 2 1/2" x width of fabric strips (Fabric F)

QUILT ASSEMBLY AND BORDER:

Make sixteen Layer Cake Latte Blocks.

Assemble Quilt Center. Rotate blocks so seams nest.

Press rows in opposite directions and then press down.


Quilt Center should measure 72 1/2" x 72 1/2".

Piece the Fabric E strips end to end and subcut into:

- 2 6 1/2" x 72 1/2" strips (Side Borders E1)
- 2 6 ½" x 84 ½" strips (Top and Bottom Borders E2)

Attach the Side Borders.

Attach the Top and Bottom Borders.
