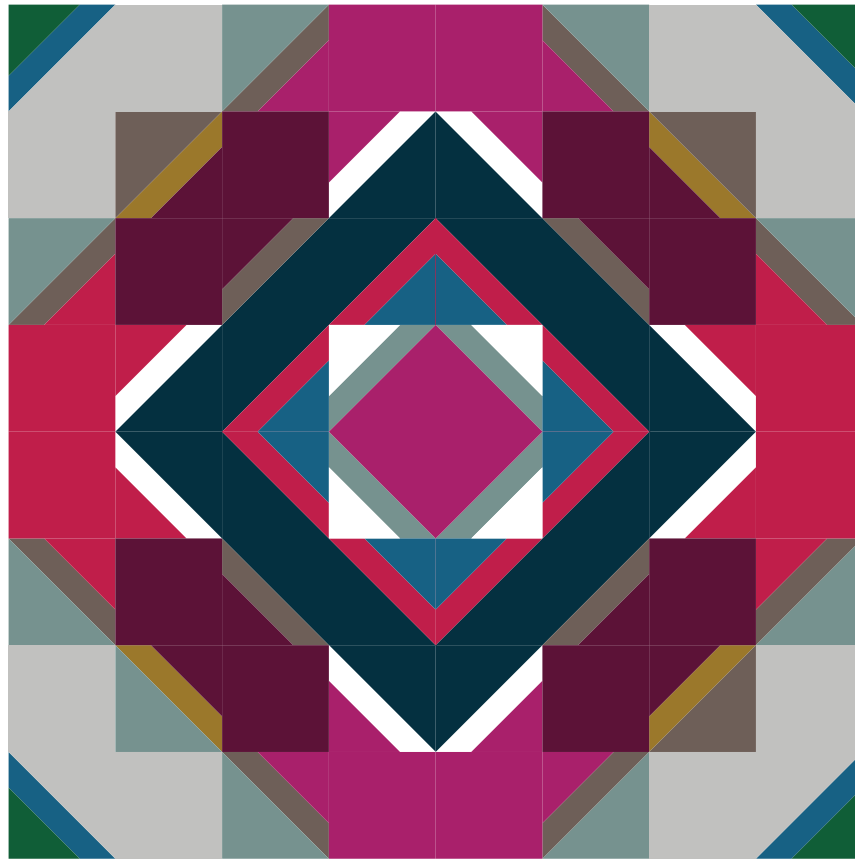

3½" Square	4	--	8	--	4	--	--	8	--	--	--
3¼" Square* Cut in Half Diagonally	4	--	--	4	4	--	--	4	--	2	2
4¼" Square* Cut in Half Diagonally	2	4	2	--	--	10**	2	--	--	--	--
1½ x 5½" Rectangle*	--	4	--	4	8	--	12	--	4	--	8

These are for foundation piecing, so they don't have to be precisely cut. *
In order to get ten squares from a Fat Eighth, you will have to cut 4 ⅛" squares. **

step 1

Foundation Piecing. Use the chart to make the proper combinations of squares with the foundation piecing pattern. You'll need 10 copies of Page 4 for the foundation patterns.

HELPFUL HINT: Use colored pencils to mark the foundation patterns and keep the colors in order.

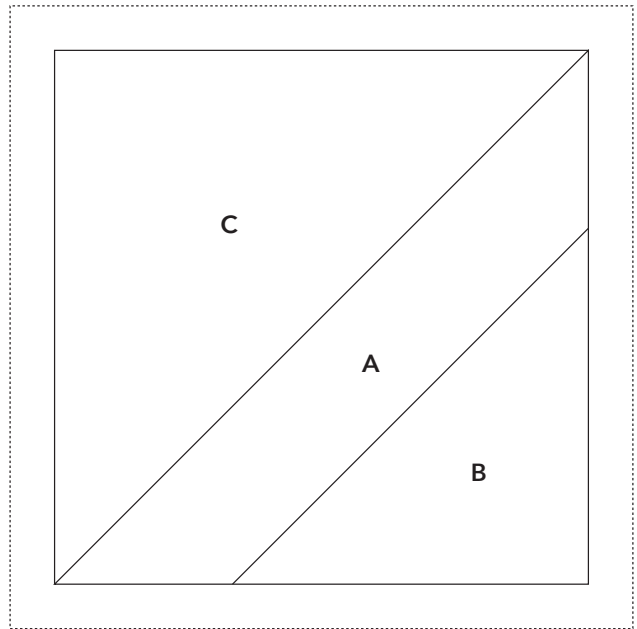
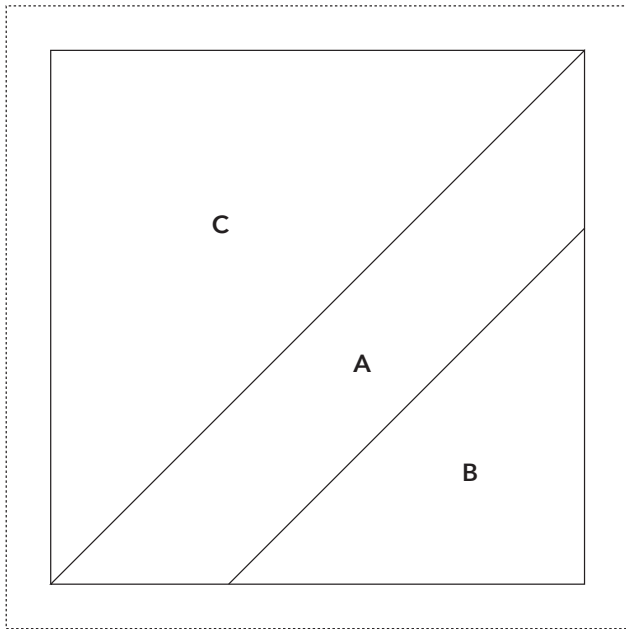
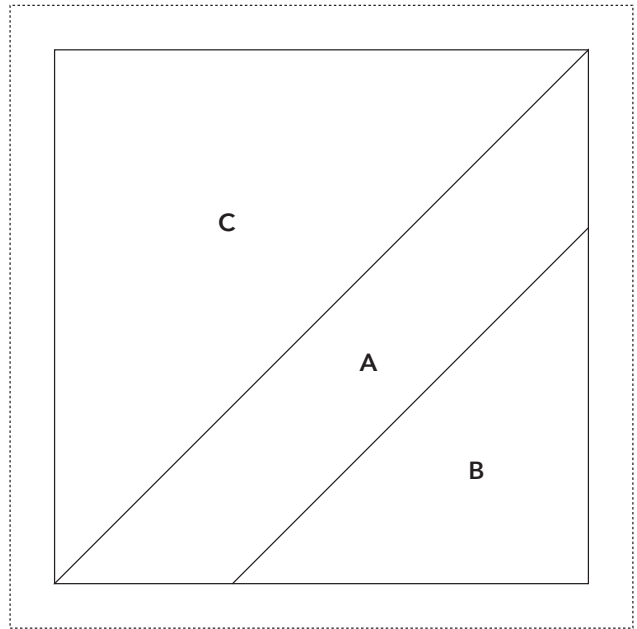
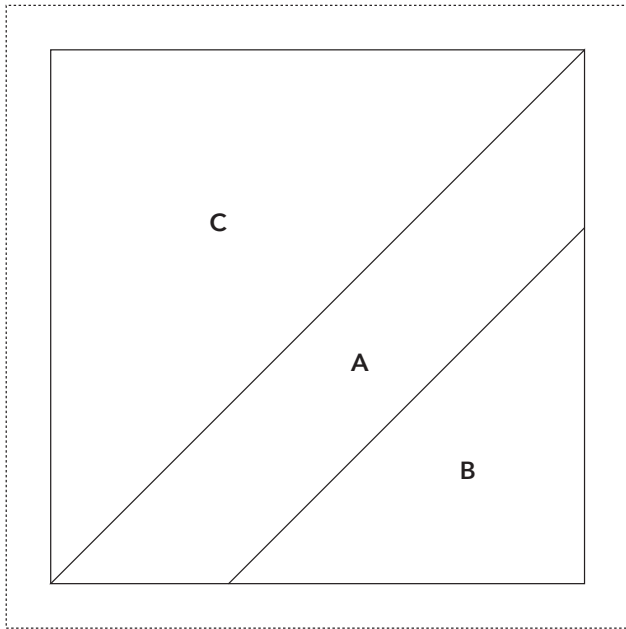
step 2

Assemble the Blocks Use the layout on Page 2 to place all the elements in the proper order Sew the blocks together row by row using 1/4" seams. Press each row in the same direction, alternating directions. (Row 1 should be pressed to the right, Row 2 to the left and so on.) Sew together all rows locking your seams.

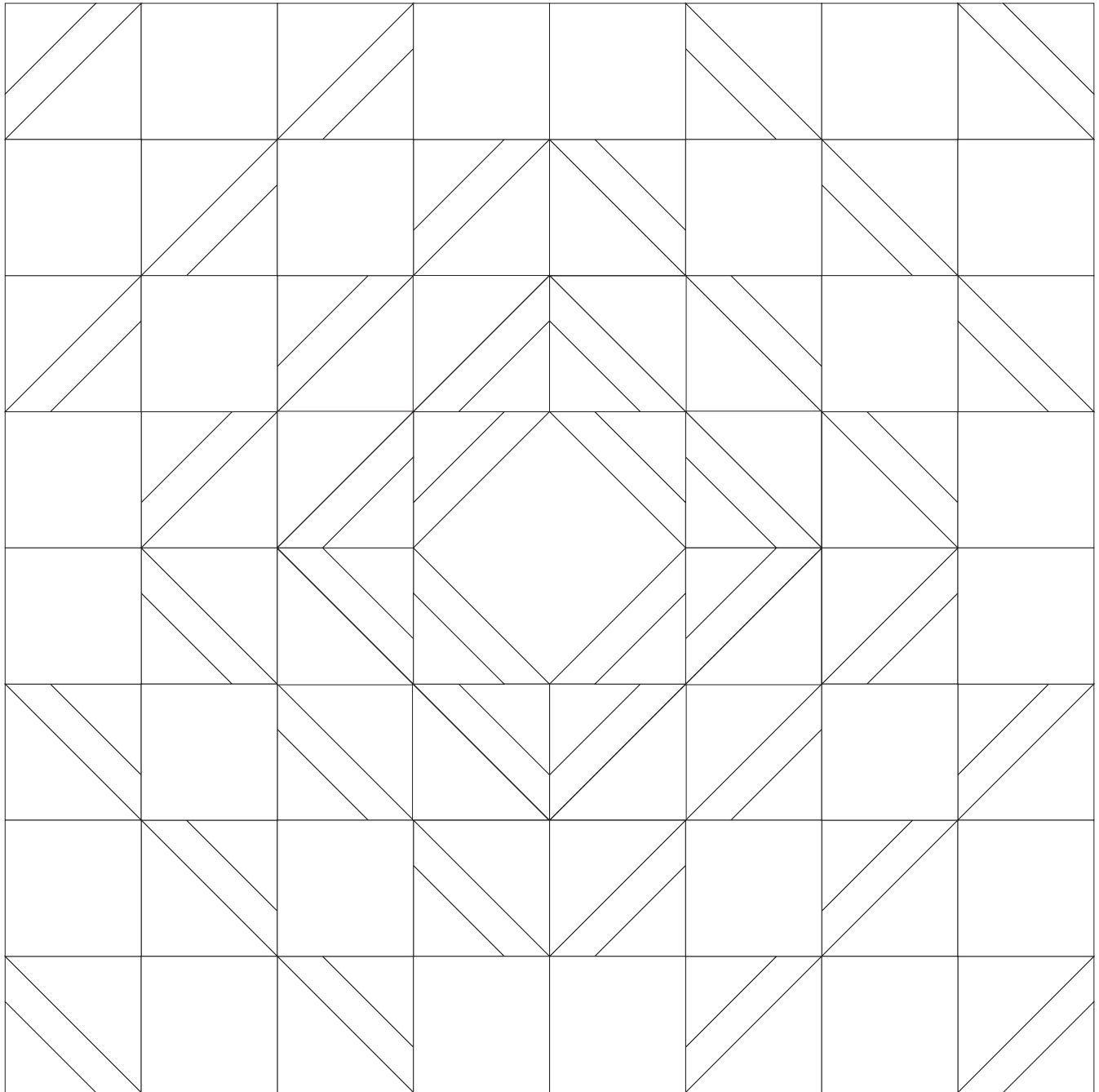
step 3

Quilt as desired. Bind. Congratulations, you're done!
