Please read all instructions before beginning this project. Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric. Pattern designed by The RBD Designers.

## **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

Please check www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates or scan the QR Code for any revisions before starting this project.

This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.



Always verify your panel size before beginning. If your panel measurements differ from those given in the pattern, trim to the desired size or use coping strips to alter the size of your panel. If coping strips are needed, add oversized, coordinating strips of fabric to the necessary edges of the panel, then trim to the size specified in the pattern.

WOF = Width of Fabric RST = Right Sides Together

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

All fabrics from the Hey Pumpkin collection unless stated otherwise.

- (1) P16038-PANEL Happy Halloween Panel
- (1) 10-16030-42 10" Stacker

### Additional Fabric:

% yard C16037-CHARCOAL Stars (includes binding)

# OTHER SUPPLIES

**Basic Sewing Supplies** 

 $1 \frac{3}{4}$  yards WB16040-WHITE Stars (wide back backing) Batting

### **CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS**

When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted. Lines have been added to the panel diagram below to demonstrate cutting instructions.



### Happy Halloween Panel

Fussy cut (4) 5 %" × 5 %" Panel squares centered over the bat motifs.\* Note: The bats will face diagonally inside the squares. Label as A.

Fussy cut (1) 22"  $\times$  29 ½" Panel rectangle centered over the house motif.\* Label as B.

Fussy cut (4) 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Panel squares centered over the tombstone motifs.\* Label as C.


\*Note: If the panel motifs do not reach the edge of the required cuts, add coping strips first and then trim to the required sizes.



# 10" Stacker

Choose (4) 10" squares (this quilt uses the four squares shown above). From each square, cut:

- (2) 1  $\frac{3}{4}$ " × 8" rectangles. Label as D.
- (2)  $1 \frac{3}{4}$ " ×  $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as E.









#### 10" Stacker

Choose (2) 10" squares (this quilt uses the two squares shown above). From each square, cut:

(4)  $5" \times 5"$  squares, cutting each in half diagonally to make (8) total triangles. Label as F.



#### 10" Stacker

From the remaining squares, cut: (36)  $8" \times 8"$  squares. Label as G.



#### **Charcoal Stars**

Cut (6) 2 %" × WOF strips. Set aside for binding. Cut (4) 1" × WOF strips. Subcut:

- (2)  $1" \times 29 \%"$  rectangles. Label as H.
- (2) 1" × 23" rectangles. Label as I.

## **SEWING TECHNIQUES**

Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram for placement of the prints. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

### **BLOCK ASSEMBLY**


To make the quilt exactly as shown, refer to the cover and the Quilt Layout Diagram on page 4 to plan your placement of the Panel and 10" Stacker squares.

1. Sew (1) **H**-rectangle to each side of (1) **B**-rectangle as shown below. Next, sew (1) **I**-rectangle to the top and bottom to make (1) Center Block.



- 2. From one print, gather (2) **D**-rectangles and (2) **E**-rectangles. Also gather (1) **C**-square.
- 3. Sew (1) **E**-rectangle to each side of (1) **C**-square Next, sew (1) **D**-rectangle to the top and bottom to make (1) Tombstone Block.
- 4. Repeat steps 2-3 to make (4) total Tombstone blocks.



- 5. From one print, gather (4) **F**-triangles. Also gather (1) **A**-square.
- 6. Sew (2) **F**-triangles to opposites sides of (1) **A**-square. Press. Next, sew (2) **F**-triangles to the remaining sides and press to make (1) Bat Block. If needed, trim the block to 8" × 8".
- 7. Repeat steps 5-6 to make (4) total Bat blocks.



# QUILT ASSEMBLY

8. Arrange (11) **G**-squares, (1) Tombstone Block, and (2) Bat Blocks as shown below. Sew the squares and blocks together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Top Border Unit.

10. Arrange (7) **G**-squares and (1) Tombstone Block as shown below. Sew the squares and block together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Left Border Unit.

11. Arrange (7) **G**-squares and (1) Tombstone Block as shown below. Sew the squares and block together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Right Border Unit.

12. Sew the Left and Right Border Units to the left and right sides of the Center Block as shown below. Next, sew the Top and Bottom Border Units to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

## FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

13. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Charcoal Stars binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
