Quilt finishes 58'x 72"
20 Blocks: $12^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$
Glowing autumn colors are surrounded by black prints. This is the perfect size for snuggling under on a cool October evening, and easy enough for beginning quilters. The fun part is choosing the placement of the plaids.

## Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances. A fat $1 / 4$ is an $18^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}-22^{\prime \prime}$ cut. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide).

## Fabric A

Cut bias strips $2^{1 / 2 \prime}$ wide and sew together end-to-end to total a length of $276^{\prime \prime}$

## Fabric B

Cut (49) sashes $2^{1 / 2 \prime} \times 12^{1 / 2 \prime} 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Fabric C

Cut (160) $3^{\prime \prime}\left(2^{7 / 8 \prime}\right)$ squares (read Step 1 before cutting)

## 12 Plaid

From each:
Cut (30) squares $2^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$ (some are for setting squares)

## 8 Black

From each:
Cut (36) $3^{\prime \prime}\left(2^{7 / 8}\right)$ squares (read Step 1 before cutting)
Cut (9) squares $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Backing

Cut (2) panels $42^{\prime \prime} \times 68^{\prime \prime}$, pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

## Making the Quilt

1. The blocks are made with black halfsquare triangles (HST) that finish $2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Use your favorite method to make HST, or follow these directions. Cut squares 3 " for HST that will be trimmed after stitching. If you prefer


HST
Make 4 per unit Diagram 1 not to trim, cut squares $2^{7} / 8^{\prime \prime}$. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a Fabric C $3^{\prime \prime}\left(2^{7 / s^{\prime \prime}}\right)$ square (Diagram 1). Place a marked square on a second black square, right sides together. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on each side of the marked line; cut apart on the marked line. Press open to make pieced HST. Trim to $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square if needed. Make 4 HST alike for each quarter block. Make 320 total HST.
2. For each quarter block, you need 4 HST alike and a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square from one of the black prints used in the HST. Referring to Diagram 2, arrange and join the HST, 1 black square, and 4 plaid squares in 3 rows as shown. Join the rows to make a quarter block. Make 80 quarter blocks.

3. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, arrange 4 quarter blocks to make a block. Make 20, distributing the fabrics so no block is the same as another.
4. To make a block row, join 4 blocks alternately with 5 sashes. Make 5 block rows.
5. To make a sash row, join 4 sashes alternately with 5 plaid $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, choosing 5 different plaids. Make 6 sash rows.
6. Join the block rows between the sash rows.

## Finishing the Quilt

7. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around block patches, or quilt an overall pattern. Bind to finish the quilt.
