Additional Requirements

- 64" x 76" (162.56cm x 193.04cm) batting
- Matching thread
- Sewing machine
- Rotary cutter/mat/ruler
- Basic sewing and pressing supplies

Cutting

WOF = Width of Fabric

Fabrics A, B, C, D, E, F, J, K, L, P, Q, and AA, cut from each:

- (1) 8⅞" x 8⅞" (22.54cm x 22.54cm) square
- (2) 3⅞" x 11⅞" (8.57cm x 30.16cm) strips

Fabrics G, H, I, M, N, O, S, T, V, W, X, Y, and Z, cut from each:

- (1) 8⅞" x 8⅞" (22.54cm x 22.54cm) square
- (1) 3⅞" x 11⅞" (8.57cm x 30.16cm) strip

Fabric R, cut:

- (1) 8⅞" (22.54cm) x WOF strip; subcut (1) 8⅞" x 8⅞" (22.54cm x 22.54cm) square and
- (2) 3⅞" x 11⅞" (8.57cm x 30.16cm) strips
- (6) 3½" (8.89cm) x WOF strips

Fabric U, cut:

- (1) 8⅞" (22.54cm) x WOF strip; subcut (1) 8⅞" x 8⅞" (22.54cm x 22.54cm) square and
- (1) 3⅞" x 11⅞" (8.57cm x 30.16cm) strip
- (7) 2½" (6.35cm) x WOF strips for binding
- (6) 1½" (3.81cm) x WOF strips

Fabrics BB and CC, cut from each:

- (2) 5¼" (13.34cm) x WOF strips; subcut (10) 5¼" x 5¼" (13.34cm x 13.34cm) squares
- and (4) 3⅞" x 3⅞" (8.57cm x 8.57cm) squares
- (3) 3⅞" (8.57cm) x WOF strips; subcut (36) 3⅞" x 3⅞" (8.57cm x 8.57cm) squares


Sewing

All seam allowances are ¼" (.64cm) and pieces are sewn right sides together.

Block Assembly

1. Cut all **Fabrics A-AA** 8⅞" (22.54cm) squares in half diagonally. (**Fig. 1**) NOTE: Not all triangles will be used.


2. Cut all **Fabrics BB** and **CC** 5¼" (13.34cm) squares in half diagonally twice. (**Fig. 2**)


3. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of all **Fabrics BB** and **CC** 3⅞" (8.57cm) squares. (**Fig. 3**)


4. Arrange 1 each marked **Fabrics BB** and **CC** $3\frac{3}{8}$ " (8.57cm) squares right sides together on a **Fabric K** $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x $11\frac{1}{8}$ " (8.57cm x 30.16cm) strip as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to $\frac{1}{4}$ " (.64cm). Press triangles out to make Unit 1. Repeat with 1 each marked **Fabrics BB** and **CC** $3\frac{3}{8}$ " (8.57cm) squares and a **Fabric N** $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x $11\frac{1}{8}$ " (8.57cm x 30.16cm) strip to make Unit 2. (Fig. 4)

5. Stitch 1 each **Fabrics BB** and **CC** $5\frac{1}{4}$ " (13.34cm) triangles together as shown. Make a total of 40 Unit 3. (Fig. 5)

6. Arrange 1 each **Fabrics K** and **N** $8\frac{7}{8}$ " (22.54cm) triangles and Units 1 and 2 as shown. Stitch together. Add 2 Unit 3 as shown to complete a block. (Figs. 6 and 7)




Block Layout

7. Refer to the **Quilt Layout** on page 5 for fabric placement of the $8\frac{7}{8}$ " (22.54cm) triangles and $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x $11\frac{1}{8}$ " (8.57cm x 30.16cm) strips in each block. Make the remaining 19 blocks.

Quilt Top Assembly

8. Referring to the **Quilt Layout** for block placement and orientation, arrange (5) horizontal rows of (4) blocks each. Sew the blocks into rows. Sew rows together.
9. Sew together (6) **Fabric U** $1\frac{1}{2}$ " (3.81cm) strips end to end. From pieced strip, cut (2) lengths 64" (162.56cm) each and 2 lengths 54" (137.16cm) each. Sew longer strips to left and right sides of quilt. Press and trim excess. Add shorter strips to top and bottom of quilt. Press and trim excess. In the same way, sew together (6) **Fabric R** $3\frac{1}{2}$ " (8.89cm) strips. Cut (2) lengths 66" (167.64cm) each and (2) lengths 60" (152.40cm) each. Sew longer strips to sides; press and trim. Add shorter strips to top and bottom; press and trim.

Finishing

10. Cut and piece the backing to measure 64" x 76" (1.63m x 1.93m).
11. Sew together the (7) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF (6.35cm x WOF) **Fabric U** binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Press the seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
12. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top after quilting is completed.

13. Leaving an 8" (20.32cm) tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" (30.48cm) from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to 1/4" (.64cm) and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
14. Turn binding to back of quilt and hand-stitch in place.
