#### **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

before cutting and assembling.

Please check www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates or scan the QR Code for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric

Always verify your panel size before beginning. If your panel measurements differ from those given in the pattern, trim to the desired size or use coping strips to alter the size of your panel. If coping strips are needed, add oversized, coordinating strips of fabric to the necessary edges of the panel, then trim to the size specified in the pattern.

WOF = Width of Fabric LOF = Length of Fabric RST = Right Sides Together

# FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

All fabrics from the Costume Maker's Act II collection unless stated otherwise.

- (1) PD16000-PANEL Main Panel
- (1) PD16003-PANEL Costume Party Bunting Panel

#### Additional Fabric:

¼ yard C16011-BLACK Web ½ yard C16015-ORANGE Thistle 1¼ yards C16012-BLACK Ticket Text 1¾ yards CD16004-WHITE Costume Border Stripe ½ yard C16006-ORANGE Tape Measure (binding)

# OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies 2 yards WB16017-BLACK Web (wide back backing) Batting

#### **CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS**

When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



#### **Main Panel**

Fussy cut (1) 23  $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 42" Panel rectangle, centered over the motif.\* Label as A.



# **Costume Party Bunting Panel**

Fussy cut (2)  $10" \times 42"$  Panel rectangles, centered over the bunting motifs.\* Label as B.

\*Note: If the panel motifs do not reach the edge of the required cuts, add coping strips first and then trim to the required sizes once the strips are added.



#### **Black Web**

Cut (2) 1 ¾" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(2) 1 %" × 42" rectangles. Label as C. Cut (3) 1 %" × WOF strips. Piece together end-toend; subcut:

(2)  $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 45" strips. Label as D.



#### **Orange Thistle**

Cut (6) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

(2) 4 %" × 65" strips. Label as E.

(2)  $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 53" strips. Label as F.



#### **Black Ticket Text**

Cut (7) 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strips. Piece together end-toend; subcut:

- (2)  $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 73" strips. Label as G.
- (2)  $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 63" strips. Label as H.



#### **Costume Border Stripe**

Cut (2) 11" × LOF strips centered over the stripe motifs. Subcut:

(2)  $11" \times 45"$  rectangles. Label as I.



# **Orange Tape Measure**


Cut (8) 2 ½" × WOF strips. Set aside for binding.

# SEWING TECHNIQUES

Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram for placement of the prints. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

## **QUILT ASSEMBLY**

1. Sew (1) **A**-rectangle, (2) **B**-rectangles, and (2) **C**-rectangles together as shown below to make (1) Panel Unit. (Pay close attention to the orientation of the **B**-rectangles.)

2. Sew (2) **D**-strips, (2) **I**-rectangles, and (1) Panel Unit together as shown below to make the quilt center. The **I**-rectangles should both be positioned upright.







45" × 65"

 Sew (1) E-strip to each side of the quilt center as shown in the Quilt Layout Diagram on page 4. Next, sew (1) F-strip to the top and bottom. In the same manner, sew G-strips to the sides and H-strips to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

# FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

4. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Orange Tape Measure binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
