



Finished Size: 34" x 86 1/2".

Fabric Requirements:

Background: 2 1/2 yards

32 Happy Chance Blocks: 10 Fat Quarters

Outer Borders: 1 1/8 yards

Binding: 5% yard Backing: 2 3/4 yards

Follow the cutting and block assembly instructions in the Serendipity Release #2 Happy Chance Row Pattern for your blocks.

Choose the Flying Geese Method that works best for you. The cutting on the left uses the Traditional Method and the cutting on the right uses the Foundation Paper Method.

Finishing Entling:


Background	4 - 5" x 15 ½" strips	Α
	10 - 2" x width of fabric strips	В
	2 - 2" x 26" strips	С
Outer Borders	5 - 4 ½" x width of fabric strips	D
	2 - 4 ½" x 34" strips	Е
Binding	7 - 2 ½" x width of fabric strips	F

Use 1/4" seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

Rows:

Assemble two Fabric A rectangles, three Bottom Happy Chance Blocks and three Top Happy Chance Blocks.


First Row should measure 5" x 75 1/2".





Assemble five Bottom Happy Chance Blocks and five Top Happy Chance Blocks.

Second Row should measure 5" x 75 1/2".



Runner Center & Inner Borders:


Piece the Fabric B strips end to end. Subcut into:

- 3 2" x 75 1/2" strips (Sashing B1)
- 2 2" x 75 1/2" strips (Side Inner Borders B2)

Assemble Runner Center. Press toward the Sashing. Runner Center should measure  $23^{\circ} \times 75^{\circ}$ 2".

Attach the Side Inner Borders.

Attach top and bottom inner borders using the Fabric C strips.







Outer Borders:


Piece the Fabric D strips end to end.

Subcut into:

2 - 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 78  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips (Side Outer Borders - D)

Attach the Side Outer Borders.

Attach top and bottom outer borders using the Fabric E strips.



Finishing:

Piece the Fabric F strips end to end for binding. Quilt and bind as desired.
