

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 69" x 69"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com/ pattern-updates for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of guilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.


FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

23 Fat Quarters of Assorted Woolen Flannels 3 Yards Parchment Diamond (F10642 Parchment) % Yard Binding

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. WOF - width of fabric.

Cutting for this quilt takes a little planning. Each block is constructed of a center and 3 rounds of squares, 1 print per round, plus the background. Take the time now to plan the block centers and rounds using the 23 fat quarters and the block fabric chart on page 4. Group the fat quarters in sets of 3 to 4 prints and cut a small swatch and glue it to the fabric chart. There is enough fabric in each fat guarter for it to be in 2 blocks or 2 rounds in one block, including the Center. The rounds start next to the center and move to the outside of the block. Round 1 has 8 squares, Round 2 has 12 and Round 3 has 15.



Label pieces as they are cut.

23 Woolen Flannel Fat Quarters

Select 9 Fat Quarters for the Block Centers. Cut 1 - 61/2" square from each Fat Quarter. (A) Select 9 Fat Quarters for the Block Round 1. Cut 8 - 2¹/₂" squares from each Fat Quarter. (B) Select 9 Fat Quarters for the Block Round 2. Cut 12 - 2¹/₂" squares from each Fat Quarter. (C) Select 9 Fat Quarters for the Block Round 3. Cut 16 - 2¹/₂" squares from each Fat Quarter. (D) From the Fat Quarter scraps. Cut 42 - 4" squares (K)

Parchment Diamond

Cut 3 strips 5¹/₈" x WOF. Sub-cut from strips: 18 - 5¹/₈" squares, cut on one diagonal for 36 triangles (F) 4 - 3½" squares (M) Cut 6 strips 41/2" x WOF for Border 1. (J) Cut 7 strips 4" x WOF. Sub-cut from strips: 42 - 4" squares (L) 27 - 4" squares, cut on both diagonals for 108 triangles (G) Cut 9 strips 21/2" x WOF. Sub-cut from strips: 6 - 2½" x 17½" rectangles (H) 36 - 2½" x 6½" rectangles (E)

Cut 3 strips 21/2" for the Sashing. (I)

Binding


Cut 8 strips 2¹/₄" x WOF for Binding.

QUILT ASSEMBLY


Refer to the block fabric chart for print placement. Press seam allowances as indicated in the diagrams unless otherwise stated.

Fan Blocks (Make 9) Select the following pieces: 1 A square for the Center 1 set of 8 B squares for Round 1 1 set of 12 C squares for Round 2 1 set of 16 D squares for Round 3 4 E rectangles 4 F triangles 12 G triangles


Lay out 2 B, C and D squares and 1 E rectangle as shown. Sew the squares into the rows. Sew the rows to the top and bottom of the E rectangle, to complete 1 Unit 1 ($6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ "). Repeat to make 4 Unit 1.




Lay out 1 C and 2 D squares and 3 G triangles as shown. Sew the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete 1 Unit 2. Repeat to make 4 Unit 2.



Lay out 4 of Unit 1 and 4 of Unit 2 and the A square as shown. Sew the pieces into diagonal rows. Sew the rows together.



Sew the 4 F triangles to the corners to complete 1 Fan Block $(17\%'' \times 17\%'')$.



Repeat to make 9 Fan Blocks.

Quilt Center

Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram (page 3) for block placement. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the rows and quilt before cutting sashing and border pieces.

Sew together 3 Fan Blocks alternating with 2 H rectangles. Repeat to make 3 rows $(17\frac{1}{2}" \times 55\frac{1}{2}")$.

Use the I strips to piece 2 sashing strips (should be 551/2").

Sew the sashing strips between the rows to complete the Quilt Center ($55\frac{1}{2}$ " x $55\frac{1}{2}$ ").

Borders

Sew side borders first.


Border 1

Use the J strips. Side borders should be $55\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $63\frac{1}{2}$ ". Press the seam allowances towards the border.

Border 2

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the L squares.

Place 1 K and 1 L square right sides together (RST). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the drawn line. Cut along the drawn line for 2 half square triangles (HSTs). Press the seam allowance open. Trim the HSTs to $\frac{31}{2}$ " x $\frac{31}{2}$ ". Repeat to make 84 HSTs.



Sew together 21 HST, randomly placing the prints. Repeat to make 4 borders $(3\frac{1}{2} \times 63\frac{1}{2})$.

Sew a border to the side edges of the Quilt Center. Press seam allowances toward Border 1.

Sew a M square to each end of the remaining borders (3½" x 69½"). Sew to the top and bottom edges of the Quilt Center. Press seam allowances toward Border 1.


Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Woolen Flannel print. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
