


WEEK FOUR - COURTHOUSE STEPS BLOCKS



Make 16.

CUTTING FOR THE LAP QUILT:

From the Bee Backgrounds 10" stacker cut:

- 32 1 ½" squares (Placements 2 & 3)
- 32 1 ½" x 3 ¼" rectangles (Placements 6 & 7)
- 32 1 ½" x 5" rectangles (Placement 10 & 11)

From the Bee Basics 10" stacker cut:

- 16 1 ½" squares (Placement 1)
- 32 1 ½" x 3 ¼" rectangles (Placements 4 & 5)
- 32 1 ½" x 5 rectangles (Placements 8 & 9)
- 32 1 ½" x 7 ¼" rectangles (Placements 12 &13)



You will need 16 sheets of the 6" Courthouse Steps Quilt Block Foundation Paper #ISE-764

CUTTING FOR THE QUEEN QUILT:

From the Bee Backgrounds Fat Quarter Bundle cut:

- 32 2 ½" squares (Placements 2 & 3)
- 32 2 ½" x 6 ¼" rectangles (Placements 6 & 7)
- 32 2 ½" x 9 ½" rectangles (Placement 10 & 11)

From the Bee Basics Fat Quarter Bundle cut

- 16 2 ½" squares (Placement 1)
- 32 2 ½" x 6 ¼" rectangles (Placements 4 & 5)
- 32 2 ½" x 9 ½" rectangles (Placements 8 & 9)
- 32 2 ½" x 13 ¼" rectangles (Placements 12 &13)



You will need 16 sheets of the 12" Courthouse Steps Quilt Block Foundation Paper #ISF-765

BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

Following the instructions on the Courthouse Steps Block Foundation Paper, assemble 16 Courthouse Steps Blocks.

Courthouse Steps Blocks for the Lap Quilt should measure 6 ½" x 6 ½".

Courthouse Steps Blocks for the Queen Quilt should measure 12 ½" x 12 ½".



Make 16 Courthouse Steps Blocks.
