GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates or scan the QR Code for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are



virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.

WOF = Width of Fabric RST = Right Sides Together

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.

Print the templates and appliqué shapes located on page 8.

For instructions on preparing your fabric for fusible appliqué before cutting, see page 4.



5" Squares

From each 5" square, cut:

(1) Crayon Top Center using Template



Fat Eigthths

From each fat eighth, cut

(1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Label as A.



Purple Neighborhood

Cut (1) 4 ½" × WOF strip. Subcut:

(1) 4 %" × 12 %" rectangle. Label as A.

Cut (1) 2 ½" × WOF strip. Subcut:

(16) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Label as B.



Green Fireworks

Cut (1) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strip. Subcut:

(2) 4 %" × 12 %" rectangles. Label as A.



Red Ditsy Doodle

Cut (1) 4 ½" × WOF strip. Subcut:

(1) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Label as A.

Cut (1) 2 ½" × WOF strip. Subcut:

(16) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Label as C.



White Dense Doodle

Cut (3) 2 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(48) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Label as D.



Yellow Dense Doodle

Cut (1) 4 ½" × WOF strip. Subcut:

(1) 4 %" × 12 %" rectangle. Label as A.

Cut (1) 2 ½" × WOF strip. Subcut:

(16) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Label as E.



Riley Black Solid

Cut (20) Serpentine Top Appliqué Shapes Cut (20) Serpentine Bottom Appliqué Shapes



White Neighborhood

Cut (2) 4 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(2) 4 %" × 32 %" rectangles. Label as F.



Blue Neighborhood

Cut (5) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

(2) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 52 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as G.

(2) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $36 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as H.



White Crayons

Cut (5) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

(2) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 56 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as I.

(2) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as J.



White Ditsy Doodle

Cut (1) 4 ½" × WOF strip*. Subcut:

(10) Crayon Top Side using Template

(10) Crayon Top Side Reversed using Template

Cut (6) 2 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(12) 2 %" × 16 %" rectangles. Label as K.

* For best use of fabric, rotate the template 180° after each cut.



Lime Dense Doodle

Cut (1) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strip. Subcut:

(1) 4 ½" × 12 ½" rectangle. Label as A.

Cut (6) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

(2) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 62 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as L.

(2) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 46 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as M.



White Fireworks

Cut (6) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

(2) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 66 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as N.

(2) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 52 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as O.



Mint Main

Cut (7) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

- (2) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 76 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as P.
- (2) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $68 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as Q.



Blue Crayons

Cut (1) 4 ½" × WOF strip. Subcut:

(1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Label as A. Cut (15) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strips. Set (8) aside for binding. Piece together remaining strips end-toend; subcut:

- (2) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 72 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as R.
- (2) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 56 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as S.




Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the quilt layout diagram for placement of the prints. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

APPLIQUE PREPARATION

Instructions are provided for raw edge fusible appliqué. Seam allowances are not included on the Templates; add it if using another applique technique.

To prepare and cut the appliqué pieces:

- Place the Template right side up on a light table or window. Note: All Templates are already reversed for ease of use.
- Trace the individual labeled shapes onto the paper side of the fusible web, leaving at least $\frac{1}{4}$ " of space around each traced shape. Transfer the Template name to the fusible paper as well.



Note: For softer finished appliqué, also remove the interior of the drawn shape, leaving at least ½" of fusible web inside of the drawn line. Discard or reuse any excess for any smaller shapes.




• Fuse the traced shapes to the WRONG side of the specified fabric following the manufacturer's instructions. Once cool, cut out each shape exactly on the drawn lines. Do NOT remove the paper backing until ready to fuse in place.




BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Sew (1) Crayon Top Side to the left side of (1) Crayon Top Center, offsetting the side template $\frac{1}{2}$ " before sewing. Press. In the same manner, sew (1) Crayon Top Side Reversed to the right side of the same Crayon Top Center. Press. Trim any dog ears to make (1) Crayon Top Unit. Repeat to make (10) total units.



- 2. Arrange (2) Serpentine Top and (2) Serpentine Bottom shapes on (1) **A**-rectangle as shown below. Remove the paper backings from each template. Fuse all the appliqué shapes in place following the manufacturer's instructions.
- 3. Once fused, hand or machine stitch using a straight or small zigzag stitch around the edges of each appliquéd piece.
- 4. Place the appliquéd rectangle right side down on a towel to protect the stitching and press gently to make (1) Crayon Bottom Unit. Repeat to make (10) total units.




5. Sew (1) Crayon Top Unit and (1) Crayon Bottom Unit together as shown below to make (1) Crayon Block. Match tops and bottoms in similar colors. Repeat to make (10) total blocks.





QUILT ASSEMBLY


6. Sew (6) **K**-rectangles and (5) Crayon Blocks together as shown below to make (1) Block Row. Repeat to make (2) total rows.




7. Gather the required pieces and sew them together to make the units shown below, referencing the diagrams for quantity, proper placement, and orientation.




8. Sew (16) D/E units together as shown below to make a Pieced Row. Repeat with remaining matching sets of Step 7 units to make (3) total rows.



9. Sew (3) Pieced Rows, (2) **F**-rectangles, and (2) Block Rows together as shown below to make the quilt center.



10. Sew (1) **G**-strip to each side of the quilt center. Next, add (1) **H**-strip to the top and bottom. Sew (1) **I**-strip to each side of the quilt center. Next, add (1) **J**-strip to the top and bottom. Sew (1) **L**-strip to each side of the quilt center. Next, add (1) **M**-strip to the top and bottom.

11. Sew (1) **N**-strip to each side of the quilt center. Next, add (1) **O**-strip to the top and bottom. Sew (1) **R**-strip to each side of the quilt center. Next, add (1) **S**-strip to the top and bottom. Sew (1) **P**-strip to each side of the quilt center. Next, add (1) **Q**-strip to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.


FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS


12. Finish the quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Blue Crayons binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.

Cut out templates on solid drawn lines. The serpentine appliqué templates are already reversed for the fusible appliqué method.

For accurate template sizing, always print template pages at "ACTUAL SIZE", not "FIT TO PRINT". After printing, measure the TEST 1" square to ensure the template printed at the correct size BEFORE cutting any fabric.





This square should measure 1".
