Please read all instructions before beginning this project. Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

Please note that prewashing can shrink 100% cotton fabric. Always verify after washing and drying that there is still 42" of usable width available. Shrinkage can affect the size of panel motifs and fussy cutting sizes may need to be adjusted. If this is the case, add strips around the edge of the fussy cut piece to create a pieced unit that matches the size of the fussy cut dimensions given in the cutting instructions.

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated. Refer to the quilt layout diagram for placement of the prints. Press seams as noted in each step for best results. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes unless otherwise stated.

WOF = Width of Fabric RST = Right Sides Together

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

All fabrics are from the Old School fabric collection.

OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies 1 ½ Yards Backing fabric of your choice Batting

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all pattern instructions before cutting fabrics. Use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter to cut your fabrics and label all cuts as noted.



School Map Panel

Fussy cut (1) 23 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 31 $\frac{1}{2}$ " panel, centered over the map motif as shown.



Off White Dictionary

Cut (4) 4 ½" × WOF strips; subcut:

(2) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 35" strips. Label as A for the side borders.

Set aside remaining (2) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strips. Label as B for the top/bottom borders.



Cut (4) 2 ½" × WOF strips; set aside for binding.


QUILT ASSEMBLY

- 1. On the panel, measure and mark the center of each edge and $\frac{1}{2}$ " from each corner.
- 2. Measure and mark the center of each border strip.
- 3. Match the center of an A border strip with one side of the panel, RST, then pin the border strip in place. Sew the border strip to the quilt top between the two ¼" end marks on the panel, backstitching at each end. Repeat to add a border strip to each side of the quilt center. Press toward each outer border.



4. Fold the quilt center diagonally, creating a 45° angle on the border. Note: The panel will not be folded through the center as it is not square. Be sure to leave the ends of the outer border strips perpendicular and press. Pull the vertical border away from the horizontal border. Use a ruler with a 45° angle to measure ¼" away from the marked corner of the quilt top and trim the horizontal border strip as shown. Repeat to press and trim the end of each border strip.

Note: Be sure to pull the perpendicular strip out of the way each time before cutting.



5. With the border strips RST, sew along the angled edge starting at the $\frac{1}{2}$ " point previously marked to the outside edge, then press. Repeat for each corner of the quilt. The quilt top should measure $31\frac{1}{2}$ " × $39\frac{1}{2}$ ".

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6. Layer your backing, batting, and quilt top. Quilt as desired.
- 7. Sew the Charcoal Handwriting binding strips together end-to-end. Bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite method.
