## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least $43^{\prime \prime}$ wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Cutting Instructions

## From Fabric A, fussy cut:

one 21-1/2" $\times 42-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ center panel

## From Fabric B, cut:

four 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two $2^{\prime \prime} \times 42-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side Border 1 strips
two 2 " $\times 24-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom Border 1 strips

## From Fabric C, cut:

eight 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twenty 1-1/2" squares
Sew the remaining strips together, end-to-end, then cut:
four $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 45-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side Border 2 and Border 4 strips
four $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 24-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom Border 2 and Border 4 strips

## From Fabric D, cut:

two 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two 1-1/2" $\times 24-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom Border 3 strips
eight $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares

## From Fabric E , cut:

three $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end-to-end, then cut:
two 1-1/2" $\times 45-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side Border 3 strips
eight $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares

## From Fabric F, cut:

five 2 " $\times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end-to-end, then cut:
two $2^{\prime \prime} \times 51-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side Border 5 strips
two 2" x 33-1/2" top/bottom Border 5 strips

## From Fabric G, cut:

five $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end-to-end, then cut:
two $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 54-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side Border 6 strips
two 1-1/2" $\times 35-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom Border 6 strips

## From Fabric H , cut:

five 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end-to-end, then cut:
two 2-1/2" $\times 56-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side Border 7 strips
two 2-1/2" x 35-1/2" top/bottom Border 7 strips
From Fabric I, cut:
one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
four 2-1/2" squares
five $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end-to-end, then cut:
two 1-1/2" $\times 60-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side Border 8 strips
two 1-1/2" $\times 41-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom Border 8 strips

From Fabric J, cut:
two 7 " x length of fabric strips. Then trim:
two 7" $\times 62-1 / 2 "$ side Border 8 strips
four strips 7" $x$ the remaining WOF. Sew the strips together, end-to-end, then cut:
two 7" $\times 54-1 / 2 "$ top/bottom Border 8 strips
From the Binding Fabric, cut:
seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips
Assemble the Quilt Center


Step 1: Sew the Fabric B side Border 1 strips to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric B top and bottom Border 1 strips to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Assemble Borders 2, 3 and 4


## Step 3: Gather:

five 1-1/2" Fabric C squares
two 1-1/2" Fabric D squares
two 1-1/2" Fabric E squares
Arrange in three rows of three to form a nine-patch, as shown. Note the placement of the D and E squares.

Step 4: Sew the squares together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows. Sew the rows together to form the block. Press the row seams open. The block should measure 3-1/2" square. Repeat Steps 3 and 4 to make a total of four blocks.

Step 5: Sew a Fabric D top/bottom Border 3 strip between two Fabric C top/bottom Border 2 and 4 strips, along the longest side. Press toward the darker fabric. Repeat to make a second unit like this.


Step 6: Sew a Fabric E side Border 3 strip between two Fabric C side Border 2 and 4 strips, along the longest side. Press toward the darker fabric. Repeat to make a second unit like this.


Step 7: Sew the completed Step 6 units to the sides of the quilt center. Press.
Step 8: Sew a completed Step 4 block each end of a completed Step 5 unit, matching the Fabric D pieces. Press. Repeat to make a second unit like this.


Step 9: Sew the completed Step 8 units to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press.



Step 10: Sew the Fabric F side Border 5 strips to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric F top and bottom Border 5 strips to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 11: Sew the Fabric G side Border 6 strips to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric G top and bottom Border 6 strips to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 12: Sew the Fabric $H$ side Border 7 strips to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew a Fabric I square to each end of the Fabric H top/bottom Border 7 strips. Press. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press.

Step 13: Sew the Fabric I side Border 8 strips to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric I top and bottom Border 8 strips to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 14: Sew the Fabric J side Border 9 strips to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric J top and bottom Border 9 strips to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
