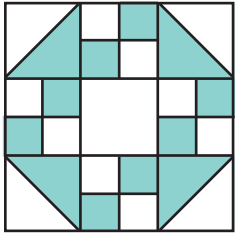





Prairie Queen Quilt Block

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tutorial!



Unfinished size: 12 1/2" x 12 1/2".

Cutting Instructions:

<p>Block Print</p> 	<p>One Block</p> <p>1 - 5 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangle (A) 2 - 2 1/2" x 11" rectangles (B)</p>
<p>Block Background</p> 	<p>1 - 5 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangle (C) 1 - 4 1/2" square (D) 2 - 2 1/2" x 11" rectangles (E)</p>
<p>4" Finished Half Square Triangle Paper #H400</p>	<p>1 - two by one section (2 squares)</p> 

Use 1/4" seams and press seams open throughout.

Block Assembly

With right sides facing, layer the Fabric C rectangle with the Fabric A rectangle.

Place the two by one section of 4" Finished Half Square Triangle Paper on top and pin in place.

Set stitch length to 1.5 and sew on the dotted lines.

Cut apart on the solid lines.

Half Square Triangle Unit should measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2".



Make 4.



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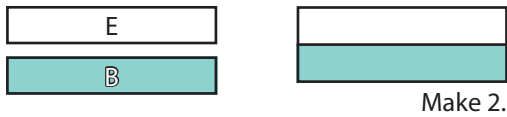
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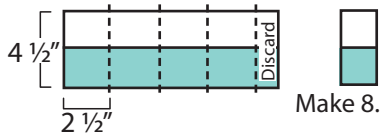
Assemble one Fabric E rectangle and one Fabric B rectangle.

Two Patch Strip Set should measure $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 11''$.



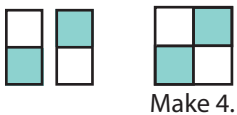
Subcut each Two Patch Strip Set into four $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangles.

Two Patch Unit should measure $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$.



Assemble two Two Patch Units.

Four Patch Unit should measure $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$.



Assemble the Prairie Queen Block.

Prairie Queen Block should measure $12\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$.
