In Stitches Quilt

FINISHED QUILT SIZE: 76" x 88"

- Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.
- Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Stitchy Birds Rolie Polie (RP-12600-40)
 3½ yards Parchment Stitches (C12606)
 1½ yards Red Main (C12600)
 1¼ yards Green Stitches (C12606) includes binding
 ¼ yard Blue Love (C12604)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

- Please read instructions before cutting fabrics.
- Label pieces as you cut.

Stitchy Birds Rolie Polie

Select 30 strips. From each strip, subcut:
 9- 2½" squares
 Keep squares together as a block set.



Parchment Stitches

Cut 8 strips 2½" x WOF; subcut:
 120- 2½" squares
 Cut 7 strips 6½" x WOF; subcut:
 112- 6½" x 2½" rectangles
 Cut 5 strips 10½" x WOF; subcut:
 71- 10½" x 2½" strips
 8- 6½" x 2½" rectangles



Red Main

Cut 8 strips 5½" x WOF.



Green Stitches

Cut 9 strips 2½" x WOF for binding.
 Cut 8 strips 2½" x WOF.



Blue Love

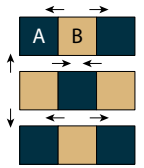
Cut 3 strips 2½" x WOF; subcut:
 42- 2½" squares

QUILT ASSEMBLY

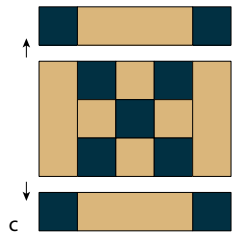
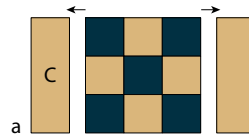
- Refer to the Cutting Requirements list, quilt photo and Quilt Layout Diagram for the placement of prints.
- Follow pressing arrows as shown.
- Orient the pieces according to their pertinent diagrams. Doing so is essential to following relational instructions such as top, bottom, left, right and so on.

Irish Chain Blocks

- Select a set of 5 matching A squares, 4 B squares, and 4 C rectangles. Arrange 5 A squares and the 4 B squares into a 3 x 3 setting, alternating positions.
- Sew squares together side-to-side into rows. Sew rows together to make a Nine-Patch (6½" square).
- Sew a rectangle C to each side of the Nine-Patch (a).
- Sew the remaining 4 A squares to opposite ends of the 2 remaining C rectangles (b). Sew these to the top and bottom edges of the Nine-Patch to complete the Irish Chain block (c). 10½" square. Make 30.

Sashing Rows

- Sew together 6 D squares and 5 E strips end-to-end, alternating positions to make a Sashing Row (62½" x 2½"). Make 7.

Quilt Center

- Referring to the Quilt Layout Diagram, arrange the 30 Irish Chain Blocks into a 5 x 6 setting.
- Sew 5 blocks together side-to-side with 6 E sashing strips into a row, alternating positions and pressing toward the sashing to complete a Block Row (62½" x 10½"). Make 6.
- Sew 6 Block Rows together with 7 Sashing Rows, alternating positions, nesting seams and pressing toward the sashing to complete the Quilt Center (62½" x 74½").

Inner Border

- Sew together 4 F strips end-to-end. Cut 2 borders 74½" in length and sew one to each side of the Quilt Center (66½" x 74½").
- Repeat Step 1 with the remaining 4 F strips. Cut 2 borders 66½" in length and sew one to the top, the other to the bottom of the Quilt Center (66½" x 78½").

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Outer Border

1. Sew together 2 G strips end-to-end. Cut strip to $78\frac{1}{2}$ " in length to make a vertical outer border. Make 2 and sew one to each side of the quilt.
2. Sew together 2 G strips end-to-end. Cut strip to $76\frac{1}{2}$ " in length to make a horizontal outer border. Make 2 and sew one to the top, the other to the bottom of the quilt. Quilt now measures $76\frac{1}{2}$ " \times $88\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Finishing

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Green Stitches strips.

Have fun and enjoy the journey of making your quilt!
