STAR BLOCK

- 1. Flying Geese Unit: Sew (2) C HST to the short sides of (1) E QST. Press seams toward C. Measures 1-1/2" x 2-1/2". Make (96).
- 2. Sew (2) Flying Geese Units onto the sides of (1) M 2-1/2" square. Press seams toward M. Make (24).
- 3. Sew (2) E 1-1/2" squares to both ends of (1) Flying Geese Unit. Press seams toward E. Make (48).
- 4. Brown Stars: Sew (2) units made from Step 3 to the top and bottom of the unit made in Step 2. Note rotation. Press seams away from the center. Square to 4-1/2". Make (24).
- 5. Sage Stars: Repeat Steps 1-4, using (24) N squares, (192) G HST, (96) E 1-1/2" squares and QST.















Step 5 - Sage Star






Make (24) of each. Square to 4-1/2".



HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE / STAR UNITS

- **6.** Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) **I** 2-7/8" square. Lay **I** and (1) **D** 2-7/8" square, right sides together. Sew 1/4" from both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line. Open and press seam toward **D**. Make (240).
- 7. Sew (96) of the I/D HST units into (48) pairs. Note rotation. Press the seams to one side.
- **8.** Sew the (48) pairs made in **Step 7** to the left side of (24) **Brown** and (24) **Sage Stars**. Note rotation. Press the seams away from the **Stars**.
- **9.** Sew the remaining (144) pieced triangles (**Step 6**) into sets of (3). Press seams in the same direction. Sew these to the adjoining sides of all of the **Brown** and **Sage Star** units, as shown. Press seams away from the **Stars**.





Make (24) of each Brown and Sage Star Units.



BLOCK UNIT

- **10.** Noting rotation, arrange and sew (1) Brown Star Unit, (1) B 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle and (1) Sage Star Unit together, as shown below. Make (2).
- **11.** Sew (2) **B** 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles to the sides of (1) **K** 2-1/2" square. Make (12).
- **12.** Noting orientation, sew (2) units from **Step 10** and (1) from **Step 11** together to complete (1) **Block**, as shown below. Square to 14-1/2". Make (12).

- **13.** Block Rows: Arrange and sew (3) Blocks alternating with and (4) **H** 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" rectangles, as shown. Press seams toward **H**. Make (4) Block rows.
- **14.** Sashing Rows: Sew (4) L 2-1/2" squares alternating with (3) H 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" rectangles together into a row. Press seams towards H. Make (5) Sashing Rows.
- **15.** Referring to the **Quilt Assembly** diagram on page 7, sew (4) **Block Rows** and (5) **Sashing Rows** together, alternately. Press seams toward the **Sashing Rows**.



BORDERS

- **16.** Inner Border: From the long strip, cut (2) **N** 66-1/2" long border strips. Sew these to the sides of the Quilt Top. Press seams toward **N**. From the remaining long strip, cut (2) **N** 60-1/2" long border strips. Sew these to the top and bottom of the Quilt Top. Press seams toward **N**.
- 17. Outer Border: Repeat Step 6 to make (68) of each fabric combination, using 2-7/8" squares of each J/A and J/D. Press seams toward A and D. Square to 2-1/2".

- **18.** Sew (19) of each **J/A** and **J/D** units into a row, alternately. Press all seams in the same direction. Make (2). Sew these to the sides of the **Quilt Top** with the **A** and **D** triangles toward the **Inner Border (N)**. Pin where necessary. Press seam toward **N**.
- 19. Repeating Step 18, use (15) of each J/A and J/D units. Add (2) A 2-1/2" squares to both ends of one row and (2) D 2-1/2" squares to both ends of the other row. Press seam toward squares. Sew these to the top and bottom of the Quilt Top. Press seams toward the Inner Border.



Quilt Assembly



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **F** 2-1/4" strips.
