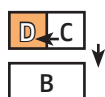

Block Assembly:

Assemble one Fabric D square, one Fabric C square and one Fabric B rectangle.

Corner Unit should measure

(1 1/4" x 1 1/4") [2" x 2"] {2 3/4" x 2 3/4"}.



Make four.



Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric G and Fabric J squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric G square on the left end of a Fabric A rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.



Repeat on the right end with a Fabric J square.

Top Flying Geese Unit should measure

$(1 \frac{1}{4}'' \times 2'')$ $[2'' \times 3 \frac{1}{2}'']$ $\{2 \frac{3}{4}'' \times 5''\}$.



Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric M squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric M square on the top end of a Fabric A rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.



Repeat on the bottom end with a Fabric J square.

Left Flying Geese Unit should measure

$(1 \frac{1}{4}'' \times 2'')$ $[2'' \times 3 \frac{1}{2}'']$ $\{2 \frac{3}{4}'' \times 5''\}$.



Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric P squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric P square on the top end of a Fabric A rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.



Repeat on the bottom end with a Fabric G square.

Right Flying Geese Unit should measure

$(1 \frac{1}{4}'' \times 2'')$ $[2'' \times 3 \frac{1}{2}'']$ $\{2 \frac{3}{4}'' \times 5''\}$.



With right sides facing, layer a Fabric P square on the left end of a Fabric A rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.



Repeat on the right end with a Fabric M square.

Bottom Flying Geese Unit should measure

$(1 \frac{1}{4}'' \times 2'')$ $[2'' \times 3 \frac{1}{2}'']$ $\{2 \frac{3}{4}'' \times 5''\}$.



Cut the Fabric E, Fabric H, Fabric K and Fabric N squares on the diagonal twice.

Assemble one Fabric K triangle, one Fabric H triangle and one Fabric O triangle.

Press open.

Trim Third Quarter Unit to measure

(1 1/4" x 1 1/4") [2" x 2"] {2 3/4" x 2 3/4"}.



Make one.

Assemble one Fabric N triangle, one Fabric K triangle and one Fabric F triangle.

Press open.

Trim Fourth Quarter Unit to measure

(1 1/4" x 1 1/4") [2" x 2"] {2 3/4" x 2 3/4"}.



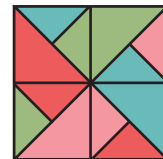
Make one.

(2" x 2") [3 1/2" x 3 1/2"] {5" x 5"}.



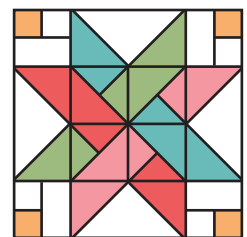
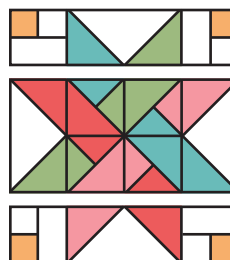
Make one.
