GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates or scan the QR Code for any revisions before starting this project.

This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.



Always verify your panel size before beginning. If your panel measurements differ from those given in the pattern, trim to the desired size or use coping strips to alter the size of your panel. If coping strips are needed, add oversized, coordinating strips of fabric to the necessary edges of the panel, then trim to the size specified in the pattern.

WOF = Width of Fabric RST = Right Sides Together

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

All fabrics from the Sunsetridge collection unless stated otherwise.

- (1) P15738-PANEL I Sew Panel
- (1) RP-15730-40 Rolie Polie



Additional Fabrics:

1 ¾ yards C120-LECREME Confetti Cotton™ ¼ yard C15732-ROUGE Flowers (binding)

OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies

 $1\,\%$ yards WB14183-SEAGLASS Bee Dots (wide back backing) Batting

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



I Sew Panel

Fussy cut (1) 34 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Panel rectangle, centered over the motif.*

*Note: If the panel motif does not reach the edge of the required cut, add coping strips first and then trim to the required size.



Rolie Polie

Cut (32) sets of (5) matching 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Label as A. Cut (32) sets of (4) matching 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Label as B. Cut (4) sets of (3) matching 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Label as C.

To make the quilt exactly as shown, refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram on page 4 to cut the same fabrics from the Rolie Polie. Additional A pieces can also be cut from the leftover binding fabric.



Le Creme Confetti Cotton™

Cut (19) 2 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut: (300) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares. Label as D.



Rouge Flowers


Cut (7) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strips for binding.

SEWING TECHNIQUES

Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram for placement of the prints. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

1. Arrange (4) matching **B**-squares and (5) **D**-squares as shown below. Sew into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Unit 1. Repeat to make (32) total units.



2. Arrange (5) matching **A**-squares and (4) **D**-squares as shown below. Sew into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Unit 2. Repeat to make (32) total units.




3. Arrange (3) matching **C**-squares and (3) **D**-squares as shown below. Sew into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Unit 3. Repeat to make (2) total units.




4. Arrange (3) matching **C**-squares and (3) **D**-squares as shown below. Sew into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Unit 4. Repeat to make (2) total units.



5. Arrange (9) Unit 1s, (9) Unit 2s, (1) Unit 3, and (1) Unit 4 as shown below. Sew into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Top Border. Repeat to make (1) Bottom Border.




6. Arrange (7) Unit 1s and (7) Unit 2s as shown below. Sew into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Side Border. Repeat to make (2) total Side Borders.



7. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Panel rectangle. Next, add (1) Top Border to the top and (1) Bottom Border to the bottom to complete the quilt top. (Pay careful attention to the direction of the borders to achieve the checkerboard effect.)

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

8. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Rouge Flowers binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
