## Fabric Requirements

One panel ( $2 / 3$ yard) Panel-C8317 Multi
3/4 yard Soho-White
3/4 yard Mix-C7200 Denim
2/3 yard Mix-C7200 Cranberry
21⁄8 yards Mix-C7200 Cream
3/8 yard USA-C8320 Multi
5/8 yard USA-C8323 Multi
$2^{1 / 4}$ yards USA-C8324 Blue
3/4 yard USA-C8325 Red (binding)
5½ yards USA-C8320 Multi (backing)
$81^{\prime \prime} \times 99^{\prime \prime}$ batting

## Cutting

## From Panel-C8317 Multi:

- Centering the design, trim the panel to $23^{\prime \prime} \times 41^{\prime \prime}$.


## From Soho-White:

- Cut four $2^{\prime \prime} \times$ width-of-fabric (WOF) strips. Sub-cut two $2^{\prime \prime} \times 26^{\prime \prime}$ strips and two $2^{\prime \prime} \times 41^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut four $1^{1 / 21} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut two $1^{1 / 21} \times 30^{1 / 21} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Sew the leftover fabric to the remaining two WOF strips, and sub-cut two $1^{1 / 2 "} \times 46^{1 / 2 "}$ strips.
- Cut six $1^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end and sub-cut two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 44^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}}$ strips and two $1^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}} \times 60^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}}$ strips.


## From Mix-C7200 Denim:

- Cut four $1^{3 / 14^{\prime \prime} \times \text { WOF strips. Sub-cut two }}$ $1^{3 / 4} \times 28^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Sew the leftover fabric to the remaining two WOF strips, and sub-cut two $1^{3 / 4^{\prime \prime}} \times 44^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut six $1^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end and sub-cut two $1^{1 / 21} \times 46^{1 / 2 "}$ strips and two $1^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}} \times 62^{1 / 2 \text { " }}$ strips.
- Cut two 2 " $\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut thirty-two 2" squares.
- Cut one $3^{1 / 21} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut four $3^{1 / 21}$ squares.


## From Mix-C7200 Cranberry:

- Cut three $2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut forty-eight 2" squares.
- Cut one $3^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut six $3^{1} / 2^{\text {" }}$ squares.
- Cut eight $1^{1 / 2 "} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end and sub-cut two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 65^{1 / 21}$ strips and two $1^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}} \times 81^{1 / 2 "}$ strips.

From Mix-C7200 Cream:

- Cut six $1 \frac{1}{1 / 2} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end and sub-cut two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 48^{1 / 2 " 1}$ strips and two $1^{1 / 21} \times 64^{1 / 2 " 1}$ strips.
- Cut nine $2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (168) $2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
- Cut nine $3^{1 / 21} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (168) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.
- Cut eight $2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end and sub-cut two $2^{\prime \prime} \times 63^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and two $2^{\prime \prime} \times 78^{1 / 2 "} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.


## From USA-C8320 Multi:

- Cut four $2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut eighty $2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
- Cut one $3^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut ten $3^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}}$ squares.
From USA-C8323 Multi:
- Cut six $2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (112) $2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
- Cut two $3^{1 / 21} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut fourteen $3^{1 / 21} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.


## From USA-C8324 Blue:

- Cut five $6^{1 / 21} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end and sub-cut two $6^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}} \times 42^{1 / 21}$ " strips and two $6^{1 / 2 "} \times 48^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}}$ strips.
- Cut four $2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut sixty-four 2" squares.
- Cut one $3^{1 / 21} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut eight $3^{1 / 21}$ " squares.
- Cut eight $4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end and sub-cut two $4^{\prime \prime} \times 72^{1 / 21} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and two $4^{\prime \prime} \times 83^{1 / 21} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
From USA-C8325 Red:
- Cut nine $2^{1 / 21} \times$ WOF binding strips.


## Block Construction

All seam allowances are ${ }^{1 / 4 \prime}$ and pieces are sewn right sides together.

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of one $2^{\prime \prime}$ fabric print square. Place the square on one corner of one $2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{11 / 2 "}$ C7200 Cream rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim ${ }^{1 / 4 "}$ away from sewn line. Open out and press the corner triangle. Repeat with a matching 2" fabric print square on the opposite corner of the same rectangle (figure 1). Make a total of four matching flying-geese units.

2. Sew one flying-geese unit to each side of a matching $3^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ fabric print square to make a row unit (figure 2).

3. Sew one 2" C7200 Cream square to each end of a step 1 unit (figure 3). Repeat to make a second unit.

4. Sew together the three units to complete one $6^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ Star Block (figure 4).

5. Make the following quantities of Star Blocks, each with a C7200 Cream background (figure 5):

C7200 Denim Make 4.


C8320 Multi Make 10.


C7200 Cranberry Make 6.


## Quilt Top Assembly

6. Sew one $2^{\prime \prime} \times 41^{\prime \prime}$ Soho-White strip to each side of the $23^{\prime \prime} \times 41^{\prime \prime}$ C8317 Multi quilt center, followed by one $2^{\prime \prime} \times 26^{\prime \prime}$ Soho-White strip to the top and the other to the bottom.
7. Sew one $1^{3 / 4} 4^{\prime \prime} \times 44^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{C} 7200$ Denim strip to each side of the quilt center, followed by one $1^{3 / 4^{\prime \prime}} \times 28^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}}$ C7200 Denim strip to the top and the other to the bottom.
8. Sew one $1^{1 / 2 " ~} \times 46^{1 / 2 "}$ Soho-White strip to each side of the quilt center, followed by one $1^{1 / 12^{\prime \prime}} \times 30^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}}$ Soho-White strip to the top and the other to the bottom.
9. Sew one $6^{1 / 21} \times 48^{1 / 21}$ " C8324 Blue strip to each side of the quilt center, followed by one $6^{1 / 2 "} \times 42^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}}$ C8324 Blue strip to the top and the other to the bottom.
10. Sew one $11 / 2^{11} \times 60^{1 / 21}$ Soho-White strip to each side of the quilt center, followed by one $1^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}} \times 44^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}}$ Soho-White strip to the top and the other to the bottom.
11. Sew one $1^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}} \times 62^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}} \mathrm{C} 7200$ Denim strip to each side of the quilt center, followed by one $1^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}} \times 46^{1 / 2 \text { " }}$ C7200 Denim strip to the top and the other to the bottom.
12. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}} \times 64^{1 / 2 \text { " }}$ C 7200 Cream strip to each side of the quilt center, followed by one $1^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}} \times 48^{1 / 2 \text { " }}$ C7200 Cream strip to the top and the other to the bottom.

13. Referring to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for Star Block color placement, arrange and sew together eleven blocks to make a vertical column. Make two column units and noting the color placement, sew one to each side of the bordered quilt center.
14. Arrange and sew together ten blocks to make a horizontal row. Make two row units and noting the color placement, sew one to the top and the other to the bottom of the quilt center.
15. Sew one $2^{\prime \prime} \times 78^{1 / 2 "}$ C7200 Cream strip to each side of the quilt center, followed by one $2^{\prime \prime} \times 63^{1 / 2 "} 2^{\prime \prime}$ C7200 Cream strip to the top and the other to the bottom.
16. Sew one $1^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}} \times 81^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ C7200 Cranberry strip to each side of the quilt center, followed by one $1^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 65^{1 / 2 \text { " }}$ C7200 Cranberry strip to the top and one to the bottom.
17. Sew one $4^{\prime \prime} \times 83^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}}$ C8324 Blue strip to each side of the quilt center, followed by one $4^{\prime \prime} \times 72^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}}$ C8324 Blue strip to the top and the other to the bottom.

## Finishing

18. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing, and quilt as desired.
19. Stitch the binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Stitch to the quilt front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
20. Fold the binding to the quilt underside and hand-stitch the folded edge to the quilt back.
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
