GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.



WOF = Width of Fabric RST = Right Sides Together SNF = Stitch and Flip SNF-FG = Stitch and Flip Flying Geese

Fat ½ of Each: C16050-GREEN Main C16052-PURPLE Boots Toss C16053-ORANGE Pumpkin Vine C16054-BLACK Stars and Moon

¼ Yard of Each: C16054-CREAM Stars and Moon C16057-CREAM Dots

Additional Fabrics: ½ yard C16050-BLACK Main ½ yard C16057-BLACK Dots (includes binding)

OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies 1 ¼ yards C16055-CREAM Stars (optional backing) Batting

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



Orange Gourds Toss Cut (4) 2" × 2" squares. Label as A.



Cream Boots Toss Cut (4) 2" × 2" squares. Label as B.



Green Pumpkin Vine Cut (4) 2" × 2" squares. Label as C.



Black Stars Cut (4) 2" × 2" squares. Label as D.



Black Stripes* Cut (1) 3" × 5" rectangle. Label as E.

*Please note this is a directional print. Cutting for this print is listed width × height.



Orange Dots Cut (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Label as F.



Green Main*

Fussy-cut (2) $2" \times 3 \%"$ rectangles, centered over the motifs. Label as G.

Fussy-cut (3) 2" × 3" rectangles, centered over the motifs. Label as H.

Fussy-cut (3) 2" \times 2 ½" rectangles, centered over the motifs. Label as I.

Purple Boots Toss Cut (32) 2" × 2" squares. Label as J.



Orange Pumpkin Vine* Cut (1) 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Label as K.

Black Stars and Moon

Cut (1) 4 ½" × 13 ½" rectangle. Label as L. Cut (1) 1 ¾" × 2 ½" rectangle. Label as M.



Cream Stars and Moon

Cut (1) 4 ½" × WOF strip. Subcut: (2) 4 ½" × 4 ½" squares. Label as N. Cut remainder of strip into (2) 2 ¼" strips; subcut:

> (2) 2 ¼" × 17 ½" rectangles. Label as O.

(1) 2 ¼" × 10 ¾" rectangle. Label as P.

(1) 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " × 7 $\frac{3}{4}$ " rectangle. Label as Q.

Cut (1) 1 ¼" × WOF strip. Subcut:

(1) 1 $\ensuremath{^{\prime\prime}}\xspace^{\prime\prime}$ rectangle. Label as R.

(1) $1" \times 2 \frac{1}{2}"$ rectangle. Label as S.

Cream Dots

Cut (2) 2" × WOF strips. Subcut: (16) 2" × 3 ½" rectangles. Label as T. (16) 2" × 2" squares. Label as U.



Black Main

Cut (2) 6 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut: (4) 6 ½" × 20" rectangles. Label as V.



Black Dots

Cut (5) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ × WOF strips. Set (4) strips aside for binding. From remaining strip, subcut:

(2) 2 ½" × 12" rectangles. Label as W.
(2) 2 ½" × 7 ½" rectangles. Label as X.


- Cut (1) $2'' \times WOF$ strip. Subcut:
 - (1) $2'' \times 12 \frac{1}{2}''$ rectangle. Label as Y.
 - (2) $2'' \times 2 \frac{1}{2}''$ rectangles. Label as Z.
 - (1) $2" \times 2"$ square. Label as AA.
 - (2) $1 \frac{3}{4}$ " × 5" rectangles. Label as BB.
 - (5) 1 ½" × 2" rectangles. Label as CC.

SEWING TECHNIQUES

Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram for placement of the prints. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes. Please refer to the following general sewing techniques as these methods are referenced throughout the pattern in their abbreviated form.


STITCH AND FLIP METHOD (SNF)

Place (2) pieces RST, matching raw edges in the corner to be replaced. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the smaller piece across the corner. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance outside the sewn line to ¼". Flip the smaller piece away from the larger piece and press, replacing the corner. The size of the larger, original piece does not change.



STITCH AND FLIP FLYING GEESE METHOD (SNF-FG)

Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner, on the wrong side of (2) squares. Place (1) square in a corner of (1) rectangle, RST, matching raw edges in the corner to be replaced. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance outside the sewn line to ¼". Flip the square away from the rectangle and press, replacing the corner. Repeat with the second square in the opposite corner. The size of the original rectangle does not change.




BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Sew (1) **F**-square and (1) **K**-rectangle together as shown below to make (1) Roof Unit.




2. Use the SNF method to sew (2) **N**-squares to the top left and top right corners of the Roof Unit as shown below.




 Sew (1) I-rectangle, (2) CC-rectangles, (1) H-rectangle, (1) G-rectangle, and (1) Z-rectangle together as shown below to make (1) Tall Window Unit. Repeat to make a second unit.



 Sew (1) I-rectangle, (1) CC-rectangle, (1) H-rectangle, and (1) AA-square together as shown below to make (1) Short Window Unit.




5. Sew (2) **BB**-rectangles and (1) **E**-rectangle together as shown below to make (1) Door Unit.



 Sew (1) X-rectangle to each side of the Short Window Unit. Next, sew the Door Unit to the bottom to make (1) House Center Unit.




7. Sew (2) W-rectangles, (2) Tall Window Units, and
(1) House Center Unit together as shown below. Next, sew
(1) Y-rectangle to the top to make (1) House Front Unit.





8. Sew (1) L-rectangle to the left side of the House Front Unit. Next, sew the Roof Unit to the top to make the House Unit.

Sew (1) S-rectangle to the top of (1) M-rectangle as shown below. Next, sew (1) Q-rectangle to the left side and (1) P-rectangle to the right side to make (1) Chimney Unit.



 Sew (1) O-rectangle to each side of the House Unit. Next, sew (1) Chimney Unit to the top and (1) R-rectangle to the bottom to make (1) House Block.




11. Gather the required pieces and use the SNF-FG method to make the unit shown below, referring the diagram for quantity, proper placement, and orientation.



Arrange (1) A-square, (1) B-square, (1) C-square, and
 D-square as shown below. Sew the squares together into pairs. Next, sew the pairs together to make (1) Star Center Unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.



 Arrange (4) U-squares, (4) SNF-FG units, and (1) Star Center Unit as shown below. Sew the squares and units together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Star Block. Repeat to make (4) total blocks.



QUILT ASSEMBLY

 Arrange (4) Star Blocks, (4) V-rectangles, and (1) House Block as shown in the Quilt Layout Diagram on page 6. Sew the blocks and rectangles together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to complete the quilt top.

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

15. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Black Dots binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
