

### Star of Wonder Block:



Unfinished size: 16 ½" x 16 ½" Make one.

Use 1/4" seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

#### Block Assembly:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric C squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric C square with a Fabric E square.

Stitch 1/4" from each side of the drawn line.

Cut apart on the marked line.

Trim Half Square Triangle Unit to measure 2 1/2" x 2 1/2".











Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric G squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric G square on the top end of a Fabric B rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.

Left Star Point Unit should measure 2 1/2" x 6 1/2".





Make four.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric G square on the top end of a Fabric B rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.

Right Star Point Unit should measure 2 ½" x 6 ½".





Make four.

Assemble Unit. Press open.

Star Point Unit should measure 4 ½" x 6 ½".





With right sides facing, layer Fabric G squares on opposite corners of the Fabric A square.

Stitch on the drawn lines and trim 1/4" away from the seams.





Repeat on the remaining corners.

Star Center Unit should measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2".



Use 1/4" seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric F square on the top end of a Fabric C rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.





Repeat on the bottom end with a matching Fabric F square.

Left Star Top Unit should measure 2 1/2" x 4 1/2".

Unfinished size: 4 ½" x 36 ½" Make four.

### Cutting:

Background 43167-21	A	4 - 4 ½" squares ◊
Inner Border 43161-14	B	16 - 2 ½" squares ◊
43163-11 43162-11		1 - 4 ½" x 18 ½" rectangle (4 total)
43161-11 43165-11	D	1 - 4 ½" x 14 ½" rectangle (4 total)

Use 1/4" seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

## Inner Border Assembly:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric B squares.

With right sides facing, layer Fabric B squares on opposite corners of a Fabric A square.

Stitch on the drawn lines and trim 1/4" away from the seams.





Repeat on the remaining corners.

Square in a Square Unit should measure 4 ½" x 4 ½".



Finished size: 48 1/2" x 48 1/2"

## Cutting:


Outer Border 43167-21	A	2 - 4 ½" x 40 ½" strips
	B	3 - 4 ½" x width of fabric strips
Binding 43166-15		6 - 2 ½" width of fabric strips

Use 1/4" seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

## Quilt Center:

Assemble Quilt Center. Pay close attention to block placement. Press open.

Quilt Center should measure 32 1/2" x 32 1/2".













### Inner Border:


Attach Round One of the Inner Border.


Stop stitching ½" away from the bottom of the Quilt Center, creating a partial seam. Backstitch.





Attach Round Two of the Inner Border.

Finish assembling Inner Border by completing the partial seam.







# Outer Border:


Piece the Fabric B strips end to end.

Subcut into:

2 - 4 ½" x 48 ½" strips (Top and Bottom Outer Borders)

Attach side outer borders using the Fabric A strips.

Attach the Top and Bottom Outer Borders.



# Finishing:

Piece the Fabric C strips end to end for binding.

Quilt and bind as desired.
