Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.

Always verify your panel size before beginning. If your panel measurements differ from those given in the pattern, trim to the desired size or use coping strips to alter the size of your panel. If coping strips are needed, add oversized, coordinating strips of fabric to the necessary edges of the panel, then trim to the size specified in the pattern.

WOF = Width of Fabric

RST = Right Sides Together

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

All fabrics from the Barbie World™ collection unless stated otherwise.

(1) PD15026-PANEL Power of Possibilities Barbie™ Panel
¾ yard C730-ALLTHEPINK Blossom
¾ yard CD15023-PINK Ken Dolls
¾ yard C15022-POWDER Barbie™ Stripe
¾ yard CD15020-HOTPINK Barbie™ Main
¾ yard C15025-TEAL Barbie™ Glasses (includes binding)

OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies

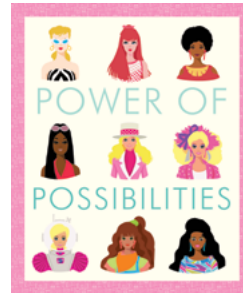
1 ¾ yards Wide Back backing fabric of your choice
(suggested WB200-CARNATION Shades)

Batting

Fusible Web

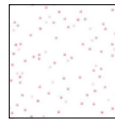
CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



Power of Possibilities Barbie™ Panel

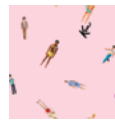
Fussy cut (1) Panel 35 ½" × 42 ½", centered over the motif as shown.



All the Pink Blossom

Cut (1) 8 ½" × WOF strip; subcut:

(4) 8 ½" × 8 ½" squares. Label as A.



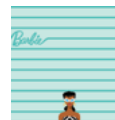
Pink Ken Dolls

Cut (2) 3 ½" × WOF strips; subcut:

(2) 3 ½" × 41 ½" strips. Label as B for top/bottom inner borders.

Cut (3) 3 ½" × WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

(2) 3 ½" × 42 ½" strips. Label as C for side inner borders.



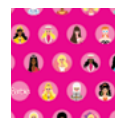
Powder Barbie™ Stripe

Cut (2) 3 ½" × WOF strips; subcut:

(2) 3 ½" × 41 ½" strips. Label as D for top/bottom outer borders.

Cut (3) 3 ½" × WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

(2) 3 ½" × 48 ½" strips. Label as E for side outer borders.



Hot Pink Barbie™ Main

Cut (2) 5 ½" × WOF strips; subcut:

(2) 5 ½" × 41 ½" strips. Label as F for top/bottom outer borders.

Cut (3) 5 ½" × WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

(2) 5 ½" × 48 ½" strips. Label as G for side outer borders.



Teal Barbie™ Glasses

Cut (1) $8\frac{1}{2}$ " \times WOF strip; subcut:

(4) $8\frac{1}{2}$ " \times $8\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Label as H.

Cut (7) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " \times WOF strips. Set aside for binding.

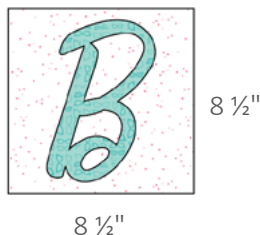
QUILT ASSEMBLY

All seams should be sewn with a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Sew with RST unless stated otherwise. Refer to the quilt layout diagram for placement of the prints. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes unless stated otherwise.

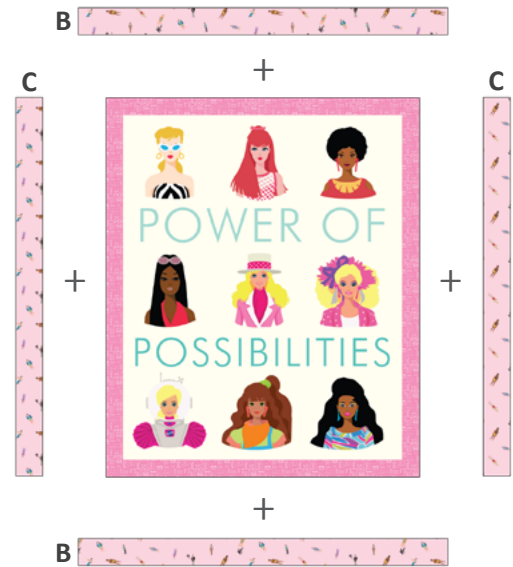
RAW EDGE APPLIQUE

Gather the (4) **A**-squares and (4) **H**-squares. Note that the "B" Template on page 6 is reversed to allow for cutting and tracing onto the wrong side of the fabric.

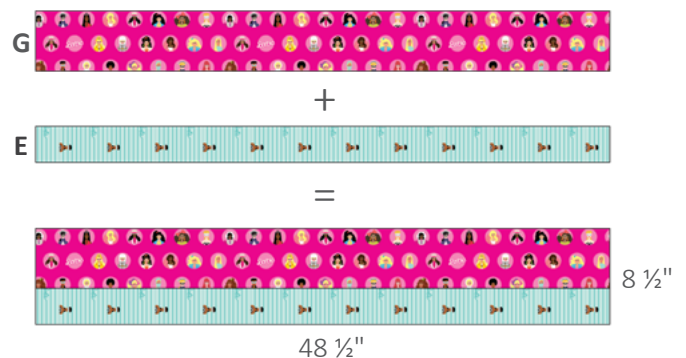
1. Using a lightbox or window, trace the "B" Template (4) times onto the paper side of your chosen fusible web.
2. Roughly cut out the template shapes, about $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the traced edges.
3. Place and center the textured side of each fusible web template onto the wrong side of each **H**-square.
4. Iron the fusible web onto the wrong side of each **H**-square.
5. Cut the shapes out precisely.
6. Peel off the fusible web's paper backing.
7. Place and center the fusible side of each shape to the right side of the **A**-squares.
8. Iron the shapes onto the **A**-squares.
9. Use a straight or zig-zag stitch around the edges of the shape to completely secure each shape in its place. These are the Raw Edge Applique Blocks. Set aside.



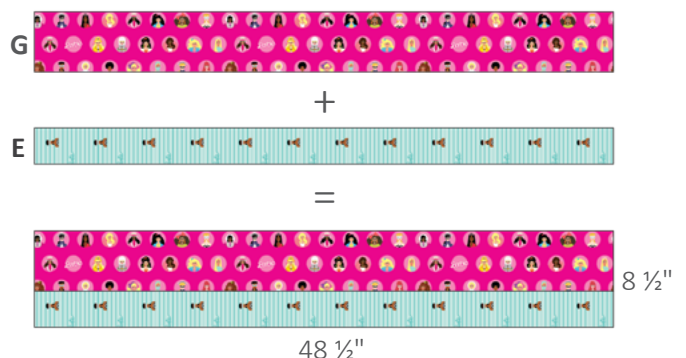
10. Gather the Panel, **B**-strips, and **C**-strips. Sew the **C**-strips to the sides of the Panel. Press toward the **C**-strips. Sew the **B**-strips to the top and bottom of the Panel. Press toward the **B**-strips. Quilt Center should measure $41\frac{1}{2}$ " \times $48\frac{1}{2}$ ". Set aside.



11. Gather (1) **E**-strip and (1) **G**-strip. Sew together as shown below, referencing the diagram for proper placement and orientation. Press. The Left Side Outer Border should measure $8\frac{1}{2}$ " \times $48\frac{1}{2}$ ". Set aside.

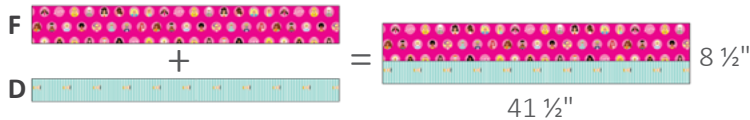


12. Gather (1) **E**-strip and (1) **G**-strip. Sew together as shown below, referencing the diagram for proper placement and orientation. Press. The Right Side Outer Border should measure $8\frac{1}{2}$ " \times $48\frac{1}{2}$ ". Set aside.

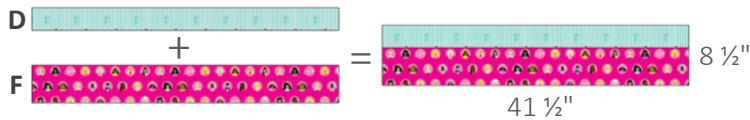


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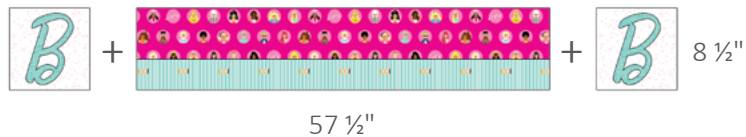
13. Gather (1) **D**-strip and (1) **F**-strip. Sew together as shown below, referencing the diagram for proper placement and orientation. Press. The Top Border Unit should measure $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 41\frac{1}{2}"$. Set aside.



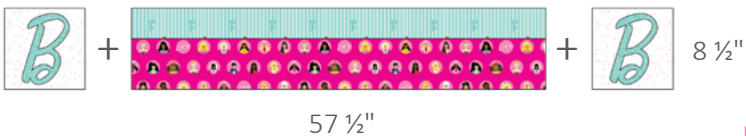
14. Gather (1) **D**-strip and (1) **F**-strip. Sew together as shown below, referencing the diagram for proper placement and orientation. Press. The Bottom Border Unit should measure $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 41\frac{1}{2}"$. Set aside.



15. Gather the Top Border Unit and (2) Raw Edge Applique Blocks. Sew together as shown below, referencing the diagram for proper placement and orientation. Press. The Top Outer Border should measure $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 57\frac{1}{2}"$. Set aside.



16. Gather the Bottom Border Unit and (2) Raw Edge Applique Blocks. Sew together as shown below, referencing the diagram for proper placement and orientation. Press. The Bottom Outer Border should measure $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 57\frac{1}{2}"$. Set aside.



17. Gather the Quilt Center and (2) Side Outer Borders. Sew the Borders to the sides of the Quilt Center as shown at top right. Press. The Quilt Center should measure $48\frac{1}{2}" \times 57\frac{1}{2}"$.



18. Gather the Top and Bottom Outer Borders. Sew the Borders to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center as shown below, referencing the diagram for proper placement and orientation. Press. The Quilt Top should measure $57\frac{1}{2}" \times 64\frac{1}{2}"$.



FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

19. Finish your quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Barbie™ Glasses binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
