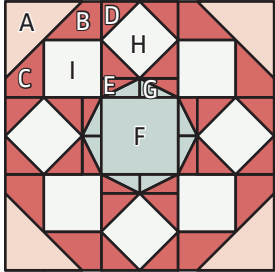

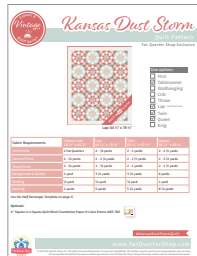
## Block Pattern

Cutting Instructions	One Block
First Print	<b>A)</b> 4 - 4 1/2" squares
Second Print	<b>B)</b> 4 - 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles
	<b>C)</b> 4 - 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles
	<b>D)</b> 16 - 2 1/2" squares ◇
	<b>E)</b> 2 - 2" x 20" strips
Third Print	<b>F)</b> 1 - 4 1/2" square
	<b>G)</b> 2 - 2" x 20" strips
Background	<b>H)</b> 4 - 4 1/2" squares ◇
	<b>I)</b> 4 - 3 1/2" squares

Use the Half Rectangle Template on page 3.

**Optional:**

◇ 4" Square in a Square Quilt Block Foundation Paper It's Sew Emma #ISE-780

(Follow the cutting instructions on the paper instead of the pattern when using the foundation paper.)

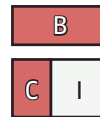


Use 1/4" seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

## Block Assembly:

Assemble Unit. Press open.

Kansas Corner Unit should measure 5 1/2" x 5 1/2".

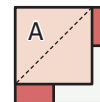


Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric A squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric A square on the top left corner of a Kansas Corner Unit.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.

Kansas Unit should measure 5 1/2" x 5 1/2".

# Kansas Dust Storm

## Block Pattern

Fat Quarter Shop Exclusive

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric D squares.

With right sides facing, layer Fabric D squares on opposite corners of a Fabric H square.

Stitch on the drawn lines and trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seams.



Repeat on the remaining corners.

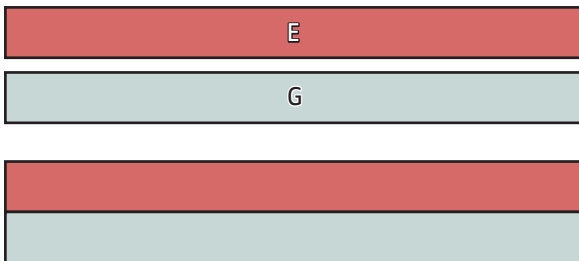
Square in a Square Unit should measure  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Make 4.

Assemble one Fabric E strip and one Fabric G strip.  
Press open.

Dust Strip Set should measure  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20".

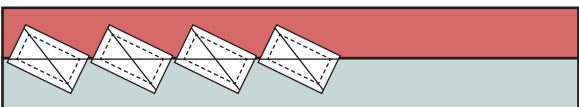


Make 2.

Using the Half Rectangle Template on page 3, align the Left diagonal line on the template with the seam of a Dust Strip Set.

Cut four Left Half Rectangle Units.

Left Half Rectangle Unit should measure  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".

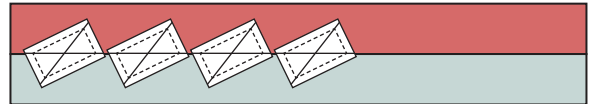


Make 4.

Using the Half Rectangle Template on page 3, align the Right diagonal line on the template with the seam of a Dust Strip Set.

Cut four Right Half Rectangle Units.

Right Half Rectangle Unit should measure  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Make 4.

Assemble Unit. Press open.

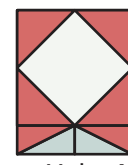
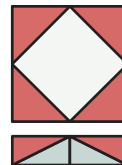
Dust Unit should measure  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Make 4.

Assemble Unit. Press open.

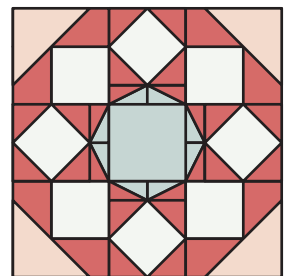
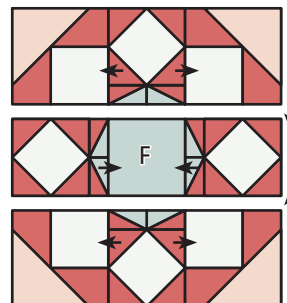
Storm Unit should measure  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Make 4.

Assemble Block.

Kansas Dust Storm Block should measure  $14\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $14\frac{1}{2}$ ".
