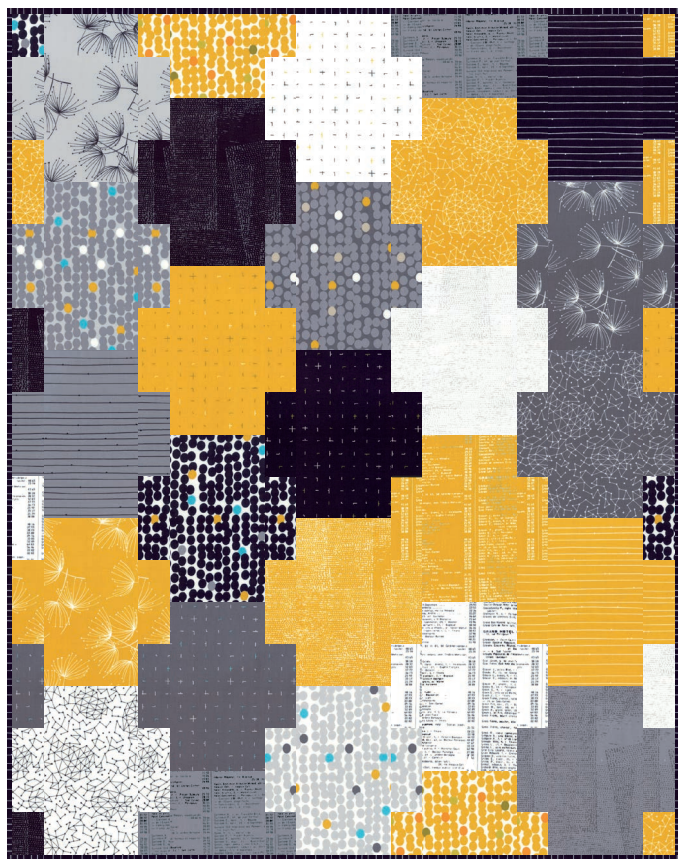


Fat Quarter Cobblestone Quilt Pattern

Shortcut Pattern



Finished Size: 63 1/2" x 80 1/2"

Fabric Requirements

One Fragile Fat Quarter Bundle (1630AB) or
twenty-five 18" x 20" rectangles
3/4 yard binding (1636-19)
5 yards backing (1630-11)

Cutting

Cut fifteen Fat Quarters into:

- 1 - 9 1/2" x 16 1/2" rectangle - 15 total (Fabric A)
- 2 - 3 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles - 30 total (Fabric B)

Cut eight Fat Quarters into:

- 1 - 9 1/2" x 16 1/2" rectangle - 8 total (Fabric C)
- 2 - 3 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles - 16 total (Fabric D)
- 1 - 3 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangle - 8 total (Fabric E)
- 1 - 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle - 8 total (Fabric F)*

Cut two Fat Quarters into:

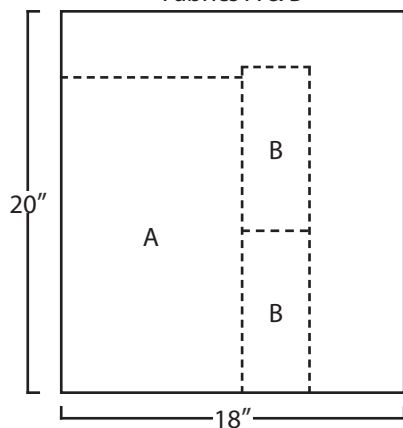
- 2 - 8 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles - 4 total (Fabric G)
- 4 - 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles - 8 total (Fabric H)

Cut binding fabric into:

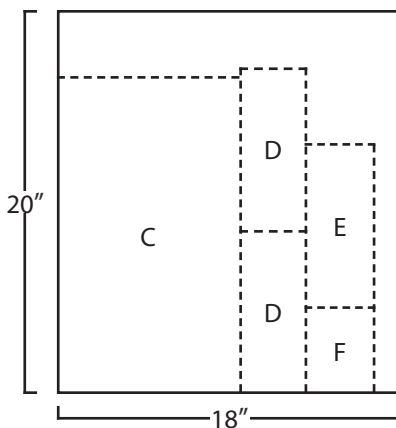
- 8 - 2 1/2" x width of fabric strips (Fabric I)

* You will not use four Fabric F rectangles.

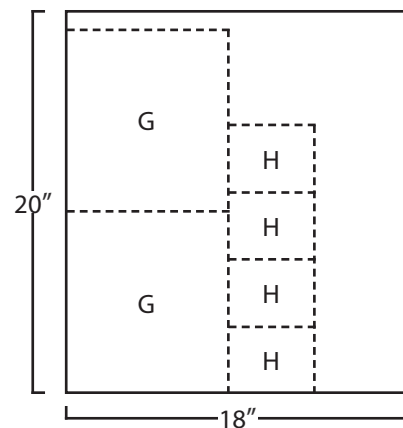
Fat Quarter cutting diagram for

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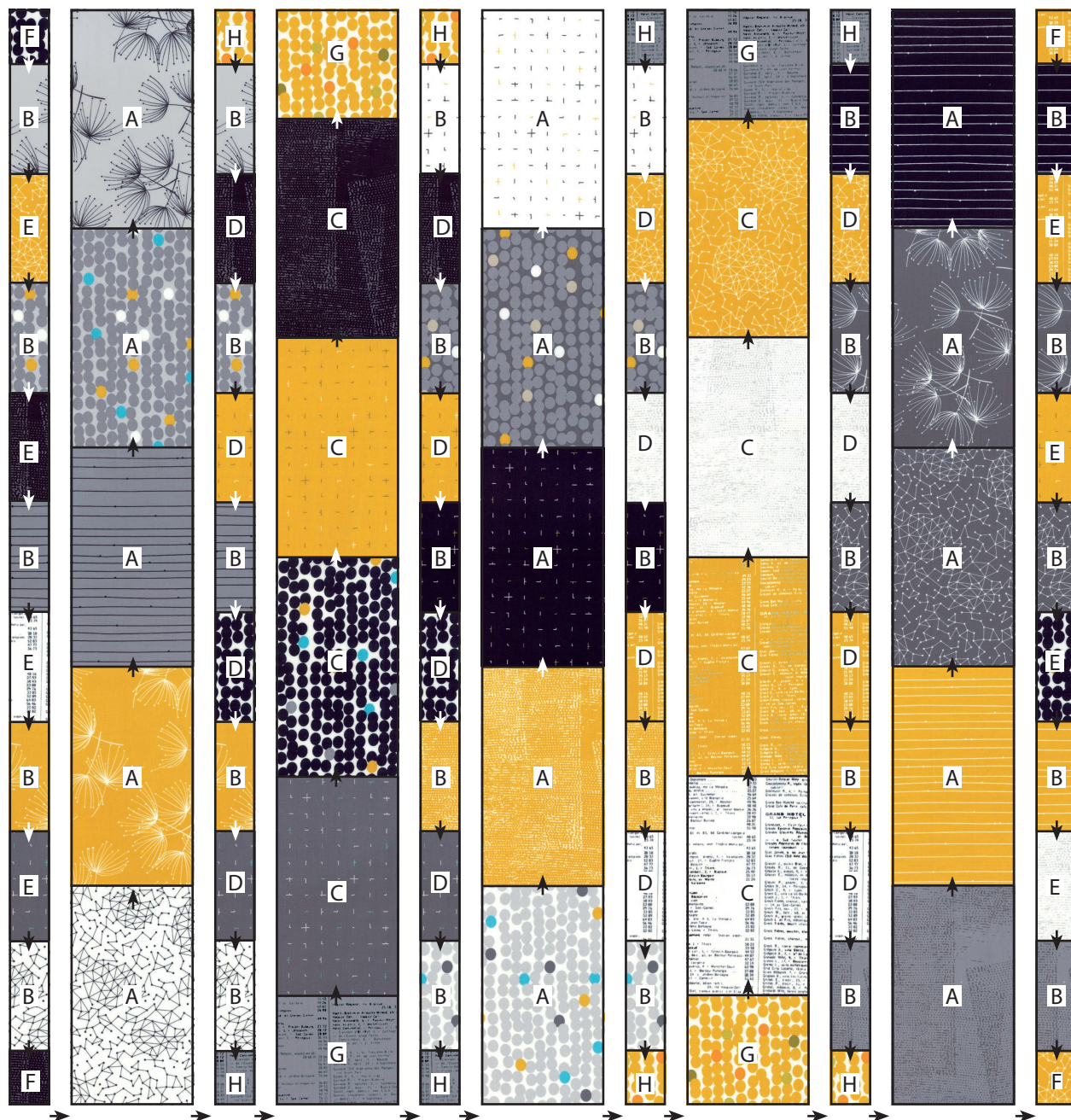
Fat Quarter Cobblestone Quilt Pattern

Shortcut Pattern

Quilt Center

Use ¼" seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

Assemble the Quilt Center. Quilt Center should measure 63 ½" x 80 ½".



Finishing

Piece the Fabric I strips end to end for binding.

Quilt and bind as desired.

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Fat Quarter Cobblestone Sizing Guide

Follow the assembly instructions in the original Fat Quarter Cobblestone pattern. This reference guide will assist in making the quilt in different sizes.

Crib Quilt

Finished Size: 39 1/2" x 48 1/2"

Fabric Requirements:

10 Fat Quarters (18" x 20" rectangles)

5/8 yard binding

2 3/4 yards backing

Cutting:

Cut six Fat Quarters into:

1 - 9 1/2" x 16 1/2" rectangle - 6 total (Fabric A)

2 - 3 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles - 12 total (Fabric B)

Cut two Fat Quarters into:

1 - 9 1/2" x 16 1/2" rectangle - 2 total (Fabric C)

2 - 3 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles - 4 total (Fabric D)

Cut one Fat Quarter into:

4 - 3 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles (Fabric E)

4 - 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles (Fabric F)

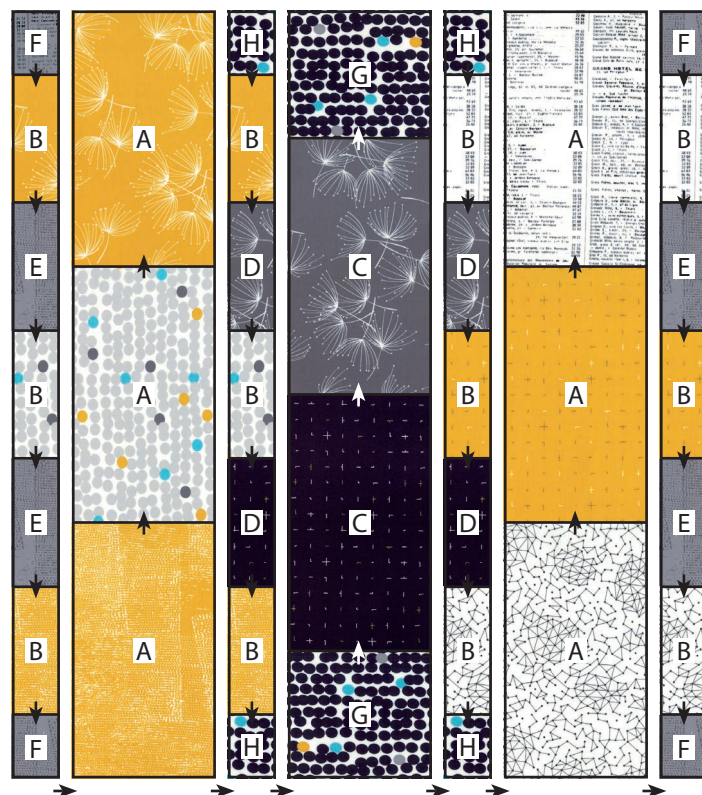
Cut one Fat Quarter into:

2 - 8 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles (Fabric G)

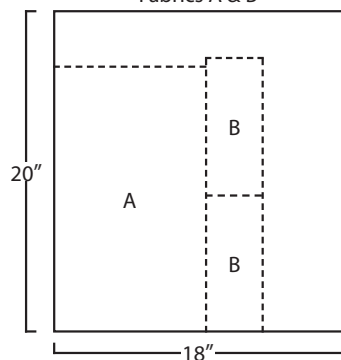
4 - 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles (Fabric H)

Cut binding fabric into:

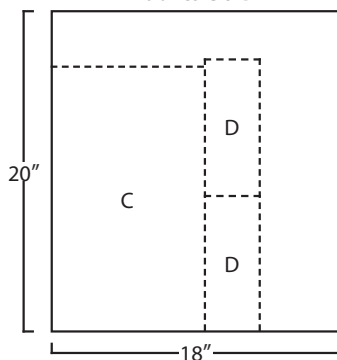
6 - 2 1/2" x width of fabric strips (Fabric I)



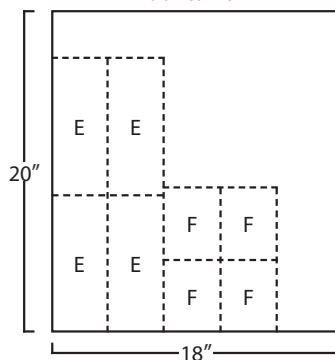
Fat Quarter cutting diagram for Fabrics A & B



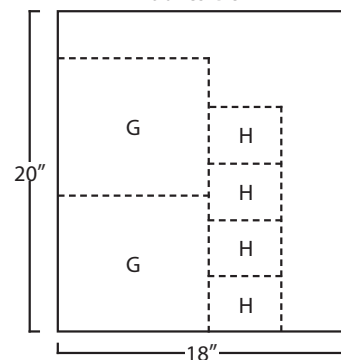
Fat Quarter cutting diagram for Fabrics C & D

Lap Quilt

Finished Size: 63 1/2" x 64 1/2"

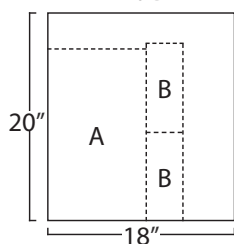
Fabric Requirements:

20 Fat Quarters (18" x 20" rectangles)

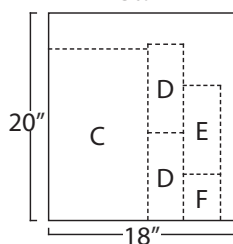
3/4 yard binding

4 1/8 yards backing

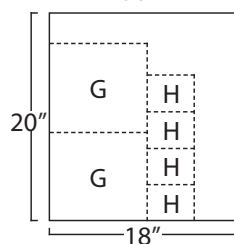
Fat Quarter cutting diagram for Fabrics A & B

Cutting:

Cut twelve Fat Quarters into:

1 - 9 1/2" x 16 1/2" rectangle - 12 total (Fabric A)

2 - 3 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles - 24 total (Fabric B)

Cut six Fat Quarters into:

1 - 9 1/2" x 16 1/2" rectangle - 6 total (Fabric C)

2 - 3 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles - 12 total (Fabric D)

1 - 3 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangle - 6 total (Fabric E)

1 - 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle - 6 total (Fabric F)*

Cut two Fat Quarters into:

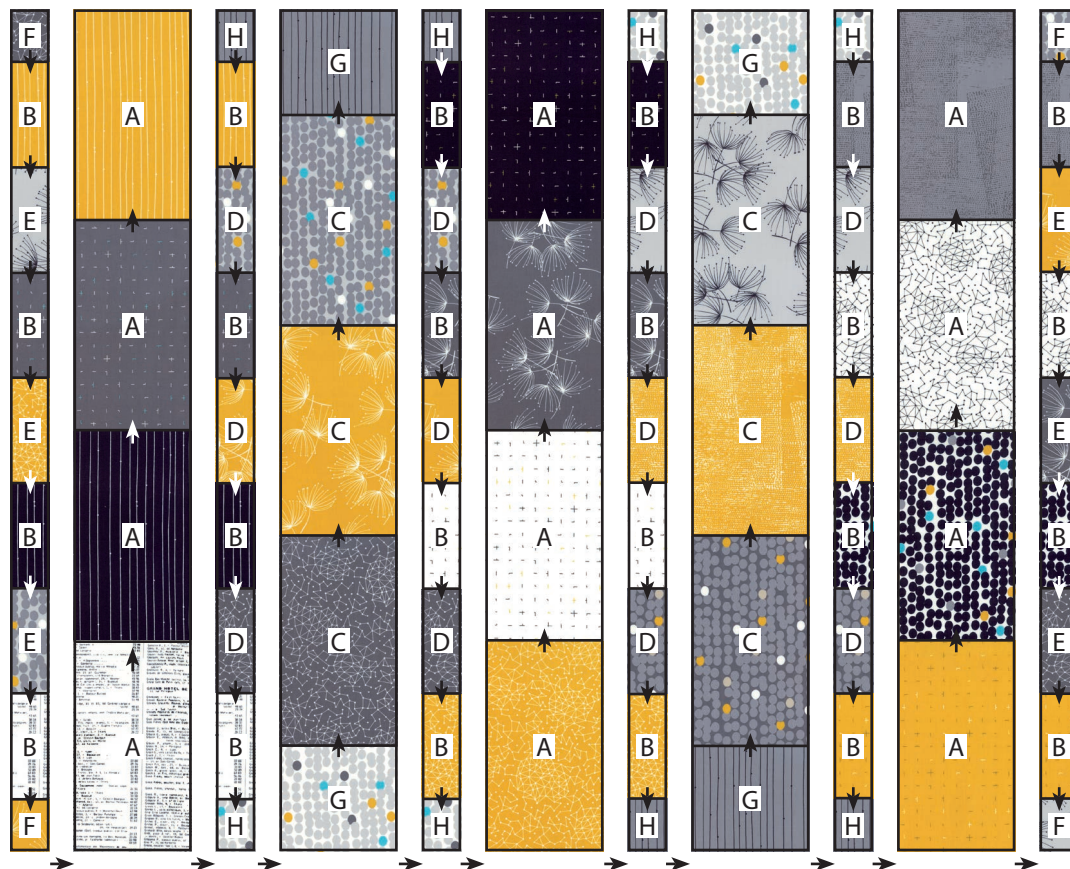
2 - 8 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles - 4 total (Fabric G)

4 - 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles - 8 total (Fabric H)

Cut binding fabric into:

8 - 2 1/2" x width of fabric strips (Fabric I)

* You will not use two Fabric F rectangles.

Queen Quiet

Finished Size: 87 1/2" x 96 1/2"

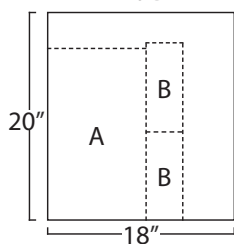
Fabric Requirements:

42 Fat Quarters (18" x 20" rectangles)

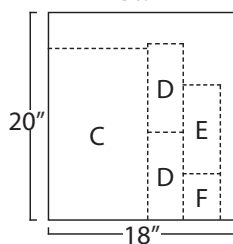
7/8 yard binding

8 1/8 yards backing

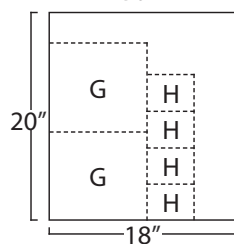
Fat Quarter cutting diagram for Fabrics A & B

Cutting:

Cut twenty-four Fat Quarters into:

1 - 9 1/2" x 16 1/2" rectangle - 24 total (Fabric A)

2 - 3 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles - 48 total (Fabric B)

Cut fifteen Fat Quarters into:

1 - 9 1/2" x 16 1/2" rectangle - 15 total (Fabric C)

2 - 3 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles - 30 total (Fabric D)

1 - 3 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangle - 15 total (Fabric E)*

1 - 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle - 15 total (Fabric F)**

Cut three Fat Quarters into:

2 - 8 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles - 6 total (Fabric G)

4 - 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles - 12 total (Fabric H)

Cut binding fabric into:

10 - 2 1/2" x width of fabric strips (Fabric I)

* You will not use five Fabric E rectangles.

** You will not use eleven Fabric F rectangles.
