## Fabric Requirements

1 yard Kim-C6100 Bark
1/4 yard Nature-C7468 Multi
$1 / 4$ yard Kim-C6100 Seaweed
11/4 yards Soho-Black
¹/2 yard Nature-C7466 Brown
1 yard Nature-C7465 Multi
One panel ( $2 / 3$ ) yard Panel-C7464 Multi
35/8 yards Mountain Vista backing fabric of your choice 63" $\times 70$ " batting

## Cutting

For easier assembly, label the fabric pieces as indicated when you cut them. Note the orientation of directional prints as they will appear in the finished quilt.

## From Kim-C6100 Bark:

- Cut eleven $1^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ width-of-fabric (WOF) strips for the second and fourth borders.
- Cut six $2^{1 / 14^{\prime \prime}} \times$ WOF strips for binding.


## From Nature-C7468 Multi:

- Start at the left side and work your way across the fabric width cutting the following sky units: One $4^{1 / 2 "} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle (A1), one $5^{\prime \prime}$ square (A2), one $5^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1 / 2 "}$ strip (A3), one $5^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip (A4),



## From Kim-C6100 Seaweed:

- Cut one $6^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut two $4^{1 ⁄ 21} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles (B), two $5^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles (C) and two $6^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1 / 2 "}$ rectangles (D).


## From Soho-Black:

- Cut six $3^{1 / 21} \times$ WOF strips for the first border.
- Cut ten $1^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut five $1^{1 / 2 "} \times 32^{1 / 2 "}$ strips, five $1^{1 / 2 "} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ strips and five $1^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Sew the remaining strips together and cut two $1^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}} \times 42^{1 / 2 "}$ strips.


## From Nature-C7466 Brown:

- Cut six $2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for the third border.


## From Nature-C7465 Multi:

- Cut two $5^{\prime \prime} \times 32^{1 / 21} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips x length-of-fabric (LOF) strips (E).
- Cut two $4^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 32^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ LOF strips ( $\mathbf{F}$ ), two $4^{1 / 2 "} \times 5^{1 / 2 "}$ LOF rectangles (G) and two $5^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{1 / 2 "}$ LOF rectangles (H).


## From Panel-C7464 Multi:

- Following the quilt image for placement and orientation in the window, cut two $10^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 32^{1 / 2 "}$ strips for the middle portion of the window ( $\mathbf{J}$ ) and two $5^{1 / 21} \times 10^{1 / 21} 2^{\text {" }}$ rectangles to line up below the corresponding larger panel portions (K).


## Quilt Top Assembly

All seam allowances are ${ }^{1 / 4 "}$ and pieces are sewn right sides together.

1. Following Figure 1, alternately sew together the $1^{1 / 2 "} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ Soho-Black strips and the designated C7468 Multi units to make the sky panel. Press the seam allowances toward the Soho-Black strips.

2. Following Figure 2, alternately sew together the designated fabrics and $1^{1 / 2} 2^{\text {" }} \times 32^{1} / 2^{\text {" }}$ Soho-Black strips to make the middle panel. Press the seam allowances away from the Soho-Black strips.

Middle Panel
3. Sew together the designed upper and lower fabrics (figure 3).

Make 2 of each.
4. Following Figure 4, alternately sew together the step 3 sections and the $1^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ Soho-Black strips. Press the seam allowances toward the Soho-Black strips.

Ground Panel
5. Lay out the sky, middle and ground sections in order and sew them together, adding a $1^{1 / 21} \times 42^{1 / 2 "}$ Soho-Black strip between and aligning adjacent section seams (figure 5). Press the seam allowances in one direction.

6. Sew the $3^{1 / 21} \times$ WOF Soho-Black strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center and cut two strips that length from the pieced strip. Sew one strip to the top and the other strip to the bottom of the quilt top. Press seam allowances toward the border.
7. Measure the length of the quilt top through the center. Cut two strips that length from the remaining pieced border strip. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top. Press the seam allowances toward the border.
8. Repeat steps 6 and 7 to sequentially add the $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ C6100 Bark border, the 2" C7466 Brown border and the $1 \not 1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ C6100 Bark border.

## Finishing

9. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing, and quilt as desired.
10. Stitch the binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Stitch to the quilt front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
11. Fold the binding to the quilt underside and hand-stitch the folded edge to the quilt back.
