


# CORAW ME IN FABRIC BOOK



#### **BOOK COVER:**

Fuse the Batting C rectangle to the wrong side of the Fabric A2 rectangle.

Make one Partial Book Cover.




With right sides facing, layer the Partial Book Cover with the Fabric A1 rectangle.


Pin in place.

Using a ¼" seam, stitch around the outside edges, leaving a 5" opening at the bottom. Backstitch at the beginning and the end.


Book Cover should measure 12" x 18".

Make one.





Trim the corners of the Book Cover just outside of the stitching to reduce bulk.



Turn the Book Cover right side out. Turn the opening edges under 1/4" and press closed.

Using a matching thread, stitch around the Book Cover  $\%^{\prime\prime}$  away from the edge. Backstitch at the beginning and the end.



### **INSIDE PAGES:**

Fuse one Batting D rectangle to the wrong side of one Fabric B rectangle.

Make two Partial Inside Page Units.



# CORAW ME IN FABRIC BOOK




With right sides facing, layer a Partial Inside Page Unit with a Fabric B rectangle.

Pin in place.


Using a ¼" seam, stitch around the outside edges, leaving a 5" opening at the bottom. Backstitch at the beginning and the end.

Inside Pages should measure 11 1/2" x 17".

#### Make two.



Trim the corners of the Inside Pages just outside of the stitching to reduce bulk.



Turn the Inside Pages right side out. Turn the opening edges under  ${\ensuremath{\mathscr{V}}}{}''$  and press closed.

Using a matching thread, stitch around the Inside Pages %" away from the edge. Backstitch at the beginning and the end.

Make two.



## BOOK ASSEMBLY:

Layer the two Inside Pages with the Book Cover. Place the Fabric A2 side of the Book Cover face down and the Inside Pages on top.

Using a matching thread, stitch down the middle through all three layers, making the spine of the book. Backstitch at the beginning and the end to secure all seams.



Note: Michael Miller recommends using Tulip Fabric Markers to color your book.
