LOVE STORIES PANEL QUILT

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 68" × 68"

Please read all instructions before beginning this project. Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric. **Pattern designed by The RBD Designers**

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates or scan the QR Code for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.



Always verify your panel size before beginning. If your panel measurements differ from those given in the pattern, trim to the desired size or use coping strips to alter the size of your panel. If coping strips are needed, add oversized, coordinating strips of fabric to the necessary edges of the panel, then trim to the size specified in the pattern.

WOF = Width of Fabric

RST = Right Sides Together

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

All fabrics from the Sweetheart collection unless stated otherwise.

(1) SP15508-PANEL Love Stories Pillow Panel

(1) 5-15500-42 5" Stacker

⅔ Yard of Each:

SC15505-CREAM Heart Toss

C15506-PINK Dots

Additional Fabrics:

½ yard C15504-RED XO

1 yard C15500-CREAM Main

1 yard C15501-HOTPINK Checks (includes binding)

OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies

2 ½ yards WB640-FROSTING Dapple Dot Wide Back Backing Batting

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



Love Stories Pillow Panel

Fussy cut the (2) top panels 17 ½" × 17 ½", centered over the motifs. * Label as A.

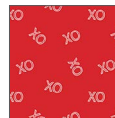
Fussy cut the (2) bottom panels 14" × 14", centered over the motifs. * Label as B.

**Note: If the panel motif does not reach the edge of the required cut, add coping strips first and then trim to the required size once the strips are added.*



5" Stacker

Set (32) 5" × 5" squares aside. Label as C.



Red XO

Cut (4) 3 ¼" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(4) 3 ¼" × 23" rectangles. Label as D.

(4) 3 ¼" × 17 ½" rectangles. Label as E.



Cream Heart Toss

Cut (8) 2 ¾" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(4) 2 ¾" × 27 ½" rectangles. Label as F.

(4) 2 ¾" × 23" rectangles. Label as G.



Pink Dots

Cut (8) 2 ¾" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(4) 2 ¾" × 27 ½" rectangles. Label as H.

(4) 2 ¾" × 23" rectangles. Label as I.

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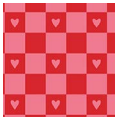


Cream Main

Cut (7) 5" x WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end, subut:

(2) 5" x 68" strips. Label as J.

(2) 5" x 59" strips. Label as K.



Hot Pink Checks

Cut (6) 2 3/4" x WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end, subut:

(2) 2 3/4" x 59" strips. Label as L.

(2) 2 3/4" x 54 1/2" strips. Label as M.

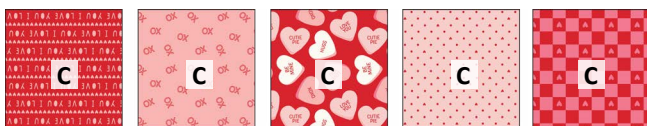
Cut (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Set aside for binding.

SEWING TECHNIQUES

Sew all seams RST and with a 1/4" seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the quilt layout diagram for placement of the prints. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Sew (5) **C**-squares together to make (1) Top/Bottom Unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.

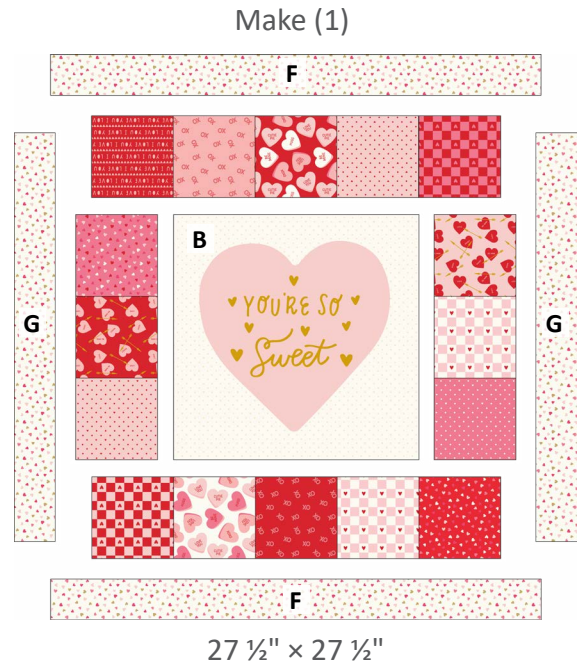
2. Sew (3) **C**-squares together to make (1) Side Unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.

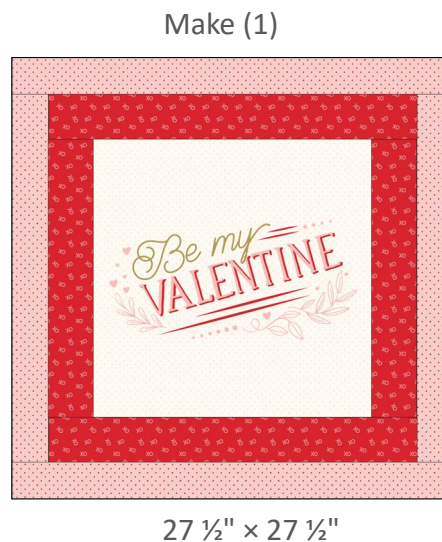
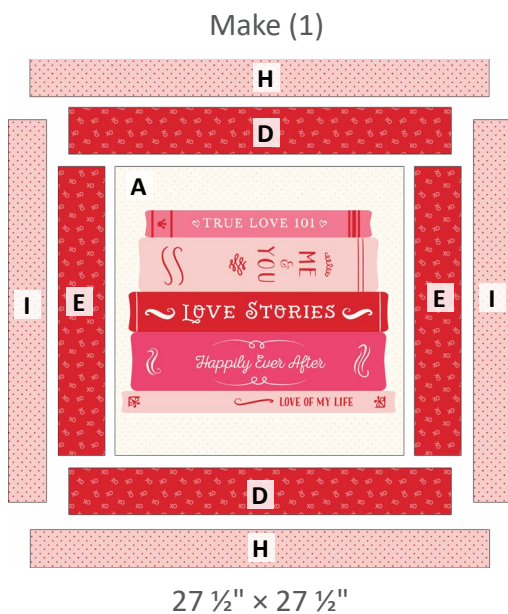

3. Sew (1) Side Unit to each side of (1) **B**-Panel as shown below. Next, sew (1) Top/Bottom Unit to the top and bottom. Sew (1) **G**-rectangle to each side and (1) **F**-rectangle to the top and bottom to make (1) Block 1. Repeat to make a second block as shown below.



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4. Sew (1) **E**-rectangle to each side of (1) **A**-Panel as shown below. Next, sew (1) **D**-rectangle to the top and bottom. Sew (1) **I**-rectangle to each side and (1) **H**-rectangle to the top and bottom to make (1) Block 2. Repeat to make a second block as shown below.



QUILT ASSEMBLY

5. Arrange (2) Block 1 and (2) Block 2, alternating blocks as shown below. Sew the blocks together into pairs. Next, sew the pairs together to make the quilt center.



54 ½" × 54 ½"

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6. Sew (1) **M**-strip to each side of the quilt center as shown below. Next, sew (1) **L**-strip to the top and bottom. Sew (1) **K**-strip to each side and (1) **J**-strip to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

7. Finish the quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Hot Pink Checks binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
