



This Starry Ornament Table Runner is such a fun project to make up for Christmas! It would be a great gift as well! The table runner includes instructions for all three blocks as 12" blocks so you can mix and match them in any 12" block quilts.

Fabric Requirements 9 Fat Quarters - Sample uses Snow Sweet Fabric Collection 1/2 yard for border print 1 yard white background fabric 1 1/2 yard backing fabric Batting piece - 26" x 52"

FINISHED RUNNER SIZE: 23" X 48"



Fabric Prep and Cutting

Thanks so much for sewing up this Starry Ornament Table Runner Pattern! Please read through all instructions first. HST: Half Square Triangle WOF: Width of Fabric

## Cutting: (for 1 ornament block and 2 star blocks) From Print Fat Quarters:

A - 1 piece - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" (perfect for fussy cutting) B - 8 pieces - 2" x 2" C - 4 pieces - 2" x 2" D - 4 pieces - 2" x 3 1/2" E - 2 pieces - 2" x 6 1/2" F - 2 pieces - 2" x 9 1/2" G - 1 piece - 2" x 3 1/2" H - 2 pieces - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" I - 4 pieces - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" J - 4 pieces - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" K - 8 pieces - 4" x 4" L - 24 pieces - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" M - 4 pieces - 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" N - 2 pieces - 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" O - 10 pieces - 3 1/2" x 7 1/2" P - 4 pieces - 3 1/2" x 5 1/2" Q - 4 pieces - 2" x 2" R - 2 pieces - 2" x 3 1/2" S - 4 pieces - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

T - 8 pieces - 4" x 4" U - 8 pieces - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" V - 2 pieces - 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" W - 2 pieces - 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" X - 2 pieces - 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" Y - 2 pieces - 1 1/2" x 39 1/2" Z - 32 pieces - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" AA - 2 pieces 1 1/2" x 20 1/2"

BB - 3 strips - 1 1/2" x WOF

Cut 1 piece 24" x 50"




## Assembly:


For the Ornament block:

Begin by drawing a diagonal line on the wrong side of the B print pieces.


Place a B piece right sides together on one side of a D print piece. Sew across the marked line, trim 1/4" away from the seam and press the pieces open.



Repeat for the other side of the piece, sewing a B print piece on the right side, with the diagonal going the opposite way. Repeat for the other three star points for a total of 4.



Assemble the center of the ornament in the following layout, sewing the blocks together in rows, then sewing the rows together.




Sew together the top of the ornament with the G print piece and 2 R background pieces.




Draw a diagonal line on the 4 Q background pieces. Place one on each end of the F Ornament pieces, with the diagonal lines as below. Sew on the marked lines, trim 1/4 away from the seam

and press the pieces open.



Sew together the ornament in the following layout.





For the Ornament block: Sew a V background piece to the top and bottom of the ornament block.

**Note:** If you want to finish the ornament block as a 12" x 12" finished block, sew a 3 1/2" x 12 1/2" background piece on each side of the ornament block. We are NOT doing that for this table runner because of the border. :)

Sew a W background piece on each side of the ornament block.

For the Star block:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the I print fabrics. Place them right sides together with the J print pieces and create hst's with the pieces.



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Sew together the center of the star blocks in the following layout.

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the T background pieces. Place them right sides together with the K print pieces. Sew them into half square triangles.

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


Draw a diagonal line on each of the L print squares. On each of the half square triangles, place a L print square on the white background corner as shown. Sew across the marked line, then trim 1/4" away from the line. Press away from the hst.



Place a L print square on one corner of the U background squares. Sew along the marked line, trim 1/4" away from the seam and press the pieces open.









Assembly


For the Star block: Assemble the block in the following layout. Create two star blocks.

Sew together the three blocks, with the ornament block in the center, (with the sashing on each side) and star blocks on the ends.





Sew the X sashing pieces on the sides of the runner and the Y sashing pieces to the top and bottom of the runner.



Draw a diagonal line on the Z background fabric squares. Place a Z background piece on the following corners of the M border pieces.





For the N, O, and P border pieces, sew Z background pieces on BOTH corners.


Piece the border sides together with an M piece, and N piece, and an M piece, so the background corners are touching.






## Assembly:


Piece the top and bottom borders with a row of 5 O pieces and an P piece on each end.



Sew the border sides to the sides of the runner and the top and bottom borders in place.



Sew the AA background pieces to the left and right sides of the runner. Piece together the BB sashing and cut it into 2 pieces 47 1/2" long. Sew them to the top and bottom of the runner.



## Finishing:

Layer together the top, batting and backing of the runner. Quilt as desired. Cut your binding into 2 1/2" strips (I cut mine on the bias) and sew your binding on.
