Please read all instructions before beginning the project. Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric.

Please note that prewashing can shrink your fabric. Always verify after washing and drying that there is still 42" of usable width available. Shrinkage can affect the size of panel motifs and fussy cutting sizes may need to be adjusted.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check our website for any revisions before starting this project, www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

Measurements include $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance. Sew with RST unless otherwise stated. Refer to the quilt layout diagram for placement of the prints. Press seams as indicated by the pressing arrows in each step for best results. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes unless otherwise stated.

Always verify your panel size before beginning. If your panel measurements differ from those given in the pattern, trim to the desired size or use coping strips to alter the size of your panel. If coping strips are needed, add oversized, coordinating strips of fabric to the necessary edges of the panel, then trim to the size specified in the pattern.

WOF = Width of Fabric RST = Right Sides Together SNF = Stitch and Flip

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all pattern instructions before cutting fabrics. Use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter to cut your fabrics and label all cuts as noted.



Trick-or-Treat Panel

Fussy cut (1) Panel 35 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", centered over the motif.




Orange Cats

Cut (2) $2" \times 6 \%"$ rectangles. Label as A.



Purple Cats

Cut (1) 2" × 5" rectangle. Label as B.



Gold Spiderwebs

Cut (1) $2" \times 8"$ rectangle. Label as C.


Cut (1) $2" \times 3 \frac{1}{2}"$ rectangle. Label as D.



Gold Pumpkins

Cut (1) $2" \times 5"$ rectangle. Label as E.

Cut (1) $2" \times 2 \frac{3}{4}"$ rectangle. Label as F.



Purple Fangs

Cut (1) $2" \times 6 \frac{1}{2}"$ rectangle. Label as G.



Orange Bones

Cut (1) $2" \times 5"$ rectangle. Label as H.



Purple Bones

Cut (1) $2" \times 6 \%"$ rectangle. Label as I.



Gold Skulls

Cut (1) $2" \times 5"$ rectangle. Label as J.

Cut (1) $2'' \times 2 \frac{3}{4}''$ rectangle. Label as K.



Purple Skulls

Cut (1) $2" \times 5"$ rectangle. Label as L.



Black Texture

Cut (1) 8" × WOF strip; subcut:

- (2) $8" \times 11"$ rectangles. Label as M.
- (2) $8" \times 3 \%"$ rectangles. Label as N.

Cut the remainder of the strip into (1) 3 ½" wide strip and (2) 2" wide strips; subcut:

- (2) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 5" rectangles. Label as O.
- (2) $2" \times 3 \frac{1}{2}"$ rectangles. Label as P.
- (8) $2'' \times 2''$ squares. Label as Q.
- (4) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Label as R.

Cut (3) 3 %" × WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

(2) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 45" strips. Label as S.



Orange Stars

Cut (6) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strips for binding.

Cut (1) 2" × WOF strip; subcut:

(1) $2" \times 5"$ rectangle. Label as T.

Cut (4) 1 3/4" × WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

- (2) $1 \frac{3}{4}$ " × 42 ½" strips. Label as U.
- (2) $1\frac{3}{4}$ " × 38" strips. Label as V.



Black Cats

Cut (7) 4 ½" × WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

- (2) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 63 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as W.
- (3) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 45" strips. Label as X.

SEWING TECHNIQUES

General sewing techniques used in this pattern are shown below. These methods will be referenced throughout the pattern in their abbreviated form.

STITCH AND FLIP METHOD (SNF)

Place (2) pieces RST, matching raw edges in the corner to be replaced. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the smaller piece across the corner. Stitch on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance above the sewn line to $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Flip the small piece away from the bottom piece and press, replacing the corner. The size of the larger, original piece does not change.





BLOCK ASSEMBLY


1. Sew (2) U strips to the top and bottom of the Trick-or-Treat Panel as shown. Sew (2) V strips to each side. The Panel Unit should measure 38" × 45".



2. Using the SNF method, attach (1) R square to the top right corner of (1) E rectangle. The B Top Unit should measure 2" × 5".



3. Sew (2) P rectangles and (1) D rectangle together as shown. The B Center Unit should measure 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 5".




4. Using the SNF method, attach (1) R square to the bottom right corner of (1) K rectangle. The unit should measure $2" \times 2 \frac{3}{4}"$.




5. Using the SNF method, attach (1) R square to the top right corner of (1) F rectangle. The unit should measure $2" \times 2 \frac{3}{4}"$.




6. Sew the Step 4 and Step 5 units together as shown to make a unit that should measure $2" \times 5"$. Sew the unit to the right side of the B Center Unit. The B Middle Unit should measure $5" \times 5"$.



7. Using the SNF method, attach (1) R square to the bottom right corner of (1) J rectangle. The B Bottom Unit should measure $2" \times 5"$.




8. Sew (1) B Top Unit, (1) B Middle Unit, and (1) B Bottom Unit together as shown to make a B Side Unit that should measure 5" × 8". Sew the B Side Unit to the right side of (1) C rectangle. The B Block should measure 6 ½" × 8".



9. Using the SNF method, attach (2) Q squares to the top corners of (1) A rectangle. Repeat to make (2) Orange O Top/Bottom Units that should measure 2" × 6 ½".




10. Sew (1) T rectangle, (1) O rectangle, and (1) H rectangle together as shown. The Orange O Center Unit should measure $5" \times 6 \%"$.




11. Sew (2) Orange O Top/Bottom Units and (1) Orange O Center Unit together as shown. The Orange O Block should measure 6 ½" × 8".




12. Using the SNF method, attach (2) Q squares to the top corners of (1) I rectangle. The Purple O Top Unit should measure $2" \times 6 \%"$.




13. Sew (1) B rectangle, (1) O rectangle, and (1) L rectangle together as shown. The Purple O Center Unit should measure $5" \times 6 \%"$.




14. Using the SNF method, attach (2) Q squares to the bottom corners of (1) G rectangle. The Purple O Bottom Unit should measure 2" × 6 ½".




15. Sew (1) Purple O Top Unit, (1) Purple O Center Unit, and (1) Purple O Bottom Unit together as shown. The Purple O Block should measure 6 ½" × 8".



16. Arrange (2) M rectangles, (1) B Block, (2) N rectangles, (1) Orange O Block, and (1) Purple O Block as shown. Sew the rectangles and blocks together in a row. The row should measure 8" × 45". Add (2) S strips to the top and bottom of the row. The Boo Block should measure 14" × 45".





QUILT ASSEMBLY

17. Arrange (3) X strips, (1) Panel Unit, and (1) Boo Block as shown. Sew the strips, unit, and block together to form the Quilt Center. The Quilt Center should measure $45" \times 63 \%"$.

18. Sew the (2) W strips to the side edges of the Quilt Center to complete the quilt top. The quilt top should measure $53" \times 63 \%"$.

FINISHING

Finish the quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Bind with the Orange Stars binding strips.
