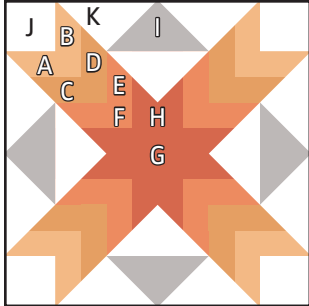




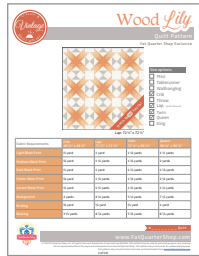

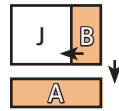
Cutting Instructions	One Block
Light Block Print	A) 4 - 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles
	B) 4 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles
Medium Block Print	C) 4 - 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles
	D) 4 - 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles
Dark Block Print	E) 8 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles
	F) 4 - 2 1/2" squares
Center Block Print	G) 1 - 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangle
	H) 10 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles
Accent Block Print	I) 4 - 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles
Background	J) 4 - 4 1/2" squares
	K) 24 - 4 1/2" squares

Use 1/4" seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

Block Assembly:

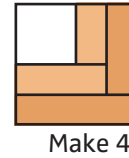
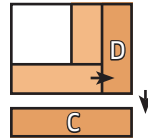
Assemble one Fabric J square, one Fabric B rectangle and one Fabric A rectangle.

First Round Unit should measure 6 1/2" x 6 1/2".



Assemble one First Round Unit, one Fabric D rectangle and one Fabric C rectangle.

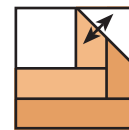
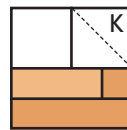
Second Round Unit should measure 8 1/2" x 8 1/2".



Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric K squares.

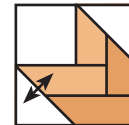
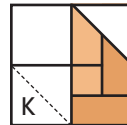
With right sides facing, layer a Fabric K square on the top right corner of a Second Round Unit.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.



Repeat on the bottom left corner.

Corner Unit should measure 8 1/2" x 8 1/2".



Make 4.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric K square on one end of a Fabric I rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.



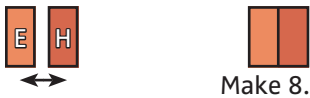
Repeat on the opposite end.

Flying Geese Unit should measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Assemble one Fabric E rectangle and one Fabric H rectangle.

Partial Star Point Unit should measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".



With right sides facing, layer a Fabric K square with a Partial Star Point Unit.

Pay close attention to unit placement.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.

Left Star Point Unit should measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".



With right sides facing, layer a Fabric K square with a Partial Star Point Unit.

Pay close attention to unit placement.

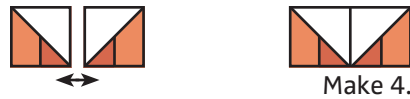
Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.

Right Star Point Unit should measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".



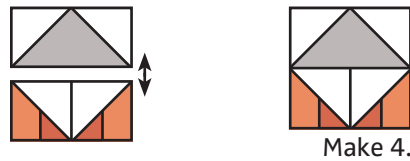
Assemble one Left Star Point Unit and one Right Star Point Unit.

Star Point Unit should measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ ".



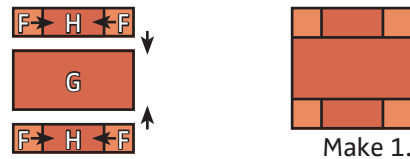
Assemble one Flying Geese Unit and one Star Point Unit.

Wood Lily Unit should measure $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Assemble four Fabric F squares, two Fabric H rectangles and the Fabric G rectangle.

Center Unit should measure $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Assemble Block. Press open.

Wood Lily Block should measure $24\frac{1}{2}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ ".
