

SEAMS QUICK & IS SEW EASY

Zipper Pouch SEWING TUTORIAL

FINISHED POUCH MEASURES APPROXIMATELY 5" X 9"



Supplies

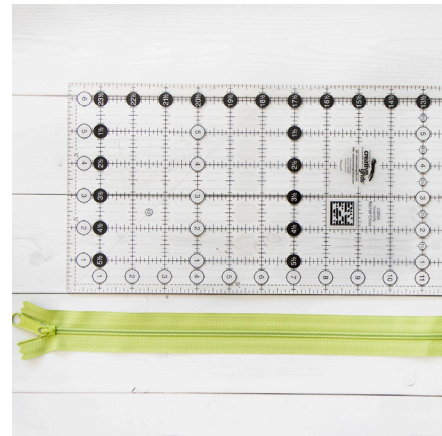
- 1/3 yard or two 10" squares of fabric
- Heat 'n Bond Ultrahold
- ByAnnie Zipper
- Wonder Clips
- Rotary Cutter

STEP 1: PREP YOUR FABRIC



Cut a 10" square of the outer fabric, inner fabric & Heat 'n Bond. Fuse the Heat 'n Bond to the wrong side of both fabrics.

STEP 2: PREP YOUR ZIPPER



Trim your zipper to about 12" and remove the zipper pull to separate the tracks.

STEP 3: ATTACH THE ZIPPER



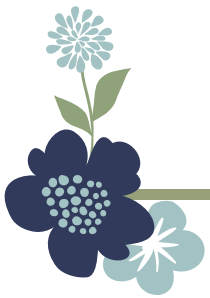
Place each zipper pieces right sides together with your outer fabric. Pay close attention to the direction of the zipper teeth (inward) and clip in place.

Stitch using a 1/4" seam.

STEP 4: TRIM THE ZIPPER



Trim excess zippers on both sides of your fabrics. Press fabric away from the zipper and topstitch.



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STEP 5: FINISH THE ZIPPER



Gently fold your pouch towards the center, wrong sides out and clip in place.

Feed zipper pull upside down to reattach to the tracks. Feed one zipper track at a time until the pull catches.

STEP 6: SEAL YOUR POUCH



Glide your zipper pull up the tracks to the middle of the pouch. Seal both openings by stitching a 1/4" seam backstitching at the start and stop.

STEP 7: FLIP IT OUT



Flip your pouch inside out through the opening. Using a point turner to get the corners out.

Zipper Pull TUTORIAL

Cut a 2.5" x 8" rectangle

With wrong sides up, fold each end inside 1/2" & press



Fold length wise to find your center & press



Finger press open and press each edge inside towards the center crease & press



Topstitch down the length to secure in place



Feed pull onto your zipper and stitch across one end and backstitch
