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Note: Sort cut pieces into (15) \#1 block piles and (15) \#2 block piles. Each \#1 block is made from (1) A 4-1/2" square, (8) L 2-1/2" squares, (4) matching 2-1/2" $\times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces and (4) different matching 2-1/2" $\times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces. Each \#2 block is made from (1) A 4-1/2" square, (8) B 2-1/2" squares, (4) matching 2-1/2" $\times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces and (4) different matching 2-1/2" $\times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces.

## BLOCK \#1 ASSEMBLY

1. From the first Block \#1 pile, sew L 2-1/2" squares to opposite ends of (1) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece. Make (2) matching short end units.

2. Sew matching $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces to opposite sides of (1) A 4-1/2" square. Sew the short end units to the top and bottom to make the block center.

3. Sew L $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares to opposite ends of (1) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece. Make (2) matching long end units.

4. Sew $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ matching pieces to opposite sides of the block center. Sew the long end units to the top and bottom to make (1) 12-1/2" unfinished \#1 block. Make a total of (15) assorted \#1 blocks.


## BLOCK \#2 ASSEMBLY

5. Sew B 2-1/2" squares to opposite ends of (1) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece. Make (2) matching short end units.

6. Sew $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ matching pieces to opposite sides of (1) A 4-1/2" square. Sew the short end units to the top and bottom to make the block center.

7. Sew B $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares to opposite ends of (1) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece. Make (2) matching long end units.
8. Sew $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ matching pieces to opposite sides of the block center. Sew the long end units to the top and bottom to make (1) 12-1/2" unfinished \#2 block. Make a total of (15) assorted \#2 blocks.


## QUILT ASSEMBLY

9. Lay out (3) \#1 blocks alternating with (2) \#2 blocks and sew into Row \#1. Make a total of (3) \#1 rows.
10. In the same way, lay out (3) \#2 blocks alternating with (2) \#1 blocks and sew into Row \#2.

Make a total of (3) \#2 rows.
11. Sew together the \#1 rows alternating with the \#2 rows to complete the quilt top.

FINISHING
12. Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using F 2-1/4" strips pieced together using diagonal seams.
