## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## From Fabric A, cut:

four 4-1/4" $\times$ WOF strips. Subcut:
thirty 4-1/4" squares
twenty-eight 1-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:
one hundred twenty $1-3 / 4$ " $\times 4-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles one hundred twenty $1-3 / 4$ " $\times$ 3" rectangles one hundred twenty 1-3/4" squares

From Fabric B, cut:
five 1-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:
forty $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3$ " rectangles for Block 3
forty 1-3/4" squares for Block 3
From Fabric C, cut:
seven 1-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:
forty $1-3 / 4$ " $\times 2-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles for Block 3
forty $1-3 / 4$ " $\times 3-5 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles for Block 3
From Fabric D, cut:
seventeen 1-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:
forty $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3$ " rectangles for Block 3
forty $1-3 / 4$ " $\times 4-1 / 4$ " rectangles for Block 3
fifty-six 1-3/4" x 2-3/8" rectangles for Block 2
fifty-six 1-3/4" $\times 3-5 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles for Block 2
From Fabric E , cut:
five 1-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twenty-four 1-3/4" $\times$ 3" rectangles for Block 1
twenty-four 1-3/4" $\times 4-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles for Block 1
From Fabric F , cut:
ten 1-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:
fifty-six 1-3/4" x 3" rectangles for Block 2
fifty-six 1-3/4" squares for Block 2
twenty-four 1-3/4" x 3" rectangles for Block 1 twenty-four 1-3/4" squares for Block 1

From Fabric G, cut:
fifteen 1-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:
fifty-six 1-3/4" $\times 3^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles for Block 2
fifty-six 1-3/4" $\times 4-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles for Block 2
twenty-four 1-3/4" x 2-3/8" rectangles for Block 1 twenty-four 1-3/4" $\times 3-5 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles for Block 1

From the Binding Fabric, cut:
seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips


Step 1: Gather: one 4-1/4" Fabric A square four 1-3/4" Fabric A squares four 1-3/4" $\times 3^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangles four $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangles four 1-3/4" Fabric F squares four 1-3/4" $\times 3^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F rectangles four $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 2-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G rectangles four $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3-5 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G rectangles four 1-3/4" $\times 3^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E rectangles four $1-3 / 4$ " $\times 4-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E rectangles

Arrange the units as shown. Note the fabric placement in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 2: Sew 1-3/4" Fabric F squares to opposite sides of a 1-3/4" Fabric A square. Press toward the darker fabric. Repeat to make a second unit like this. Sew the units to opposite sides of the 4-1/4" Fabric A Square. Press.
Step 3: Sew $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $F$ rectangles to opposite sides of a $1-3 / 4$ " Fabric A square. Press toward the darker fabric. Repeat to make a second unit like this. Sew the units to the remaining edges of the $4-1 / 4$ " Fabric $A$ Square. Press.

Step 4: Sew $1-3 / 4$ " $\times 2-3 / 8$ " Fabric $G$ rectangles to opposite sides of a $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ $\times 3$ " Fabric A rectangle. Press toward the darker fabric. Repeat to make a second unit like this. Sew the units to left and right edges of the block unit. Press.

Step 5: Sew $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3-5 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G rectangles to opposite sides of a $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ $\times 3$ " Fabric A rectangle. Press toward the darker fabric. Repeat to make a second unit like this. Sew the units to top and bottom edges of the block unit. Press.


Step 6: Sew $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E rectangles to opposite sides of a $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ $4-1 / 4$ " Fabric A rectangle. Press toward the darker fabric. Repeat to make a second unit like this. Sew the units to left and right edges of the block unit. Press.

Step 7: Sew 1-3/4" $\times 4-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E rectangles to opposite sides of a 1-3/4" x 4-1/4" Fabric A rectangle. Press toward the darker fabric. Repeat to make a second unit like this. Sew the units to top and bottom edges of the block unit. Press. [illo of this]

The Block 1 unit should measure 11-3/4" square. Repeat Steps 1-7 to make six Block 1 units.


Step 8: Gather: : one 4-1/4" Fabric A square four $1-3 / 4$ " Fabric A squares four $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangles four $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangles four 1-3/4" Fabric F squares four 1-3/4" $\times 3^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F rectangles four $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 2-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D rectangles four $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3-5 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D rectangles four $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G rectangles four $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G rectangles

Arrange the units as shown. Note the fabric placement in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 9: Sew the Block 2 unit together using the process shown in Steps 1-7. Repeat to make fourteen Block 2 units.

## Assemble the Block 3 Units



Step 10: Gather: one 4-1/4" Fabric A square four 1-3/4" Fabric A squares
four 1-3/4" $\times 3^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangles
four $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangles
four $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $B$ squares
four 1-3/4" $\times 3^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B rectangles four $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 2-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C rectangles four $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3-5 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C rectangles four $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D rectangles four $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D rectangles

Arrange the units as shown. Note the fabric placement in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 11: Sew the Block 3 unit together using the process shown in Steps 1-7. Repeat to make ten Block 3 units.


Step 12: Arrange the blocks into six rows of five blocks. Note the block placement in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 13: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

Step 14: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.
Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
