#### **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

Please check www.rileyblakedesigns.com/ pattern-updates or scan the QR Code for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are



virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.

Always verify your panel size before beginning. If your panel measurements differ from those given in the pattern, trim to the desired size or use coping strips to alter the size of your panel. If coping strips are needed, add oversized, coordinating strips of fabric to the necessary edges of the panel, then trim to the size specified in the pattern.

WOF = Width of Fabric RST = Right Sides Together

#### **FABRIC REQUIREMENTS**

All fabrics from the Get Your Cray-On collection unless stated otherwise.

(1) P15416-PANEL Get Your Cray-On Panel ¾ yard C15412-RED Crayons ¾ yard C15415-YELLOW Dense Doodle 1 yard C15410-WHITE Main ½ yard C15414-RED Ditsy Doodle (binding)

#### OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies 1 % yards WB660-RED Swiss Dot (Wide Back Backing) Batting

#### **CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS**

When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include  $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



## Get Your Cray-On Panel

Fussy cut (1) panel 35  $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 42  $\frac{1}{2}$ ", centered over the motif.\*

\*Note: If the panel motif reaches the edge of the cut, add coping strips first and then trim to the required size once the strips are added.



#### **Red Crayons**

Cut (4) 2 ½" × WOF strips. Piece together end-toend; subcut:

- (2)  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 42  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as A.
- (2)  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 39  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as B.



#### Yellow Dense Doodle

Cut (5) 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

- (2)  $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 46  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as C.
- (2) 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 45  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as D.



#### White Main

Cut (6) 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strips. Piece together end-toend; subcut:

- (2)  $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " ×  $55 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as E.
- (2)  $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " ×  $52 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as F.



#### Red Ditsy Doodle

Cut (6)  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strips. Set aside for binding.

## **SEWING TECHNIQUES**

Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the quilt layout diagram for placement of the prints. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

## **QUILT ASSEMBLY**

1. Sew **A**-strips to the sides of the panel. Next, sew **B**-strips to the top and bottom. Sew **C**-strips to the sides. Next, sew **D**-strips to the top and bottom. Sew **F**-strips to the sides. Next, sew **E**-strips to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top. The quilt top should measure 55 %" × 62 %".

# FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

2. Finish the quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Red Ditsy Doodle binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
