## Fabric Requirements \& Cutting Instructions

Quilt Size: Approximately 61" x 78"

## Fabric A- Sunflowers - Black

8476-0512
$15 / 8$ yards
Cut eight $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} x$ width of fabric (WOF) strips.
Cut two $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twelve $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

## Fabric B- Roses - Cream

477-0540
$13 / 8$ yards
Cut eighteen $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (288) $2^{1 / 2 "}$ squares.

## Fabric C- Tossed Daisies - Black 8470-0512 $2 / 3$ yard

Cut one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into six $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Cut six $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into ninety-six $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

## Fabric D- Bouquet - Green

8471-0514
$1 / 4$ yard
Cut two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eighteen $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.

## Fabric E- Daisies \& Vines - Green 8473-0514 1/4 yard

Cut two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eighteen $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2$ " strips.

## Fabric F- Bow Ties - Green

8475-0514 1/4 yard
Cut two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eighteen $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2$ " strips.
Fabric G- Leaves - Green
8472-0514
1/4 yard
Cut two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eighteen $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.
Fabric H- Sunflowers - Red
8476-0511
$1 / 2$ yard
Cut three $21 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twelve $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
Cut two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Fabric I- Leaves - Red
8472-0511
$1 / 3$ yard
Cut three $21 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twelve $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.

## Fabric J- Daisies \& Vines - Red <br> 8473-0511 <br> 718 yard

Cut three $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twelve $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
Cut seven $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

## Fabric K- Tossed Daisies - Red <br> 8470-0511 <br> 1/3 yard

Cut three $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twelve $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.

## Fabric L- Bouquets - Red <br> 8471-0511 <br> 1/4 yard

Cut two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Fabric M- Roses - Black
8477-0512
$1 / 2$ yard

Cut six $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

## Fabric N- Vines - Cream/Red 8474-0511 $11 / 4$ yards

Cut two $18 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into three $18 \frac{1}{4}$ " squares and (2) $93 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Cut the $181 / 4$ " squares across both diagonals to make twelve corner setting triangles (only ten will be used). Cut the $93 / 8{ }^{\prime \prime}$ squares across one diagonal to make four corner setting triangles.

## Block Assembly

## (Pay attention to the orientation of the components when assembling the quilt top.)

Place one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B square on the left side of one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D strip, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2).

Place another $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B square on the right side of the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{1 / 2 "}$ " Fabric D strip, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 3). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Flip open the triangle formed and press to make one Unit 1 strip (Fig. 4).
Repeat Steps 1-2 to make eighteen Unit 1 strips total.
Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Figures 6-8 for fabric identification, location and seam direction to make eighteen Unit 2 strips, eighteen Unit 3 strips and eighteen Unit 4 strips.
Place one $21 / 2$ " Fabric B square on the left side of one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} x$
 $81 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I strip, right sides together (Fig. 9). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 9). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 10).
Place another $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B square on the right side of the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I strip, right sides together (Fig. 11). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 11). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Flip open the triangle formed and press to make one Unit 5 strip (Fig. 12).
Repeat Steps 5-6 to make twelve Unit 5 strips total.
Repeat Steps 5-6 and refer to Figures 13-16 for fabric identification, location and seam direction to make twelve Unit 6 strips, twelve Unit 7 strips, twelve Unit 8 strips and twenty-four Unit 9 strips.
Sew one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C square to each end of one Unit 1 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make twelve rows.

Sew one Unit 4 strip to the left side and one Unit 2 strip to the right side of one $41 / 2$ " Fabric A square to make the middle row. Repeat to make twelve rows.
Sew one $21 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C square to each end of one Unit 3 strip to make the bottom row. Repeat to make twelve rows.
Sew the three rows from Steps 9-11 together to make one Unit 10 block (Fig. 17). Repeat to make twelve Unit 10 blocks total.
Repeat Steps 9-12 and refer to Figure 18-19 for component identification, location and orientation to make twelve Block One squares and six Block Two squares.

Quilt Assembly (refer to Figure 20 and the quilt layout while assembling the quilt top)

Sew one Fabric $N$ side setting triangle to each side of one Block One square. Sew one Fabric N corner setting triangle to the top of the Block One square to make Row One.
Sew one Block One square to each side of one Block Two square. Sew one Fabric $N$ side setting triangle to each end of the new strip to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Five.
Sew three Block One squares and two Block Twos squares together, alternating them. Sew one Fabric $N$ side setting triangle to the left end of the new strip and one Fabric $N$ corner setting triangle to the right end of the strip to make Row Three.
Sew three Block One squares and two Block Twos squares together, alternating them. Sew one Fabric $N$ corner setting triangle to the left end of the new strip and one Fabric $N$ side setting triangle to the right end of the strip to make Row Four.


Sew one Fabric $N$ side setting triangle to each side of one Block One square. Sew one Fabric N corner setting triangle to the bottom of the Block One square to make Row Six.
Sew the six rows together in numerical order to make the Center Block.
Sew four $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF Fabric A strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Trim the seam to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$. Measure the sides of the Center Block and cut two strips to that length. Sew one strip to each side of the Center Block.
Sew four $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF Fabric A strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Trim the seam to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$. Measure the top and bottom of the Center Block and cut two strips to that length. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
Layer and quilt as desired.
Sew the seven $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF Fabric J strips together, end to end with $45^{\circ}$ seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half, lengthwise with wrong sides together, and press.
Bind as desired.
