

Bee Happy Pillowcase

Free Pattern



Finished Size: 18 1/2" x 23 1/2"

Fabric Requirements

For Pink Lady (red) version:

1 2/3 yards C4760-MULTI for Front Middle Panel
and Pillow Back

2/3 yard C4762-RED for Side Panels

For Granny Smith (green) version:

1 2/3 yards C4760-GREEN for Front Middle Panel
and Pillow Back

2/3 yard C4765-GREEN for Side Panels


One standard size pillow

Cutting

From Middle Panel and Pillow Back fabric cut:

1 - 16 1/2" x 20" fussy cut rectangle (Front Middle Panel)

2 - 17" x 20" fussy cut rectangles (Pillow Back)



From Side Panels fabric, cut:

2 - 6" x 20" rectangles (Front Side Panels)

To secure your seams, backstitch at the beginning and end of each seam.

Pillowcase Assembly:

Using a 1/4" seam and with wrong sides facing, assemble the Front Side Panels and the Front Middle Panel .

Press toward the Front Side Panels.

Make one Partial Pillow Front.





Make one.

With right sides facing, refold the Partial Pillow Front along the seam lines.

Using a 3/8" seam, stitch along the folded edges enclosing the raw edges of the first seams.

Make one Pillow Front.

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
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Fold one Pillow Back under $\frac{1}{2}$ " on the 20" edge toward wrong side of the fabric. Press in place.

Fold the seam under another $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Press in place.

Make two.




Using matching thread, top stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the fold.

Make two.



Place two Pillow Backs right sides down and overlap them 5".

Place finished edges in the center.



With wrong sides facing, place Pillow Front on top of the Pillow Backs.

Matching corners, pin in place.

Using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam, stitch around the outside edges, backstitching where the back pieces overlap.

Trim the corners of the Pillowcase to reduce bulk.



Turn Pillowcase inside out.

Press seams flat.

Using a $\frac{3}{8}$ " seam, stitch around the perimeter of the Pillowcase.



Turn Bee Happy Pillowcase right side out.
