## (Culling Instructions:

i !	One Block
Light Print	1 - 4 ½" square (A)
	16 - 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles (B)
Dark Print	1 - 12 ¾" square (C)
	2 - 4" squares (D)
 	32 - 2 ½" squares (E)

Use 1/4" seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

## Block Assembly:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric E squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric E square on one end of a Fabric B rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.





Repeat on the opposite end.

Flying Geese Unit should measure 2 1/2" x 4 1/2".





Make sixteen.

Assemble four matching Flying Geese Units. Goose Chase Unit should measure 4 ½" x 8 ½".





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Cut the Fabric D squares on the diagonal once.







Cut the Fabric C square on the diagonal twice.







Assemble two Fabric D triangles, two Goose Chase Units and the Fabric A square. Make one Center Wild Goose Unit.





Assemble two Fabric C triangles, one Goose Chase Unit and one Fabric D triangle. Make two Outer Wild Goose Units.





Assemble the Wild Goose Chase Block.

Trim the Wild Goose Chase Block to measure 17 1/2" x 17 1/2".
