

KISSES doodlebug design inc.

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 80½" x 87"

Finished Block Size 6" x 6"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1/3 Yard C120 Riley Aqua Confetti Cotton Solid

1/8 Yard C120 Riley Baby Pink Confetti Cotton Solid

1/4 Yard C120 Cayenne Confetti Cotton Solid

5/8 Yard C120 Clover Confetti Cotton Solid

1/4 Yard C120 Denim Confetti Cotton Solid

5/8 Yard C120 Riley Green Confetti Cotton Solid

1/2 Yard C120 Honey Confetti Cotton Solid

1/2 Yard C120 Hunter Confetti Cotton Solid

1/4 Yard C120 Lipstick Confetti Cotton Solid

1/3 Yard C120 Peacock Confetti Cotton Solid

1/8 Yard C120 Peony Confetti Cotton Solid

1/2 Yard C120 Pumpkin Confetti Cotton Solid

1/8 Yard C120 Purple Confetti Cotton Solid

1/3 Yard C120 Redwood Confetti Cotton Solid

1/8 Yard C120 Riley Lilac Confetti Cotton Solid

1/4 Yard C120 Riley Medium Blue Confetti Cotton Solid

1/4 Yard C120 Riley Navy Confetti Cotton Solid

1/3 Yard C120 Riley Orange Confetti Cotton Solid

1/4 Yard C120 Riley Raspberry Confetti Cotton Solid

1/3 Yard C120 Riley Red Confetti Cotton Solid

1/2 Yard C120 Riley Yellow Confetti Cotton Solid

5 Yards C120 Riley White Confetti Cotton Solid

1/3 Yard C120 Sweet Mint Confetti Cotton Solid

1/2 Yard C120 Treetop Confetti Cotton Solid

1/2 Yard C120 Vivid Confetti Cotton Solid

3/4 Yard Binding (C120 Peacock Confetti Cotton Solid)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Cut squares 3½" x 3½" in the corresponding number from each solid (excluding binding).

4 – Baby Pink and Lilac

8 – Peony and Purple

12 – Lipstick and Navy

16 – Denim and Raspberry

20 – Cayenne and Medium Blue

24 – Red and Peacock

28 – Aqua and Redwood

32 – Orange and Sweet Mint

36 – Pumpkin and Vivid

40 – Hunter and Yellow

44 – Honey and Treetop

48 – Clover and Green

Riley White Solid

Cut 57 strips $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF. From the strips cut 1248 squares $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $1\frac{3}{4}$ ".

Cut 8 strips 6½" x WOF. From the strips cut 287 rectangles 1" x 6½" for Sashing.

Cut 4 strips 1" x WOF. From the strips cut 132 squares 1" x 1" for Posts.

Cut 8 strips 2" x WOF for Border 1.


QUILT ASSEMBLY


Refer to the diagrams for placement of fabrics.

Kisses Block


Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of all the Riley white solid $1\frac{3}{4}$ " squares. Place a Riley white solid $1\frac{3}{4}$ " square on two opposite corners of a solid $3\frac{3}{4}$ " square and sew on the drawn line. Repeat for all of the solid $3\frac{3}{4}$ " squares.

Trim excess fabric from the corners, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.







Sort the units by color. Press half of the units of each colorway toward the Riley white solid and the other half toward the solid to create Unit A. Make a total of 624 Unit A's.



Sew two Unit A's of the same colorway, with seams pressed in opposite directions, together to create Unit B. Press. Repeat to make a total of 312 Unit B's.



Sew two Unit B's of the same colorway together to create the Kisses Block. Press. Repeat to make a total of 156 Kisses Blocks.



Kisses Block

Blocks and Sashing Rows

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for sashing and block placement. Sew Kisses Block to a Riley white solid 1" x 6½" rectangle. Repeat to make a horizontal row with 12 blocks and 11 sashing rectangles. Press toward the sashing rectangles. Make 13 block and sashing rows.

Sashing and Posts Rows

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for sashing and post placement. Sew a Riley white solid 1" x 6½" rectangle

to a Riley white solid 1" x 1" square. Repeat to make a horizontal row with 12 sashing rectangles and 11 posts. Press toward the sashing rectangles. Make 12 sashing and post rows.

Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for row placement. Sew rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

Border

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Side borders should be 84½". Top and bottom borders should be 81".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with the Peacock Confetti Cotton Solid using your preferred method. We used 2½" strips. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
