

Cutting

WOF = Width of Fabric

Fabrics A B, C, E, F, and G, cut from each:

(2) **identical** 3½" (8.89cm) x WOF strips

Fabric D, cut:

(4) 2" (5.08cm) x WOF strips

Fabric H, cut:

(6) 2" (5.08cm) x WOF strips; subcut (112) 2" x 2" (5.08cm x 5.08cm) squares

Fabric I, cut:

(6) 2" (5.08cm) x WOF strips; subcut (112) 2" x 2" (5.08cm x 5.08cm) squares

(4) 1½" (3.81cm) x WOF strips

Fabric J, cut:

(2) 9¾" (24.77cm) x WOF strips; subcut (5) 9¾" x 9¾" (24.77cm x 24.77cm) squares

(1) 5½" (13.97cm) x WOF strip; subcut (5) 5½" x 5½" (13.97cm x 13.97cm) squares

(1) 5⅞" (13.02cm) x WOF strip; subcut (8) 5⅞" x 5⅞" (13.02cm x 13.02cm) squares

(6) 2½" (6.35cm) x WOF strips for binding

Fabric K, cut:

(4) 2½" (6.35cm) x WOF strips

Fabric L, cut:

(7) 2⅜" (6.03cm) x WOF strips; subcut (112) 2⅜" x 2⅜" (6.03cm x 6.03cm) squares

Fabric M, cut:

(4) 4¼" (10.80cm) x WOF strips; subcut (28) 4¼" x 4¼" (10.80cm x 10.80cm) squares

Fabric N, cut:

(2) 9¾" (24.77cm) x WOF strips; subcut (5) 9¾" x 9¾" (24.77cm x 24.77cm) squares

and (2) 5⅞" x 5⅞" (13.02cm x 13.02cm) squares

(1) 3½" (8.89cm) x WOF strip; subcut (10) 3½" x 3½" (8.89cm x 8.89cm) squares


Sewing

All seam allowances are ¼" (.64cm) and pieces are sewn right sides together.

Block Assembly


1. Cut all **Fabrics J** and **N** 5⅞" (13.02cm) and **Fabric L** 2⅜" (6.03cm) squares in half diagonally. (**Fig. 1**)

2. Cut all **Fabrics J** and **N** 9¾" (24.77cm), **Fabric J** 5½" (13.97cm), and **Fabric M** 4¼" (10.80cm) squares in half diagonally twice. (**Fig. 2**) NOTE: Not all **Fabrics J** and **N** 9¾" (24.77cm) triangles will be used.

3. Sew (2) **Fabric L** 2⅜" (6.03cm) triangles to short edges of a **Fabric M** 4¼" (10.80cm) triangle as shown. Make a total of (112) Unit 1. (**Fig. 3**)

4. Arrange (2) each **Fabrics H** and **I** 2" (5.08cm) squares in (2) rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of (28) Unit 2. (**Fig. 4**)



5. Arrange (4) Unit 1, (1) Unit 2, and (2) each **Fabrics H** and **I** 2" (5.08cm) squares in (3) rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of (28) Block 1. (**Fig. 5**)



6. Sew (2) **Fabric J** 5½" (13.97cm) triangles to adjacent sides of a **Fabric N** 3½" (8.89cm) square as shown. Make a total of (10) Block 2. (**Fig. 6**)

7. From the (2) **Fabric A** 3½" (8.89cm) x WOF strips cut (2) different sets of (4) identical squares.

8. Arrange (4) identical **Fabric A** squares in (2) rows, each square turned 90 degrees from the one next to it as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to make Block 3. Make a second **Fabric A** Block 3 (with a different design) in the same manner. (**Fig. 7**)

9. Repeat Steps 7 and 8 to make (2) Blocks 3 each with **Fabrics B, C, E, F, and G**. (**Fig. 8**)

Quilt Top Assembly

10. Referring to **Quilt Layout** on page 5 for block placement and orientation, arrange (12) Block 1, (10) Block 2, (1) each Blocks 3A, 3B, 3C, 3E, 3F, and 3G, and **Fabric J** 5½" (13.02cm) triangles into (8) diagonal rows. Sew the blocks into rows. Sew rows together. Quilt center measures approximately 26" x 34½" (66.04cm x 87.63cm).
11. Sew 1½" (3.81cm) **Fabric I** strips to right and left sides of quilt. Press and trim excess. Add remaining **Fabric I** strips to top and bottom of quilt. Press and trim excess. In the same way, add **Fabric D** 2" (5.08cm) and **Fabric K** 2½" (6.35cm) borders to the quilt. Trim quilt to 34½" x 43" (87.63cm x 109.22cm) if needed.
12. Arrange (4) Block 1, (1) Block 3A, 4 each **Fabrics J** and **N** 9¼" (24.77cm) triangles, and 2 each **Fabrics J** and **N** 5½" (13.02cm) triangles in 7 diagonal rows on left side of quilt. Stitch into diagonal rows. Sew rows together and then stitch pieced border strip to left side of quilt. In a similar manner, make and add pieced border strips to right side, top, and bottom of the quilt.

Finishing

13. Cut and piece the backing to measure 62" x 70" (1.57m x 1.78m).
14. Sew together the (6) 2½" x WOF (6.35cm x WOF) **Fabric J** binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Press the seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
15. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top after quilting is completed.
16. Leaving an 8" (20.32cm) tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" (30.48cm) from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding right sides together. Trim seam to ¼" (.64cm) and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
17. Turn binding to back of quilt and hand-stitch in place.
