Please read all instructions before beginning this project. Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please visit www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated. Refer to the quilt layout diagram for placement of the prints. Press seams as noted in each step for best results. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes unless otherwise stated. For accurate template sizing, always print the templates at "ACTUAL SIZE" not "FIT TO PRINT". After printing, measure the 1" square to ensure the templates are the correct size before cutting any fabric.

WOF = Width of Fabric RST = Right Sides Together

2 ¾ Yards Backing fabric of your choice Batting

½ Yard Fusible Web

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all pattern instructions before cutting fabrics. Use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter to cut your fabrics and label all cuts as noted.



From EACH Fat Quarter of Yellow Handwriting, Orange Gym Class, and Green Penmanship

Cut (1) 10 ½" × 21" strip; subcut:

(1) 10 %" × 10 %" square. Label as A.

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From EACH Fat Quarter of Library Card and Red Math Graphs

Cut (1) 10 ½" × 21" strip; subcut:

(2) $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Label as A.



Blue Bookworm

Cut (1) 10 ½" × WOF strip; subcut:

(3) $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Label as A.



Black Flashcards

Cut (7) 2 ½" × WOF strips; subcut:

(2) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $34 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips for Top/Bottom Borders.

Sew the remaining (5) 2 ½" × WOF strips together end-to-end; subcut:


(2) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 83 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for Side Borders.



White Math Graphs

Cut (4) 10" × WOF strips; subcut:

- (8) $10'' \times 10 \frac{3}{4}''$ rectangles. Label as B.
- (6) 5 %" × 10" rectangles. Label as C.
- (3) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 10" rectangles. Label as D.
- (2) 5 ¾" × WOF strips; subcut:
 - (2) 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ " × 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as E.
- (6) 1 ½" × WOF strips; subcut:
 - (6) 1 %" × 30 %" rectangles. Label as F.



Off White USA States

Cut (7) 2 ½" × WOF strips. Set aside for binding.



Riley Black Confetti Cottons Solid

Cut (2) 5" × WOF strips. Set aside for appliqué.

Fusible Web

Cut (4) 5 3/4" × width of product strips. Set aside for appliqué.

APPLIQUÉ INSTRUCTIONS

Appliqué Preparation

Instructions are provided for raw edge fusible appliqué. Seam allowances are not included on the templates; please add if using another appliqué technique.

To prepare and cut the appliqué pieces:

- Place the number templates (pages 6-8) right side up on a light table or window. Note: The images have already been reversed.
- Trace the individual numbers onto the paper side of the fusible web, leaving at least ½" of space around each traced number. Note: Trace (2) of numbers 1 and 6. The 1 will be used for 1 and 10. The 6 will be used for 6 and turned 180° for number 9.




- Roughly cut outside the drawn line of each shape, leaving at least ¼" of fusible web. Note: For softer finished appliqué, also remove the interior of the drawn shape, leaving at least ½" of fusible web inside of the drawn line. Discard any excess.
- Fuse the traced shapes to the WRONG side of the Black Confetti Cottons fabric strips as shown, following the manufacturer's instructions. Once cool, cut out each shape exactly on the drawn lines. Label pieces as they are cut. Do NOT remove the paper backing until ready to fuse in place.



Appliqué Directions

Remove the paper backing from the appliqué number. Center the numbers in the print square. You may find it helpful to fold each square in half vertically and horizontally to mark the center lines. Use tape or pins to temporarily hold the fabric shapes in place. Fuse the appliqué numbers in place following the manufacturer's instructions.

Sew around the raw edges of each number using a straight or small zigzag stitch and matching thread.




BLOCK ASSEMBLY


- 1. Gather the (10) A-squares and fused numbers. Follow the Appliqué Directions to center, fuse, and appliqué the number to the corresponding square as shown in the diagram below.
- 2. Trim each square to $10" \times 10"$.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

1. Arrange the appliquéd A-squares and B through F-rectangles as shown. Sew the units together in rows and press. Sew the rows together and press to complete the Quilt Center. The Quilt Center should measure 30 ½" × 83 ½".



2. Sew the Side Borders to the sides of the Quilt Center and press, then sew the Top/Bottom Borders to the top and bottom and press. The Quilt Top is now complete and should measure $34 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $87 \frac{1}{2}$ ".





FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

- 3. Layer your backing, batting, and quilt top. Quilt as desired.
- 4. Sew the Off White USA States strips together end-to-end. Bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
