

FINISHED QUILT SIZE: 46" x 18"

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- 5/8 yard Santa Claus Blossom (C730)
- 1/2 yard Red Trees Seasonal Basics (C654) includes binding
- 3/8 yard Red Stars Seasonal Basics (C657)
- 1/8 yard Christmas Stripe Seasonal Basics (C495)
- 3" strip Green Trees Seasonal Basics (C654)
- 10" square each of:
 - Holly Shabby (C605)
 - Peas Texture (C610)
 - Clover Sparkler (SC650)
 - Teddy Bear Solid (C120)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

- Please read instructions before cutting fabrics.
- Refer to the quilt photo and layout diagram for fabric placement.
- Label the pieces as you cut.
- 4 1/2" Trim-It Ruler™ by Lori Holt of Bee in My Bonnet *(optional)*



Santa Claus Blossom

Cut 2 strips 4 3/4" x WOF; subcut:

- 2 – 4 3/4" x 18 1/2" **C**
- 2 – 4 3/4" x 10" **B**

Cut 4 strips 2 1/2" x WOF; subcut:

- 4 – 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles **BK5**
- 4 – 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles **BK1**
- 4 – 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles **BK2**
- 4 – 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles **BK3**
- 20 – 2 1/2" squares **BK4**



Red Trees

Cut 1 strip 4 7/8" x WOF; subcut:

- 2 – 4 7/8" squares; cut in half diagonally once. **P1**
- 2 – 4 7/8" squares; cut in half diagonally twice. **P2**
- Cut 4 strips 2 1/2" x WOF for binding.



Red Stars

Cut 4 strips 2 1/2" x WOF; subcut:


- 8 – 2 1/2" x 14 1/2" strips **A**



Christmas Stripe


Cut 1 strip 2" x WOF; subcut:

- 1 – 2" x 10" rectangle **P5**
- 2 – 2" x 4 1/2" rectangles **P4**
- 4 – 2" x 3 1/2" rectangles **P3**



Green Trees

- Cut 2 – 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" strip **T4**




Peas Texture

- Cut 2 – 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles **T1**



Clover Sparkler

- Cut 2 – 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles **T2**



Holly Shabby

- Cut 2 – 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles **T3**



Teddy Bear Solid

- Cut 2 – 2 1/2" squares **T5**


QUILT ASSEMBLY

- Orient the cut pieces following the pertinent illustrations while constructing the table runner. Doing so is essential to understanding terms such as top, bottom, left side, right side and so on.
- All angled seams are constructed using the Stitch & Flip method. The method is described next and referenced throughout the pattern.

Under the Tree


Stitch & Flip Method (S&F)

Place 2 pieces right sides together matching raw edges in one corner. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the smaller piece across the corner. Stitch on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance above the sewn line to $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Flip the small piece away from the bottom piece and press, replacing the corner.




Tree Blocks (T)

1. Using the S&F method, replace the top corners of green rectangles T1, T2, T3, T4, and T5 with BK4 squares.



2. Sew a BK1 rectangle to each side of T1 to make Row 1.




3. Repeat Step 2 to make Rows 2, 3, 4, and 5, using the following rectangles:

BK2 + T2 + BK2; BK3 + T3 + BK3; BK4 + T4 + BK4;
BK5 + T5 + BK5

4. Arrange the rows from top to bottom in numerical order. Sew rows together to complete the Tree ($14\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ ").


5. Sew a Sashing strip A to the top and bottom of the Tree.

6. Sew a Sashing strip A to each side of the Tree Block. Make 2 Tree Blocks ($18\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ ").




Present Block


1. With the long edge facing upward, sew a P2 triangle to either side of a P3 rectangle, lining up the bottom edges to make Unit 1.




2. Sew triangle P1 to the bottom of Unit 1. Trim using the $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Trim-it™ Ruler to make a Corner Block. Make 4 Corner Blocks.



3. Arrange 4 Corner Blocks, rectangles P4 and P5 in the configuration shown. Sew 2 Corner Blocks on either side of rectangle P4 to make a row. Repeat for a second row. Sew rectangle P5 between the rows to make the Present (10 " x 10 ").



4. Sew rectangles B to each side of the Present. Sew Rectangles C to the top and bottom edges to complete the Present Block ($18\frac{1}{2}$ " x $18\frac{1}{2}$ ").

Table Runner Assembly

Following the Table Runner Layout Diagram, arrange the Tree and Present Blocks in a row. Sew the blocks together side-to-side to complete the Table Runner (46½" × 18½").

Finishing

Finish the table runner by layering the runner top, batting, and back. Bind with 2½" Red Tree strips.

Have fun and enjoy the journey of making your table runner!
