



## WEEK TWO - ECONOMY BLOCKS





## CUTTING FOR THE LAP QUILT:

Placements 1 and 6 - 9 are cut from Light fabrics (Bee Backgrounds). Placements 2 - 5 are cut from Dark fabrics (Bee Basics).

From the Bee Backgrounds 10" stacker cut:

8 - 4" squares (Placement 1)

16 - 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares (Placements 6 - 9)

From the Bee Basics 10" stacker cut:

16 - 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares (Placements 2 - 5)



You will need 8 sheets of the 6" Economy Quilt Block Foundation Paper #ISE-760

## CUTTING FOR THE QUEEN QUILT:

The Fussy Cut Center Option and Placements 14 - 17 are cut from Light fabrics (Bee Backgrounds). Placements 10 - 13 are cut from Dark fabrics (Bee Basics).

From the Bee Backgrounds Fat Quarter Bundle cut:

8 - 6 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" squares (Fussy Cut Center Option) 16 - 7 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares (Placements 14 - 17)

From the Bee Basics Fat Quarter Bundle cut: 16 - 5 ½" squares (Placements 10 - 13)



You will need 8 sheets of the 12" Economy Quilt Block Foundation Paper #ISE-761

## BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

Following the instructions on the Economy Block Foundation Paper, assemble 8 Economy Blocks.

Economy Blocks for the Lap Quilt should measure  $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6 \frac{1}{2}$ ".

Economy Blocks for the Queen Quilt should measure  $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12 \frac{1}{2}$ ".



Make 8 Economy Blocks.
