Use 1/4" seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

## Thicket Rows:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric D squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric D square with a Fabric M square.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.

First Half Tree Unit should measure 2 1/2" x 2 1/2".

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric D square on the right end of a Fabric L rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam. Second Left Half Tree Unit should measure 2 1/2" x 3 1/2".



Make 1 from each print.  
Make 6 total.



Make 12 total.





# Thicket Quilt Pattern



With right sides facing, layer a Fabric D square on the right end of a Fabric K rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.

Third Left Half Tree Unit should measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Make 1 from each print.  
Make 6 total.



With right sides facing, layer a Fabric D square on the right end of a Fabric J rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.

Fourth Left Half Tree Unit should measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Make 1 from each print.  
Make 6 total.



With right sides facing, layer a Fabric D square on one end of a Fabric H rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.



Repeat on the opposite end.

First Tree Unit should measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Make 24 total.



With right sides facing, layer a Fabric D square on the left end of a Fabric G rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.



Repeat on the right end.

Second Tree Unit should measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Make 24 total.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric D square on the left end of a Fabric F rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.



Repeat on the right end.

Third Tree Unit should measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Make 24 total.



With right sides facing, layer a Fabric D square on the left end of a Fabric E rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.



Repeat on the right end.

Fourth Tree Unit should measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Make 24 total.



With right sides facing, layer a Fabric D square on the left end of a Fabric L rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.

Second Right Half Tree Unit should measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Make 1 from each print.  
Make 6 total.



With right sides facing, layer a Fabric D square on the left end of a Fabric K rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.

Third Right Half Tree Unit should measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Make 1 from each print.  
Make 6 total.



With right sides facing, layer a Fabric D square on the left end of a Fabric J rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.

Fourth Right Half Tree Unit should measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ ".



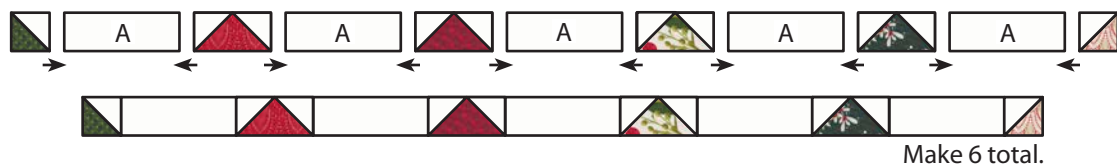
Make 1 from each print.  
Make 6 total.



# *Thicket Quilt Pattern*

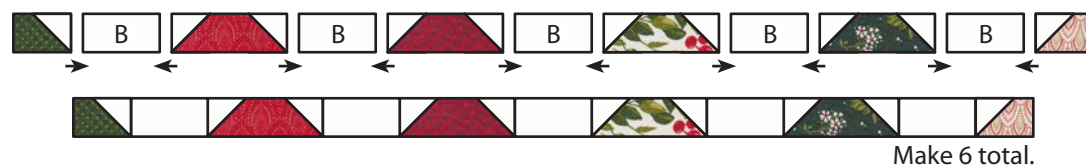
Assemble Unit using quilt diagram for fabric placement.

First Row Unit should measure 2 ½" x 50 ½".



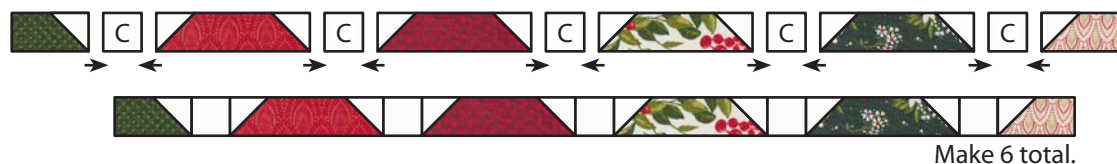
Assemble Unit using quilt diagram for fabric placement.

Second Row Unit should measure 2 ½" x 50 ½".



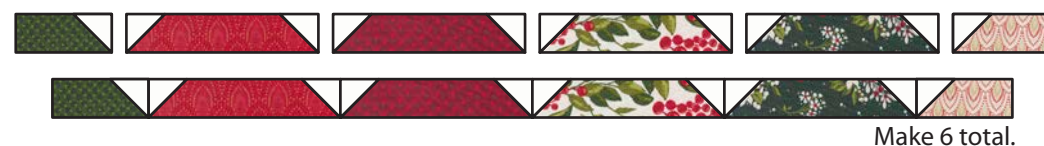
Assemble Unit using quilt diagram for fabric placement.

Third Row Unit should measure 2 ½" x 50 ½".



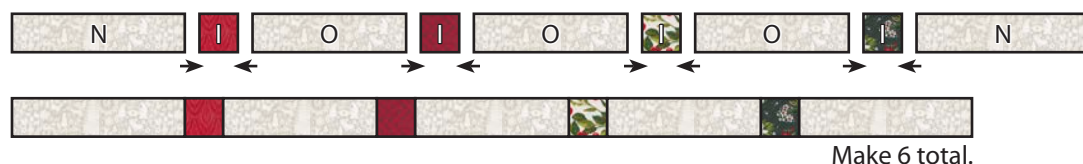
Assemble Unit using quilt diagram for fabric placement. Press open.

Fourth Row Unit should measure 2 ½" x 50 ½".



Assemble Unit using quilt diagram for fabric placement.

Fifth Row Unit should measure 2 ½" x 50 ½".



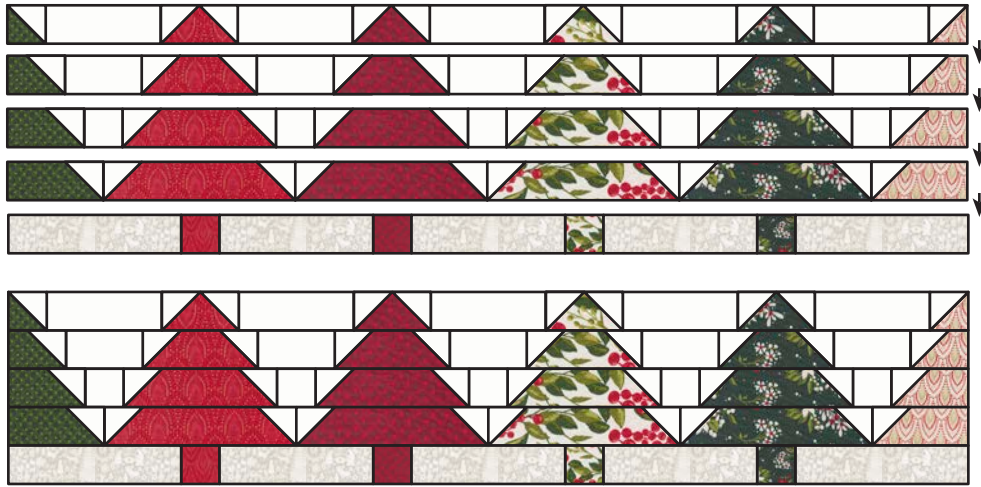


# *Thicket Quilt Pattern*



Assemble Row using quilt diagram for fabric placement.

Thicket Row should measure 10 1/2" x 50 1/2".



Make 6 total.



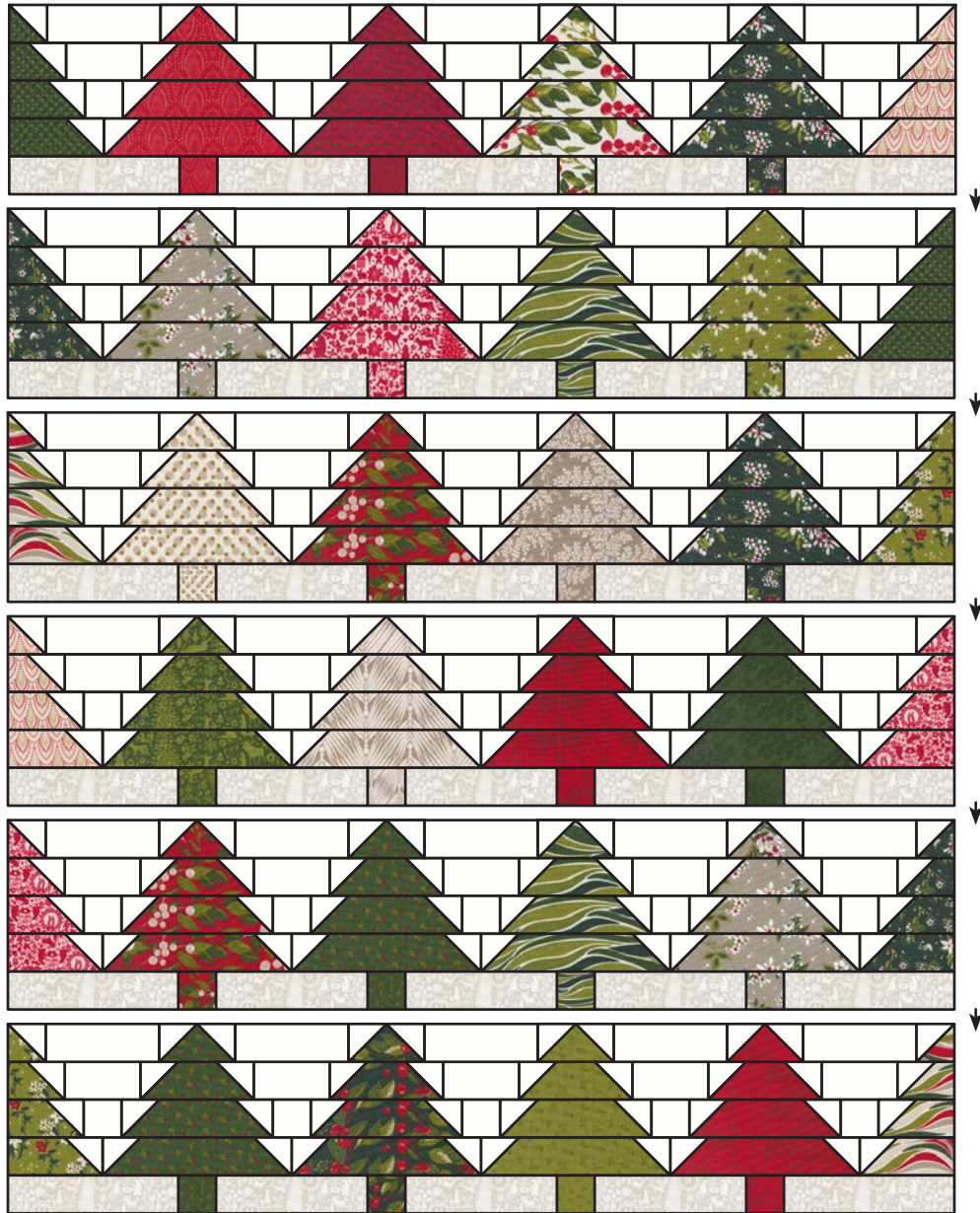
# Thicket Quilt Pattern



## Quilt Center:

Assemble Quilt Center.

Quilt Center should measure 50 ½" x 60 ½".





# Thicket Quilt Pattern



## *Borders:*

Piece the Fabric P strips end to end.

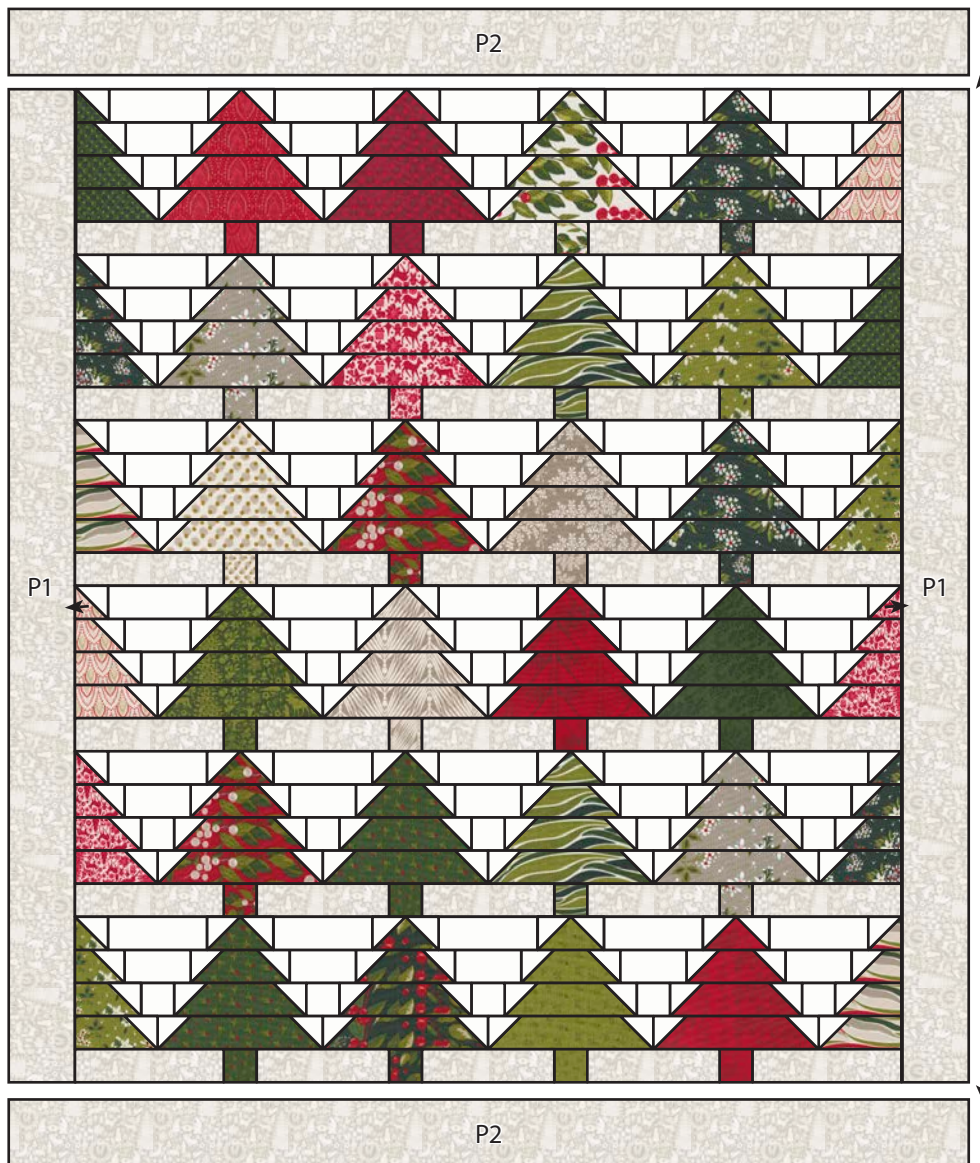
Subcut into:

2 - 4 1/2" x 60 1/2" strips (Side Borders - P1)

2 - 4 1/2" x 58 1/2" strips (Top and Bottom Borders - P2)

Attach the Side Borders.

Attach the Top and Bottom Borders.



## *Finishing:*

Piece the Fabric Q strips end to end for binding.

Quilt and bind as desired.
