


Save the Bees

Finished quilt size: 431/2" x 58"

Fabric Requirements

One panel (²/₃ yard) Panel-C8121 Black ⁷/₈ yard Bee-C8126 Honey (includes ¹/₂ yard for binding) ³/₄ yard Soho-White ⁵/₈ yard Bee-C8125 Black ³ yards backing fabric of your choice 52" × 66" batting

Cutting

From Panel-C8121 Black:

• Trim the panel to $22^{1/2"} \times 40^{1/2"}$.

From Bee-C8126 Honey:

- Cut two $2^{1/2^{"}} \times$ width-of-fabric (WOF) strips. Sub-cut two $2^{1/2^{"}} \times 40^{1/2^{"}}$ strips.
- Cut two $2^{1/4"} \times WOF$ strips. Sub-cut two $2^{1/4"} \times 26^{1/2"}$ strips.
- Cut six $2^{1/2^{"}} \times WOF$ binding strips.

From Soho-White:

- Cut five 3" × WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end. Cut two 3" × 44" strips and two 3" × 54" strips.
- Cut four $2^{1}/2^{"} \times WOF$ strips. Sub-cut two $2^{1}/2^{"} \times 31^{1}/2^{"}$ strips. Sew the remaining two strips together end to end and add a leftover strip, then cut two $2^{1}/2^{"} \times 43^{1}/2^{"}$ strips.


From Bee-C8125 Black:

- Cut three 4" × WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end and cut two 4" × 48" strips.
- Cut two $3^{1/2^{"}} \times WOF$ strips. Sub-cut two $3^{1/2^{"}} \times 38^{1/2^{"}}$ strips.


Quilt Top Assembly

All seam allowances are 1/4" and pieces are sewn right sides together.

- 1. Sew one $2^{1}/2^{"} \times 40^{1}/2^{"}$ C8126 Honey strip to each side of the C8121 Black panel.
- 2. Sew a $2^{1}/4^{"} \times 26^{1}/2^{"}$ C8126 Honey strip to the top and another to the bottom of the panel.
- 3. Following the Quilt Assembly Diagram, continue to add borders to the quilt top center in the following order:
 - $3^{"} \times 44^{"}$ Soho-White strip to each side



- $2^{1}/2^{"} \times 31^{1}/2^{"}$ Soho-White strip to the top and another to the bottom
- $4" \times 48"$ C8125 Black strip to each side
- $3^{1}/2^{"} \times 38^{1}/2^{"}$ C8125 Black strip to the top and another to the bottom
- $3" \times 54"$ Soho-White strip to each side
- $2^{1/2^{"}} \times 43^{1/2^{"}}$ Soho-White strip to the top and another to the bottom

Finishing

- 4. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing, and quilt as desired.
- 5. Stitch the binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Stitch to the quilt front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
- 6. Fold the binding to the quilt underside and hand-stitch the folded edge to the quilt back.

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
