FINISHED QUILT SIZE: 47½" × 56½"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

1 Hershey Halloween 5" Stacker (5-11980-42)

5" square Riley Lime Solid C120

1¾ yards Riley Black Solid C120

½ yard White Pumpkins C11983

1 Fat Quarter each of:

Orange Spiderweb C11982

Yellow Spiderweb C11982

Orange Pumpkins C11983

½ yard Black Pumpkins C11983 for Binding

31/4 yards Backing

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions before cutting fabrics. Refer to the guilt photo for the placement of each of the fabrics included in the kit. Label as you cut.

Hershey Halloween 5" Stacker

Select 38 squares 5" × 5".

Trim each square to $5" \times 2\%"$ for patchwork inner border.

Riley Lime Solid

Cut 6 squares 1½" × 1½" D

Riley Black Solid

Cut 1 strip 4½ × WOF

Subcut 3 rectangles 4½" × 12½" E

Cut 5 strips 4" × WOF for outer border.

Cut 2 strips 2" × WOF

Subcut 24 squares $2" \times 2"$ B Cut 8 strips 2½" × WOF

Set aside 4 strips for inner border.

Subcut 6 rectangles 2½" × 13½" for sashing

Subcut 30 squares 2½" × 2½"

Subcut 3 rectangles 2" × 31/4" G

Cut 6 strips 1½" × WOF.

Subcut 2 strips 1½" × 32½" for horizontal sashing

Subcut 3 strips 1½" × 8½" J Subcut 6 strips 1½" × 6" F

 $1\frac{1}{2}$ " × 4"

Subcut 6 rectangles Subcut 3 rectangles 2" × 3" Τ

Subcut 12 rectangles 1½" × 2½"

Subcut 18 squares 1½" × 1½"



White Pumpkins

Cut 2 strips 9" × WOF.

Subcut 3 rectangles 9" × 21" (= fat eighths)



Orange & Yellow Spiderweb, Orange Pumpkins

Cut each fat quarter into 2 rectangles 9" × 21" for a total of 6 fat eighths.



Black Pumpkins

Cut 5 strips 2½" × WOF for binding.

Cutting Blocks

The following cutting instructions are for 1 block of each block type: Ghost, Short Pumpkin, and Tall Pumpkin.

There are 3 of each block type. 1 fat eighth makes 1 block. Simply layer 3 fat eighths and cut all of the same type block at once. Follow the cutting diagrams and cut in the order listed. Label the pieces as you go.

Ghost (G)

Layer 3 White Pumpkins fat eighths.

Cut 1 strip 5½" × 9"


Subcut 1 rectangle 5½" × 8½" Ga

Cut 1 strip 3½" × 9"

Subcut 1 rectangle 3½" × 8½" Gb

Cut 5 strips 1½" × 9"

Subcut 1 strip	1½" × 8½"	Gc
Subcut 2 rectangles	1½" × 4"	Gd
Subcut 3 rectangles	1½" × 2½"	Ge
Subcut 8 squares	1½" × 1½"	Gf



Tall Pumpkins (T)

Layer 2 Yellow Spiderweb & 1 Orange Pumpkins fat eighths.

Cut 1 strip 3½" × 9"

Subcut 1 rectangle 3½" × 8½" Ta

Cut 1 strip 3" × 9"


Subcut 1 rectangle 3" × 8½" Tb

Cut 4 strips 2" × 9"

Subcut 1 rectangle	2" × 8½"	Tc
Subcut 2 rectangles	2" × 3½"	Te
Subcut 2 rectangles	2" × 3¼"	Tf
Subcut 1 rectangle	2" × 2½"	Tg
Subcut 2 rectangles	2" × 2½"	Ti

Cut 2 strips 1½" × 9"

Subcut 1 strip	1½" × 8½"	Td
Subcut 2 rectangles	1½" × 4½"	Th



Short Pumpkins (S)

Layer 2 Orange Spiderweb & 1 Orange Pumpkins fat eighths.


Cut 1 strip 12½" × 9"

Subcut 2 strips

Subcut 2 rectangles $1\%" \times 6"$ Sb

Cut 1 strip 5\%" × 9"

Cut 1 strip 2" × 9"

Subcut 1 rectangle	2" × 3¼"	Se

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the cutting requirements list, quilt photo and layout diagrams for the placement of prints and block construction. Press seam allowances open unless otherwise stated.

Stitch-N-Flip Corners (SNF)

1. Draw a pencil or chalk line diagonally on back of the smaller contrasting piece.



2. Position it on the desired corner. Sew on the drawn line. Trim ¼" away from the stitching.



3. Flip the triangle open and press. The corner is replaced.



Ghost Blocks (G)

Using the SNF technique, replace the 2 top corners of rectangle Gb with C squares.


Using the SNF technique, replace the top 2 corners of rectangle K with Gf squares. Make 4 for the bottom row. Each unit measures $2\frac{1}{2}$ " × $1\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Lay out the pieces of the block. Sew pieces together to complete rows first. Sew rows together and add Black strip J to the top. The Ghost Block now measures $8\frac{1}{2}$ " × $13\frac{1}{2}$ ". Make 3 Ghost Blocks.


Tall Pumpkin Blocks (T)

Using the SNF technique, prepare the eyes (Te + B), nose (Th + A), sides of the mouth (Tf + B) and 4 corners (Ta + C and Tb + C) of the Tall Pumpkin as shown.


- The next 6 steps are a modified version of the SNF technique.
- Orient the cut pieces following the pertinent illustrations while constructing the blocks. Doing so is essential to following positional terms such as top, bottom, left side, right side and so on.
- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of rectangle Ti from upper right to lower left (a).
- 2. Right sides together, position one end of the drawn line on rectangle I's lower right corner. Swivel the other end of the drawn line to the left side of rectangle I (b).
- 3. Sew on the drawn line. Trim seam allowance below the stitched line ¼" (c).
- 4. Open the triangle and press (d).




5. Repeat Steps 1 & 2 using a second Ti rectangle. This time, draw the diagonal line from upper left to lower right (a). Position the drawn line on rectangle I's upper right corner and swivel again to the left side of rectangle I (b).



6. Repeat Steps 3 & 4—this time trimming *above* the stitched line—to complete the Pumpkin's mouth (c & d) $2" \times 3"$.





Lay out the pieces of the block. Sew pieces together to complete rows first.

Sew rows together. The Tall Pumpkin Block now measures 8%" × 13%". Make 3 Tall Pumpkins.


Short Pumpkin Blocks (S)

Using the SNF technique, prepare the eyes and sides of mouth (SC + B), and 4 corners (Sa + C) of the Short Pumpkin.

Follow Tall Pumpkin Blocks— the modified SNF technique— Steps 1-6 to make the Small Pumpkin mouth, using rectangles G & Sd $(2 \times 3\%)$.

Lay out the pieces of the block. Sew pieces together to complete rows first.

Sew rows together and add Black rectangle E to the top. The Small Pumpkin Block now measures 12%" × 13%". Make 3 Small Pumpkins.



Quilt Center Assembly

Layout the 9 blocks in 3 rows of 3 blocks each. Follow the quilt layout diagram for placement. Sew 2 vertical sashing strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " × $13\frac{1}{2}$ " between blocks in each row.

Sew the horizontal sashing strips $1\frac{1}{2}$ " × $32\frac{1}{2}$ between the rows. The quilt center now measures $32\frac{1}{2}$ " × $41\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Inner Border

Sew 2%" × 41%" borders to each side. Add borders 2%" × 36%" to the top and bottom. The quilt now measures 36%" × 45%".

Patchwork Border

Sew together 10 trimmed Stacker rectangles end-to-end to make a side border. Make 2 and sew 1 to each side.

Sew together 9 trimmed Stacker rectangles end-to-end for a top border. Repeat to make a bottom border. Sew these to the quilt top and bottom. The quilt now measures $41" \times 50"$.

Outer Border

Sew together the 5 border strips 4" × WOF end-to-end.

Cut 2 borders 50" long and sew 1 to each side.

Cut 2 borders 48" long and sew 1 to the top and bottom. The quilt now measures $48" \times 57"$.

Finishing

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with 2½" Black Pumpkins strips.

Have fun and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
